YESTERDAY'S RECAP

The Baysox split Saturday's doubleheader, losing game one 18-2 but winning game two 4-3. In the first game, Erie struck for seven runs in the first inning as **Zach Fruit** failed to record an out. The SeaWolves also scored six in the fourth inning. **Anthony Servideo** went 2-for-3 with an RBI double and pitched two scoreless frames. In the second game, **Trace Bright** pitched 5.2 hitless innings to pick up his first Double-A win. **Hudson Haskin** tripled home two runs, Servideo doubled in another run and **Yaqui Rivera** closed things out for his first Double-A save.

A WIN TODAY WOULD....

A win today would secure a series win over the Erie SeaWolves and back-to-back series victories to start the season. The Baysox won one of three series meetings against Erie last year with the most recent two ending in splits. The last time Chesapeake won its first two series of the season was in 2021.

ELECTRIC ENRIQUE

Before being placed on the injured list Friday, OF **Enrique Bradfield Jr.** started the season on a six-game hit streak. The Orioles No. 3 prospect begins his first full season in Double-A after swiping the second-most bases in the Minors last year with 74 stolen bags. The O's' 17th overall selection in 2023 led all O's minor leaguers in runs scored and received a Minor League Gold Glove Award after recording only two errors all season. **On Tuesday, Bradfield stole his first base of the season and the 100th of his career with a swipe of third.**

CREED CRUSHES

C **Creed Willems** begins his first full season in Chesapeake. The Orioles No. 12 prospect matched his career-high with 17 homers and set a new career-high with 65 RBI last season. Willems raked in the Arizona Fall League and was named a Fall League All Star after batting .338 with an .891 OPS.

READY FOR REILLY

RHP **Pat Reilly** is set to make his second start of the series after making his season debut on Tuesday. The Orioles No. 10 prospect delivered 4.1 shutout innings and allowed one run on two hits and three walks and struck out three in a no decision. Reilly was acquired by the Orioles from the Pirates in last year's trade deadline for former Baysox UTL Billy Cook. In four career outings vs Erie, Reilly holds a 4.20 ERA over 15.0 innings pitched.

MEET THE SQUAD

Chesapeake's 2025 Opening Day roster features 19 returners from last year and nine newcomers. Of the returners, five are top 30 Orioles prospects with three in the top 15, according to MLB Pipeline. OF Enrique Bradfield Jr. (No. 3), RHP Patrick Reilly (No. 10), C Creed Willems (No. 12), RHP Trace Bright (No. 25) and RHP Alex Pham (No. 29) all return to Bowie while notable newcomers include top-20 O's prospect RHP Juan Nunez (No. 20), RHP Zach Fruit, former Royal RHP Dylan Coleman and non-roster Spring Training invitee IF Jeremiah Jackson.

THE CHAMPS HAVE ARRIVED

The Erie SeaWolves are on a quest for a third consecutive Eastern League title after defending their crown last year against Somerset. The Double-A affiliate of the Detroit Tigers finished 77-58 last year and clinched the first half of the season. Erie's active roster features nine Tigers' Top 30 prospects (MLB.com), C/1B Thayron Liranzo (No. 5), RHP Jaden Hamm (No. 9), RHP Troy Melton (No. 12), LHP Jake Miller (No. 17), RHP Joseph Montalvo (No. 19), OF Roberto Campos (No. 22), IF Max Anderson (No. 23), OF Justice Bigbie (No. 27) and RHP RJ Petit (No. 30).

TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

LHP Jake Miller is Erie's scheduled starter for today's series finale. The Tigers No. 17 prospect pitched across three levels last season beginning in Single-A Lakeland, earning promotion to High-A West Michigan, and rising all the way to Double-A Erie for one spot start. The spot start came against Chesapeake during the final week of the season and he pitched five scoreless innings. Miller is an 8th round pick by the Tigers in the 2022 Draft out of Valparaiso University.

CHESAPEAKE OYSTER CATCHERS



For select home games, the Chesapeake Baysox will take the field as the Chesapeake Oyster Catchers as a tribute to the Chesapeake Bay's rich heritage and thriving ecosystem.

Inspired by the American oystercatcher, the prominent patterned shorebird can be found along the Chesapeake Bay year-round. With its bold black-and-white plumage, orange beak, and knack for hunting shellfish, the oystercatcher is a symbol of strength and ingenuity—qualities that define both the Chesapeake region and its passionate baseball fans.

The Oyster Catchers name also pays homage to the Chesapeake Bay's rich maritime traditions and oyster restoration efforts, celebrating the region's deep connection to its waters.

CANGREJOS FANTASMAS DE CHESAPEAKE



The Cangrejos Fantasmas De Chesapeake (Chesapeake Ghost Crabs) are a part of MiLB's "Copa de la DiversiónTM" or "Fun CupTM"- a season-long event series specifically designed to embrace the culture and values that resonate most with Minor League BaseballTM teams' local U.S. Hispanic communities.

Boasting a desire to better represent the Chesapeake Bay area, Bowie's "Cangrejos Fantasmas de Chesapeake" identiy came to light after research presented the existence of the small, yet active Atlantic Ghost Crab species in the bay.

BOWIE PIT BEEF



The "Bowie Pit Beef" is an alternate identity of the Chesapeake Baysox that pays tribute to the culinary culture of Maryland.

Pit Beef consists of top round cuts of beef, thinly sliced and prepared over a charcoal fire. The meat is cooked quickly at high temperatures and has a slight smoked flavor. The sandwich got its name on Baltimore's east side in the 1970s, before being popularized by the 1980s.
