HAPPY OPENING NIGHT: Following an incredible inaugural season in 2021 that saw the Trash Pandas post a 54-56 record, Rocket City Trash Pandas baseball returns with Opening Night in Birmingham. This will be the first game the Trash Pandas have ever played in April after the 2021 season began in May. Tonight's contest marks the first of a three-game series and the first of 30 games between Rocket City and Birmingham, with the matchups to be evenly split between Regions Field and Toyota Field.

BACK IN BIRMINGHAM: The Trash Pandas open their second season against their closest rival with the trip south to Birmingham's Regions Field. The Barons and Trash Pandas had many heated matchups in 2021, with the Barons winning the season series 16-8, including 9-3 at Regions Field. In September 2021, the Trash Pandas and Barons were tied atop the North Division standings when the teams met in Birmingham for a crucial six-game series. The Barons swept the Trash Pandas and ultimately won the North Division title.

NEW MAN IN CHARGE: On 2/25, the Angels named Andy Schatzley the second manager in Trash Pandas history. Schatzley, 37, spent the 2021 season as the manager for High-A Tri-City, where the Dust Devils went 43-68 in Schatzley's first season as a professional manager. He was set to lead Rookie-Level Orem in 2020 before the season was cancelled. Schatzley previously served as Associate Head Coach at Harding University in Searcy, Arkansas for the previous eight seasons. Joining Schatzley on the coaching staff will be Pitching Coach Michael Wuertz, Hitting Coach Kenny Hook, and Coach Dann Bilardello.

ARMS RACE: At the 2020 MLB Draft, the Angels used all 20 of their selections on pitchers. Six of those pitchers begin the season with Rocket City, led by second-round selection Ky Bush, who will start for the Trash Pandas at home next week against Pensacola. All three starters for Rocket City this weekend were drafted last year, with Brett Kerry (5th round) starting tonight, Mason Erla (17th round) going tomorrow, and Chase Silseth (11th round) starting on Sunday. Starting the season in the bullpen will be 4th round selection Luke Murphy and 14th round pick Eric Torres.

RETURNING TO REGIONS FIELD: Among the relievers up in the Trash Pandas bullpen will be 26-year-old right-hander Luis Ledo, who spent the entire 2021 season with the Birmingham Barons. Last year, he went 4-1 with a 4.17 ERA and four saves in his ninth and final season in the Chicago White Sox system and first at the Double-A level. Ledo pitched against the Trash Pandas six times last year and was sharp, going 2-0 with a 1.29 ERA and one save while striking out 10 in 7.0 innings.

TONIGHT'S STARTING PITCHER: RHP Brett Kerry will get the ball for the Trash Pandas tonight to begin his first full professional season. Making his sixth career start, Kerry will pitch at the Double-A level for the second time after making one start for the Trash Pandas in 2021. On 9/10/21, Kerry pitched 5.0 scoreless innings in Birmingham, walking one and striking out two for a no-decision. The Barons ended up winning the game, handing the Trash Pandas their fifth loss in a season-long eight-game losing streak. Kerry began 2021 in college at South Carolina as the team's game one starter and went 5-1 in 17 appearances before getting drafted by the Angels in the fifth round.

PROSPECT RANKINGS: The Trash Pandas' current roster features six of the Angels' Top 30 prospects (according to MLB.com): left-handed pitcher Ky Bush (Angels' No. 5), Infielder Jeremiah Jackson (No. 8), right-handed pitcher Chase Silseth (No. 18), right-handed pitcher Coleman Crow (No. 22), right-handed pitcher Mason Erla (No. 25) and right-handed pitcher Luke Murphy (No. 29).

NEW IN 2022: After the Trash Pandas played in Double-A South in 2021, they will play in the Southern League in 2022 and beyond. That came in March when Major League Baseball announced the return of historical names for the 11 leagues that comprise the player development system for MLB's 30 clubs. Also new this season, the Southern League Championship season will be played as a split season (i.e. the season will be divided into two halves). For the Trash Pandas, the first half will end on Sunday, 6/26 at Birmingham after the 69th game of the season and the second half will begin with game number 70 on 6/28 at Tennessee. The format of the Southern League Playoffs will consist of four teams, the division winners for each half from the North and South Division, participating in a best-of-three Division Series followed by a best-of-three Championship Series.

