Marte was the headline piece that came back to the Reds in the trade that sent former Reds ace Luis Castillo to the Mariners. Marte ranked as the Mariners No. 1 prospect before the trade, and now ranks as the Reds No. 1 prospect per MLB Pipeline.
- Infielder Jose Torres hit the first grand slam of the year for the Dragons last Thursday against Peoria. It was part of a seven run third inning for Dayton that propelled them to their second win of the series.
