Tonight: The Lugnuts play the finale of a six-game series against the South Bend Cubs, the 12th home game in 13 days for the Lugnuts. Lansing is 5-6 thus far during its 12-game homestand against Great Lakes and South Bend, losing four of six to the Loons before winning three of five against the Cubs. Away from the baseball, enjoy a Capital City Market Kids Day with gates opening at 12 noon and 1st pitch at 1 p.m., plus post-game Kids Run the Bases.

On Deck: Tomorrow is a day off on Monday before the Lugnuts open a six-game series at West Michigan on Tuesday.

On the Air: Today's game is on MiLB.TV with audio available online via http://milb.streamguys1.com/lansing featuring broadcasters Jesse Goldberg-Strassler and Adam Jaksa.

Last Night: Lugnuts 9, Cubs 3. Nuts starter Colin Peluse dominated with ten strikeouts in 5 2/3 innings, and two Lugnuts relievers struck out six subsequent Cubs batters in the easy Lugnuts win. The Nuts' offense scored runs in every at-bat save for the fifth and eighth innings.

What's New in 2021: Entering this season, the Lugnuts' stadium name changed from Cooley Law School Stadium to Jackson® Field™, the Nuts moved up to the High-A Central, and they accepted an invitation to affiliate with the Oakland Athletics, the Nuts' fourth MLB partner, following the Kansas City Royals (1996-98), Chicago Cubs (1999-2004) and Blue Jays (2005-2020).

Lug•Notes: Headlines and Points of Interest

Meet the Boss: Scott Steinmann is the 16th manager in Lugnuts team history. Born in Dayton, Steinmann joins the Lugnuts after three straight seasons assigned to manage Double-A Midland (though the 2020 season was canceled). Steinmann previously managed against the Lugnuts with Wisconsin (2005), Clinton (2009, 2014-15) and Beloit (2017). More info about the skipper can be found on the next page of these notes

Roster News: On Friday the Lugnuts placed outfielder Austin Beck on the Injured List and reinstated infielder Jordan Díaz from the temporarily inactive list.

Highs and Lows: The Lugnuts have scored at least seven runs in a game 11 times this season, but have also scored three runs or fewer in a game in 15 games. If the offense does get going, chances are it's going to happen either late: Lansing's biggest inning this year is the 8th (25 runs).

Keys to Success: When Lansing scores more than two runs in a game, the club is 13-4. When it scores two runs or fewer, the record is just 1-11. Another one for you: When the Nuts outhit the opposition, they are 11-1 this season. When they get outhit, however, they are just 1-13.

In the Big Inning: The Lugnuts' best innings this season have been the sixth and eighth innings, scoring 24 and 25 runs in those innings... but the team's worst inning is the third inning, allowing 26 runs total this season.

A Hail to Arms: The Lugnuts' pitching staff tops the High-A Central with a 3.13 earned run average and has walked the second-fewest batters (89), struck out the second-most hitters (311), allowed the second-fewest home runs (18) and recorded the best GO/AO ratio (1.32) in the league.

A Breath of Relief: The bulloen has been a strength for the Lugnuts, with a 2.79 ERA and 190 strikeouts compared to 46 walks in 142 innings. The Lugnuts' relief corps has not allowed a run to South Bend in either of the last two games.

Getting Hits and Getting Hit: The Nuts lead the league in at-bats (932), doubles (65) and HBPs (30), rank second in batting average (.240), at-bats (965), doubles (66) and total bases (382), third in base hits (232), and second in fewest strikeouts (252), and rank fourth in sluggins (.396) and OPS (.730).

Thou Shalt Not: Stealing bases has been a difficult proposition against the Nuts, who have nabbed a league-best 15 runners in 50 attempts, with Jared McDonald cutting down Yonathan Perlaza in a botched South Bend hit-and-run on Thursday night.

An Eagle Flying High: Infielder Max Schuemann (Portage Northern H.S. / Eastern Michigan University) is first in the league in HBPs (9), second in OBP (.426), second in runs scored (26), third in steals (19), tied for fourth in extra-base hits (14) and fifth in OPS (.920).

Streaking: Infielder Max Schuemann went 1-for-4 with a walk last night to increase his on-base streak to 23 games (23-for-83, .277, with 12 walks and eight HBPs). Outfielder Michael Guldberg enters play today on a 18-game on-base streak, hitting .304 (21-for-69) with six walks and two HBPs in that span.