WHAT IS A TRASH PANDA?

The name was chosen in a name-the-team contest and is a reference to the area's association with the space industry and the determination and ingenuity of raccoons, aka trash pandas.

Trash Pandas, slang for raccoon, was included in the original 10 nominations following several Brandiose-led focus groups in Madison and Huntsville. The ballot descriptor read: Our community is known for engineering, and no creature in our galaxy is as smart, creative, determined and ingenious a problem solver - dedicated to the challenge at hand - as our local raccoons!

In July 2018, after the results from several focus groups in Madison and Huntsville, 10 names were selected, based on their uniqueness and how each name relates to the characteristics of the area: (Alphabetically) Army Ants, Comet Jockeys, GloWorms, Lunartics, Moon Possums, Puffy Head Bird Legs, Space Chimps, Space Sloths, ThunderSharks and Trash Pandas. The focus groups were led by San Diego-based Brandiose, the Minor League Baseball industry's premiere branding partner.

Over the next few weeks, two rounds of online voting took place. The first round narrowed the list to Comet Jockeys, Moon Possums, Space Chimps, ThunderSharks and Trash Pandas.

Trash Pandas won the final round with 44.75 percent of the vote to ThunderSharks 19.25 percent. Moon Possums was third (12.57 percent); Space Chimps fourth (12.05 percent); and Comet Jockeys fifth (11.38 percent).

By the way, Trash Pandas dominated both rounds.

More than 28,500 nominations and votes were recorded. According to Brandiose, this represented - by far - the largest community participation in a Name the Team contest in the history of Minor League Baseball.

The team name was announced in a local microbrewery in September 2018 with nearly 1,500 fans on hand. Trash Pandas was nominated by Matthew Higley of Lacey's Spring, Ala. He received two box seats for the first five seasons and will throw out the ceremonial first pitch at a Trash Pandas home game.

The regional identifier was also chosen by the community. Out of 13,559 votes cast, 67.4 percent chose Rocket City over North Alabama (18.09 percent) and Madison (14.51 percent).



NEW MiLB RULES FOR 2022

Press Release From Major League Baseball - March 14, 2022

Major League Baseball announced a variety of experimental playing rules that have been approved by the Competition Committee and the Playing Rules Committee for use during the 2022 Minor League season. Consistent with the preferences of fans, these rules are designed to improve the pace of play, create more action on the field, and reduce player injuries.

Many experimental rules were first tested on a limited basis in 2021. The use of the most promising rules has been expanded to additional levels of play, providing more players and fans with exposure to the rules and allowing the Competition Committee to better evaluate the impact of each on game play. Below is a summary of the experimental rules that will be tested during the 2022 Minor League season:



PITCH TIMER: On-field timers will be used at all full-season affiliates to enforce regulations designed to create a crisp pace of play, with batters required to be ready to hit and pitchers required to deliver the pitch within allotted periods of time. With runners on base, pitchers will have additional allotted time for each pitch but will risk automatic baserunner advancement if a third pick-off attempt or step-off within the same plate appearance is made without recording an out. These rules were used in tandem in the Low-A West and in the Arizona Fall League in 2021 and led to a significant improvement in pace of play and a reduction in average game time of more than 20 minutes.

LARGER BASES: The size of first, second and third base will be increased from 15 inches square to 18 inches square at all full-season affiliates to reduce player injuries. Bigger bases were used in 2021 at the Triple-A level and in the Arizona Fall League, and were associated with a decrease in the severity of base-related injuries. In addition, the reduction in distance between bases led to a modest increase in the rate of successful stolen base attempts.

DEFENSIVE POSITIONING: In Double-A, High-A and Low-A, the defensive team must have a minimum of four players on the infield, with at least two infielders completely on either side of second base. These restrictions on defensive positioning are intended to allow infielders to better showcase their athleticism, to increase batting average on balls in play, and to restore a more traditional set of aesthetics and outcomes on batted balls.

ANDY SCHATZLEY — MANAGER

Born: October 23, 1984, Paragould, Arkansas.

