RANCHO CUCAMONGA QUAKES (32-20)

RHP Gabe Emmett (4-1, 3.08 ERA) vs. RHP Shaddon Peavyhouse (4-2, 4.42 ERA)

TODAY'S GAME: The Quakes continue their longest northern road trip of the year with 12 straight games. Tonight is game two of a six-game set against the Modesto Nuts (Mariners) here at John Thurman Field. From here, the Quakes will head to San Jose next week for their one and only visit to Excite Ballpark. The Quakes will return to LoanMart Field on Tuesday, June 20 to take on the Lake Elsinore Storm. Tickets are available at rcquakes.com.

VS THE NUTS: Today's game is the second of nine between the two clubs this year and the second of six at John Thurman Field. Last year, the Quakes went 3-3 here at John Thurman Field and 5-7 overall against the Nuts.

LAST GAME: The Quakes managed just five hits and were routed on Tuesday, dropping a 10-3 decision to the Modesto Nuts at John Thurman Field. The Nuts pounded out ten hits and slugged a pair of home runs, including a three-run shot from Tatem Levins in the seventh that helped put the game away. Rancho starter Peter Heubeck (0-4) suffered the loss, as he allowed four runs on three hits over three innings. Modesto reliever Blake Townsend (2-2) was credited with the win. Rancho's Nick Biddison was the only Quake with a multi-hit game, as he went 2-for-4.

NEWELL HANGOVER: The Quakes' offense has scuffled without what was probably the league's MVP, but since CF Chris Newell's promotion to High-A, it's been really struggling. Their first game without Newell, they endured their first shutout of the year, as they dropped game one of the Inland Empire series. The Quakes scored just one run in each of their last two games against the 66ers. Last night's opener against Modesto saw them score three runs on just five hits two of the three runs coming on a wild pitch and a bases-loaded walk, respectively. Rancho's offense is currently ranked fourth with a .250 batting average. They are still tops with 51 home runs in 52 games.

STANDINGS UPDATE: The Quakes still have a 4.5 game lead over Lake Elsinore with 14 to play in the first half. Despite losing five of their last seven, that lead of 4.5 games is just one game off of the high-water mark, as the Rancho lead over Lake Elsinore has fluctuated between 5.5 and 2.5 over the last three weeks. Remaining games for the Quakes include five at Modesto, six at North-leading San Jose, then home for three games against the Storm to finish the first half. Lake Elsinore's remaining games include five at Fresno, Stockton at home for six, then three at Rancho.

SERIES STUFF: The Quakes had not lost a series at any point here in 2023, but that all changed with Sunday's loss to Inland Empire, giving the 66ers four of six and sending Rancho to their first series defeat this year. The Quakes were faced with this same dilemma last week against the Storm after dropping the first three, only to recover and win the final three to salvage a split. Rancho is now 6-1-2 in series overall, splitting at Visalia and vs LE.

KARROS NAMED PITCHER OF THE MONTH: Right-hander Jared Karros had a terrific May for the Quakes and on Monday, was named the Cal League Pitcher of the Month. In May, Karros went 1-0 with an ERA of 1.40 over four starts and five appearances. He did not allow an earned run in three of his five outings and did not allow more than three hits in an outing. Karros was a Dodgers 16th-rounder in the 2022 draft out of UCLA.

GABE EMMETT: Right-hander Gabe Emmett makes his 14th appearance and first start for the Quakes, his first against Modesto. In his last outing, he fired five scoreless, hitless innings in a win against the 66ers on June 2, allowing just two walks with four strikeouts. The Sacramento native was drafted by the Dodgers in the 19th round of the 2021 draft out of Folsom Lake Community College, located about 90 miles from Modesto.

SHADDON PEAVYHOUSE: Righty Shaddon Peavyhouse makes his 11th start of the year for the Nuts, his first against Rancho. In his last outing overall, he allowed three runs (two earned) on three hits with four walks and strikeouts over six innings in a win at Stockton on June 1. The Mariners signed Peavyhouse as an undrafted free agent in February of 2023 out of the University of North Carolina.
