FRISCO, TX — The Northwest Arkansas Naturals pounded the Frisco RoughRiders for four runs across the middle three innings to edge out a 4-3 win Sunday evening and take the series on the road, four games to

- After Frisco tagged starter Alec Marsh for runs in the first and third, relievers Yefri Del Rosario and Jonah Dipoto combined for 5.0 scoreless innings of relief, holding the RoughRiders to two hits and two walks, with seven strikeouts.
- Michael Massey started the scoring for the Naturals, connecting for a solo home run to begin the fourth inning, his third straight game with a homer.
- Tucker Bradley raced home on a wild pitch to tie the score in the fifth, then Massey brought home John Rave as he reached on a two-base error by Frisco shortstop Ezequial Duran, giving the Naturals a 3-2 lead.
- In the sixth, **Nate Eaton** singled home **Robbie Glendinning** with no outs, in what proved to be an important run of insurance in the one-run game.
- Del Rosario was awarded with his first win of the season, stretching his scoreless streak to begin the season to 11.1 innings without allowing a run to cross. After Dipoto contributed two scoreless innings, **Ándres Sotillet** came on for the ninth and while the RoughRiders scored a run and put the tying run in scoring position, Sotillet closed the door and recorded his second save of the year.

This Day in Naturals History

The Naturals are 7-4 all-time when playing on April 26

On April 26, 2010, the Northwest Arkansas Naturals beat the Springfield Cardinals, 6-2 at Hammons Field and Naturals leadoff hitter and center fielder **Derrick Robinson** became the first player in club history to steal four bases in a single game. After walking in the fourth, he stole second, then swiped third on a double steal with Johnny Giavotella. He singled and stole second in the sixth inning, then walked and stole second again in the eighth inning.

THE CHAMPS ARE HERE!

Of the 28-man roster the Naturals rolled out for the Double-A Central Championship Series in 2021, seven players are on the Naturals' 2022 active roster, with a total of 10 returning players with the Naturals this season.

- Pitchers Holden Capps, Yefri Del Rosario, Drew Parrish, Ándres Sotillet, Stephen Woods Jr. and Ángel Zerpa were all a part of the championship celebration last year, as was outfielder Seuly Matias.
- Additionally, catcher/infielder Gavin Stupienski and pitcher Alec Marsh both played for the Naturals in 2021, as did catcher Tyler Cropley, who is currently on the Injured List.

FOLLOW THE LEADER

Manager Chris Widger enters his first season at the helm of the Naturals, after previous stops in *Advanced Rookie* Burlington (2019) and *High-A* Quad Cities (2021) managing Royals affiliates.

- 20 of the Naturals' 28 active players played for Widger with the Quad Cities
 River Bandits last season.
- 10 of the Naturals' 28 active players played under Widger with the Burlington Royals, then in Quad Cities and now in Northwest Arkansas:
 Dante Biasi, Jonah Dipoto, Maikel Garcia, Michael Massey, Jake Means, Drew Parrish, Zack Phillips, Logan Porter, John Rave and Ángel Zerpa.

STAR-STUDDED ROTATION

All five of the Naturals starting pitchers to open the season are consensus top prospects in the Royals' organization, with all five listed in MLB Pipeline's Top-30 rankings for Kansas City.

- LHP Drew Parrish starts today for the Naturals ... MLB Pipeline lists him at No. 29 in the system, while Baseball America had him at No. 38 in their preseason rankings.
- LHP Anthony Veneziano starts Wednesday for the Naturals ... MLB Pipeline lists him at No. 17 in the system, while Baseball America has him at No. 21.
- LHP Ángel Zerpa starts Thursday for the Naturals ... MLB Pipeline lists him at No. 13 in the system, while Baseball America has him at No. 20.
- RHP Alec Marsh stars Friday for the Naturals ... MLB Pipeline lists him at No. 12 in the system, while Baseball America has him at No. 11.
- LHP Asa Lacy has made two starts for the Naturals ... MLB Pipeline lists him No. 72 overall in baseball, No. 4 in the system and the No. 5 lefthanded pitching prospect, while Baseball America has him at No. 4 in the Royals' minor league system, the No. 4 left-handed pitching prospect.

TOOLSY TEAM

Six active Naturals players were listed in *Baseball America*'s 2022 Best Tools Survey of the Kansas City Royals' organization.

- CF Nick Loftin is rated as having the "Best Strike-Zone Discipline" in the system.
- C Sebastian Rivero is rated as being the <u>"Best Defensive Catcher"</u> in the system
- SS Maikel Garcia is rated as having the <u>"Best Infield Arm"</u> in the system.
- RF **Seuly Matias** is rated as having the "Best Outfield Arm" in the system.
- LHP **Asa Lacy** is rated as having the "Best Slider" in the system.
- LHP **Ángel Zerpa** is rated as having the "Best Control" in the system.