Managerial/Coaching Career: Begins his third season with the Angels organization at the helm of the Trash Pandas for their second season ... In his professional managerial debut, led High-A Tri-City to a 43-68 record in 2021 where he coached future Trash Pandas standouts including Brendon Davis, Kolton Ingram, Davis Daniel, Ryan Smith, and Cristopher Molina ... Was slated to debut with Rookie-Level Orem in 2020, but the season was cancelled due to the pandemic ... Prior to joining the Angels, Schatzley spent eight seasons as an Associate Head Baseball Coach at Harding University in Searcy, Arkansas ... Previously, he came to Harding from Emporia State University in Emporia, Kansas where he worked as an assistant in 2011 ... During the 2009-10 seasons, he was a Graduate Assistant at Lubbock Christian University, where he won a NAIA title in 2009 ... Also was the Head Coach of the Outer Banks Daredevils of the Coastal Plain League, a summer wood bat league for collegiate players ... Served as Head Coach of the El Dorado Broncos of the Jayhawk League from 2009-10, including a National Baseball Congress World Series title in 2009.

Playing Career: Played at Pratt Community College in Pratt, Kansas from 2004-06 and Lyon College in Batesville, Arkansas (2006-08) ... Earned a master's at Lubbock Christian University in organizational leadership in 2010.



MICHAEL WUERTZ — PITCHING COACH

Born: December 15, 1978, Austin, Minnesota

Resides: Scottsdale, Arizona

Coaching Highlights: The first pitching coach in franchise history, Wuertz returns for his second season with the Trash Pandas after 10 former Rocket City pitchers made their MLB debut for the Angels in 2021 ... He spent three of the previous four seasons played with High-A Inland Empire ... In 2018, he was the Pitching Coach for Rookie-level Orem ... Was scheduled to return to Inland Empire in 2020 before the MiLB season was cancelled.

Playing Career: Pitched in 426 Major League games over eight seasons between the Chicago Cubs (2004-08) and Oakland Athletics (2009-11) ... Posted a 21-11 record and 11 saves with 444 strikeouts over 414.1 career innings for a solid 9.6 strikeouts per nine innings ... Led American League relievers and tied for second in the Majors with a career-high 102 strikeouts in 2009, becoming the third A's reliever after Rollie Fingers (1972-73, 75-76) and Dennis Eckersley (1987) to fan 100 in a season ... Made MLB debut for the Cubs in 2004 and spent all or parts of five seasons in the Cubs bullpen from 2004-08 ... Appeared in a team-leading 75 games for Chicago in 2005 ... His 265 relief appearances for the Cubs ranked eighth-most in franchise history prior to his trade to Oakland in February 2009 ... Finished his playing career with parts of two seasons for the York Revolution of the Independent Atlantic League from 2013-14.



KENNY HOOK — HITTING COACH

Born: July 6, 1975, Houston, Texas

Resides: Kansas City, Missouri

Managerial/Coaching Highlights: The first hitting coach in Trash Pandas history, Hook begins his second season in Rocket City and third with the Angels after leading a powerful Trash Pandas offense to a Double-A South best 152 home runs in 2021 ... Was scheduled to be the hitting coach for High-A Inland Empire in 2020 ... Spent the previous six seasons played in the Texas Rangers organization ... Started as the hitting coach for the Arizona Rookie League Rangers from 2014-15 before moving up to Class-A Short Season Spokane in 2016, followed by a season with both Class-A Hickory in 2017 and Class-AA Advanced Down East in 2018 ... He returned to Spokane in 2019 for his first season managing in affiliated baseball and led the Indians to the Northwest League playoffs after posting a 45-31 record. However, the Indians were eliminated in the first round of the postseason ... Prior to his stint with the Rangers, he began his coaching career as the hitting coach for the Kansas City T-Bones of the Independent American Association in 2011 while also working as an assistant head coach at Maple Woods Community College ... Became manager of the T-Bones in 2012 and in his first season as a manager at any level, he led Kansas City to a 51-49 record in 2012 before posting a 40-60 record in 2013.