TODAY IN LUGNUTS HISTORY

2012: An 11-inning game in two hours and 44 minutes? Sure! Kevin Patterson's RBI single in the bottom of the 11th gave the Lugnuts a 5-4 victory over Bowling Green.

Major League Lugnuts: Two former Nuts have made their Major League debuts this season, pitcher Ty Tice '18 and outfielder Josh Palacios '16-'17, with the duo making their first MLB appearance in the same game for the Toronto Blue Jays on April 9th. It was the seventh time in team history that two Lugnuts made their MLB debut in the same game, with the first occurring on September 14, 1998: Carlos Febles and Carlos Beltrán for the Kansas City Royals.

Familiar Settings: 14 of the 30 Lugnuts active players came through the Midwest League in Beloit on their way up the Athletics' ladder, and coaching staff members Scott Steinmann, Don Schulze and Anthony Phillips all have experience in the league.

A Lineup of Starters: The Lugnuts have used nine starting pitchers this year, namely Brady Basso, Reid Birlingmair, Jeff Criswell, Stevie Emanuels, Richard Guasch, Rafael Kelly, Colin Peluse, Seth Shuman and Shohei Tomioka.

A Pleasant Peninsula Surrounds You: Max Schuemann (Portage Northern H.S.) is the first Lugnut from Eastern Michigan University, and Jeff Criswell (Portage Central H.S.) and Jack Weisenburger (Rockford H.S.) are the fourth and fifth Michigan Wolverines to play in Lansing (following Troy Miller, Jake Fox and Rich Hill).

Finally: Pitchers Jeff Criswell, Stevie Emanuels and Shohei Tomioka, catchers Jared McDonald, Drew Millas and William Simoneit, first baseman Patrick McColl, and outfielders Michael Guldberg and Jake Suddleson are all making their pro debut this season.

Front Office Connections: Lugnuts pitching coach Don Schulze was drafted 11th overall by the Chicago Cubs in 1980, 12 picks before Oakland Executive Vice President of Baseball Operations Billy Beane was drafted by the New York Mets. Lugnuts first baseman Patrick McColl set a new Harvard baseball single season record with 70 hits in 2019, breaking the previous record held by Athletics General Manager David Forst.

Clubhouse of Higher Learning: The Ivy League is well represented on the Lansing roster. Outfielder Jake Suddleson and first baseman Patrick McColl played for Harvard, reliever Michael Danielak was drafted from Dartmouth and catcher William Simoneit spent four years at Cornell before grad-transferring to Wake Forest.

Power Five Baseball: The Lugnuts also represent the ACC (Michael Guldberg, Georgia Tech); Big 12 (Brady Basso, Oklahoma State); Big Ten (Jeff Criswell and Jack Weisenburger, Michigan; Dalton Sawyer, Minnesota); and the SEC (Cobie Vance, Alabama, and Ryan Gridley, Mississippi State); and the Pac-12 (Stevie Emanuels, Washington).

International Appeal: In addition to 16 different states (Arizona, California, Delaware, Georgia, Illinois, Louisiana, Maryland, Massachusetts, Michigan, Minnesota, Nevada, North Carolina, Ohio, Texas, Virginia, Washington) represented by Lugnuts players and coaching staff, seven nations are represented: USA, Colombia, Cuba, Dominican Republic, Japan, South Africa and Venezuela.

Teammates Then, Teammates Now: Several of the Nuts are familiar with one another. Jake Suddleson and Patrick McColl played together at Harvard, Reid Birlingmair and Charlie Cerny pitched together at the University of Illinois at Chicago, and Jeff Criswell and Jack Weisenburger pitched together in Ann Arbor. The Lugnuts also have a pair of Wake Forest Demon Deacons, but William Simoneit played only one year at Wake, 2020, thus missing Colin Peluse by a year.





Last Outing: Started on Sunday, May 30 vs. Great Lakes... unlike prior three starts, was unable to help Lugnuts earn a series split, giving up four runs on five hits in four innings... allowed two runs in the 1st and 3rd innings (an Andy Pages two-run homer)... struck out four and walked two... Lugnuts lost, 6-2.