Yo, You Wanna See Some Real Speed?

Through 15 games, the Naturals have stolen <u>25 bases in 28 attempts</u> (average 1.67 steals/game) and *pulled off a double steal 5 times*.

- 25 steals ranks third in the Texas League, while a 89.29% success rate on steals is 15th out of 120 Minor League teams and 8th among teams with at least 20 successful steals and fourth in Double-A.
- Maikel Garcia's 7 steals ranks tied for third in the league.

GAR-SEE YA ON BASE

Shortstop **Maikel Garcia** drew 10 walks through the season's first five games, and has drawn four walks across in his last three games, is second in the Texas League with 14 walks.

- Garcia drew at least one walk in each of the first five games he played, while walking twice or more on four occasions. He collected his first threewalk game on 4/13 in the Naturals' 8-5 win over Wichita.
- In 67 plate appearances, the Venezuelan has reached base 28 times, for a .418 on-base percentage (14 hits + 14 walks).
- Garcia ranks among the Texas League leaders, ranking tied for third in walks (14) and tied 3rd in steals (7).
- Despite his on-base prowess, Garcia has gone hitless in his last four games and is 0 for his last 17 at the plate, with four walks, a span in which his batting average has dropped nearly 100 points.

G'DAY ROBBIE!

Australian infielder **Robbie Glendinning** was a February free agent signing by the Kansas City Royals and has proven himself to be one of the best players on the 2022 Naturals.

- The native of Perth, Western Australia has reached base in all <u>12 games</u> he's played started the season, hitting .289 (11-for-38) with 3 doubles, 1 triple, 1 home run and 12 walks, giving him a .471 on-base percentage.
- Glendinning is the ONLY Natural that has reached base in every game played this season, his 12-game on-base streak is second on the team behind Maikel Garcia's 13 and is tied for seventh in the Texas League.
- Among nine qualified Naturals hitter, Glendinning is the Naturals' team leader in batting average (.289), on-base percentage (.471), slugging percentage (.500) and OPS (.971), while ranking second in walks (12) and runs scored (11) ... his .471 OBP ranks sixth in the Texas League.

SNIDER DEBUTS AND EARNS THE DUB!

On April 9, right-handed pitcher **Collin Snider** made his Major League debut for the Kansas City Royals, the 111th Naturals alum to reach the Majors.

- Snider is one of 16 former Naturals on the Royals' 28-man Opening Day roster, one of 15 that has made their MLB debut after playing in Northwest Arkansas.
- Snider's first MLB appearance was a high-leverage situation, as he came on to pitch the 10th inning of a game tied 0-0 at Kauffman Stadium against Cleveland. He kept the Guardians off the board, with some defensive help from fellow 2021 Natural and 2022 debutante Bobby Witt Jr. and after the Royals walked it off in the bottom of the 10th for a 1-0 win, Snider was awarded his first MLB win in his debut.
- The full list of former Naturals on the Royals' active roster is: Scott Barlow, Jake Brentz, Dylan Coleman, Hunter Dozier, Cam Gallagher, Jackson Kowar, Nicky Lopez, Whit Merrifield, Adalberto Mondesi, Ryan O'Hearn, Salvador Perez, Brady Singer, Collin Snider, Gabe Speier, Josh Staumont and Bobby Witt Jr. ... note that Barlow pitched in MLB before he played for the Naturals.

#36 CHRIS WIDGER • Manager

- Chris Widger will manage the Naturals after guiding the River Bandits to a High-A Central championship in their first season as a Kansas City affiliate in 2021. In doing so, he was named the Minor League Manager of the Year by Baseball America following the 2021 season.
- 2022 marks Widger's seventh year in the Royals' organization, as he was slated to manage Advanced-A Wilmington in 2020 and led Burlington to the Appalachian League Championship Series in his first season as Manager in 2019. Prior to that, he was Wilmington's Bench Coach from 2016-18.
- Before joining the Royals organization, he managed the Independent League Camden Riversharks in 2015 and was their Pitching Coach from 2012-14.
- A third-round pick by Seattle in the 1992 Draft, Widger played in parts of 10 seasons in the Majors with the Mariners (1995-96, 2000), Expos (1997-2000), Yankees (2002), Cardinals (2003), White Sox (2005-06) and Orioles (2006), winning a World Series with Chicago in 2005.
- Widger and his wife, Whitney, reside in Pennsville, N.J., with their children: C.J., Ashlynn and Skylar.

- Derrick Lewis is in his third season with the Royals' organization and second as pitching coach at Northwest Arkansas.