Playing Career: Played collegiately for Crowder College (Neosho, MO) and Benedictine College (Atchinson, KS) ... Made his pro debut for the Amarillo Dillas from 1997-2000 and was a part of their 1999 Texas-Louisiana League Championship club ... After a year off, played in 38 games as a player/coach for the Central League's Rio Grande Valley WhiteWings in 2002 ... Over 351 games in his five-year pro career, hit .277 (360-1300) with six HR and 192 RBI.



DANN BILARDELLO — COACH

Born: May 26, 1959, Santa Cruz, California

Resides: West Palm Beach, Florida

Managerial/Coaching Highlights: Enters his first season in the Angels organization after spending most of the last 15 years in the Cardinals system ... Managed High-A Palm Beach (2014, 2017-20), Double-A Springfield (2015-16), Low-A Peoria (2013), and Rookie-Level Batavia (2010-12) after he was a minor league catching instructor from 2006-09 ... Won a Pioneer League Championship in his managerial debut for the Great Falls Dodgers in 2002 ... Stayed in Dodgers system from 2002-04 before a season in Red Sox organization in 2005.

Playing Career: Appeared in 382 MLB games over eight big league seasons from 1978-1994, playing for the Cincinnati Reds, Montreal Expos, Pittsburgh Pirates, and San Diego Padres ... Hit .204 with 18 home runs, 91 RBI, and 79 RBI in his MLB career ... Also played in over 800 minor league games, hitting .260 with 90 home runs, 385 RBI, and 347 runs ... During his big league career, was teammates with Hall of Famers Tony Gwynn, Johnny Bench, and Andre Dawson.

Before starting his professional baseball career, he worked as an Athletic Trainer for both the Winter X Games and the Texas Tech University Baseball Team.

TRASH TALK

THE KERRY FILE: RHP Brett Kerry gets the Opening Night nod for his sixth professional appearance (all starts) and his second Double-A start in the first game of the Trash Pandas' second season. The Angels' 5th round draft pick in the 2021 draft out of South Carolina made his professional debut with Low-A Inland Empire on 8/12/21 against Rancho Cucamonga and pitched two scoreless innings, allowing two hits with no walks and five strikeouts. His first three starts (6.2 IP) were scoreless with one walk and 12 strikeouts in August before allowing two earned runs in 2.2 innings in his final Low-A Start at Modesto on 9/4. He joined the Trash Pandas on 9/9 and made one start at the end of the season, firing 5.0 scoreless innings at Birmingham on 9/10. With that start against the Barons, Kerry became the second of the Angels' 2021 draft picks to reach Double-A, following 11th round selection Chase Silseth, after Los Angeles selected 20 pitchers in the draft.

VS. BIRMINGHAM: Kerry made his Double-A debut for Rocket City at Birmingham's Regions Field on 9/10/21 and was brilliant, throwing 5.0 scoreless innings with one walk and two strikeouts, getting two double play ground balls and retiring the final three hitters he faced. The Trash Pandas ultimately fell 2-0.

MORE NOTES

GETTING COCKY: Kerry began the 2021 season as a junior for the University of South Carolina and made 17 appearances (three starts) as the team's game-one starter and went 5-1 with a 2.15 ERA and four saves while striking out 84 in 54.1 innings. On May 15, he threw a complete-game shutout at Kentucky on 94 pitches while allowing just four hits with 10 strikeouts. He was named SEC Co-Pitcher of the Week for that performance. In his next start on May 21, Kerry struck out eight to over seven innings to earn another win. Kerry was also named to the 2020-21 SEC Spring Honor Roll. In 2020 for South Carolina, Kerry was 2-0 with a 3.60 ERA and one save in six appearances (two starts) while striking out 18 over 15 innings before the pandemic brought an abrupt end to the season. He struck out a season-high 12 over five innings over Holy Cross on February 15. Before that, he made 22 appearances as a freshman in 2019, going 4-1 with a 2.62 ERA and seven saves, holding opponents to a .200 batting average. He finished 10th in the SEC in ERA in conference games (2.95) and opponents batting average in SEC contests (.208).

HIGH SCHOOL NOTES: Attended Wesleyan Christian Academy in High Point, NC where he was a part of three straight state championship teams from 2016-18. In 2018, he was 10-1 with a 0.60 ERA while striking out 111 and walking just eight in 69.1 innings. He tied current San Diego Padre Wil Myers for career wins at WCA.