2021 in Lansing:

- Started the series finale vs. Lake County on Sunday, May 9th... worked 4 1/3 innings in his professional debut, allowing two hits, one walk and one run, striking out five in a no-decision... difficult 1st inning saw Stevie need 35 pitches: set down the first two batters but allowed a single, a walk and an HBP to load the bases before escaping on a groundout with Bryce Nightengale warming up in the bullpen; if he had not induced the groundout, he would have been pulled... set down next 11 batters with ease before departing after giving up a single to Joe Naranjo... exited with Lugnuts leading, 3-0... Nightengale subsequently allowed Naranjo to score... Lugnuts went on to win the game, 5-2.

- Started Sunday, May 16th at Dayton, earning the win in a Lugnuts 3-1 triumph over the Dragons... pitched five scoreless innings, allowing two hits and a walk, striking out four... allowed a leadoff single to Brian Rey in the 1st, but induced a double play from Jose Tello to face the minimum... struck out both Miguel Hernandez and Mariel Bautista to end a perfect 2nd... began the 3rd with strikeouts of both Bren Spillane and Francisco Urbaez... all four consecutive strikeouts were looking... recorded a perfect 4th... streak of 13 straight batters retired was broken with two outs in the 5th by a Mariel Bautista double and Bren Spillane walk... catcher Drew Millas picked off Spillane at first base to end the inning and Emanuels's outing.

- Started at Fort Wayne, Sunday, May 23rd... struck out six in 3 1/3 innings while allowing three runs on three hits and four walks... relievers Hall, McIntyre and Weisenburger combined for 5 2/3 scoreless innings and the Lugnuts' offense rallied for seven runs from the 6th-8th innings, including a four-run 8th, for an 8-3 victory... Max Schuemann homered on the first pitch of the game.



Draft Day: Selected 157th overall in the 5th round, 2020 from the University of Washington (the "Huskies")... scout: Jim Continan, who also signed Lugnuts catcher Jared McDonald (Western Oregon) and current Oakland A's outfielder Seth Brown... signed for \$400,000... drafted three picks before the end of the draft... one of three 2020 Oakland draft picks on the Lugnuts (Jeff Criswell, 2nd round; Michael Guldberg, 3rd round)... one of nine Lugnuts on the roster to make his professional debut this year.

Personal: Born in Seattle... played three years in Little League for, coincidentally, the A's, and still has his old A's baseball cap... younger brother, Josh, is currently a pitcher at Washington, standing 6'3... uncle, Jake, also played baseball for Washington.

Hometown: Bellevue is the third largest city in the Seattle metropolitan area ("belle vue" in French means "beautiful view"; it's situated across Lake Washington from Seattle)... Amazon was founded in Bellevue in Jeff Bezos's garage on July 5, 1994... many companies are headquartered in Bellevue, notably T-Mobile USA, the North American headquarters for Pokémon, QFC, Expedia Group, Coinstar and Eddie Bauer.

Glory Days: Attended Interlake High School... rated by Baseball Northwest as Washington's No. 1 baseball recruit in the Class of 2017... rated by Perfect Game as Washington's No. 4 right-handed pitcher... Interlake's alumni includes John Olerud, Larry Andersen, Jim Mora Jr., and actor Timothy Omundson.

Life as a Huskie: Ascended from setup man to closer to ace starting pitcher from freshman to junior year at Washington... broke the Washington freshman record with 34 relief appearances, tied for second most in school history for a single season; led all freshmen in the Pac-12 in appearances... also led Washington as a freshman in wins (8-2, 4.37, 45 1/3 IP, 2 HR, 28 BB, 32 K)... followed up a sophomore in 2019 with 31 appearances (2.35 ERA, 6 saves, 53 2/3, 3 HR, 22 BB, 65 K)... made four starts as a junior, including 13-K, 6-IP gem vs. Fresno State, before season was shut down (0.79, 22 2/3 IP, 2 ER, 0 HR, 9 BB, Pac-12 leading 38 K)... 15.1 K/9.0-IP ranked 16th in the country... named a 2020 3rd Team All-American by The Collegiate Baseball.

Washington Nationals... and American Leaguers, too: Notable Huskies in MLB history include Tim Lincecum, Mike Blowers, Jim Colborn, Fred Hutchinson, Jeff Heath, Jake Lamb, Andrew Kittredge, Adam Cimber, Austin Voth, Braden Bishop, Jeff Brigham, Kevin Stocker, and the unforgettable Hunky Shaw.
