LEITER, TANIELU PILOT RIDERS TO GAME TWO WIN OVER AMARILLO:

The Frisco RoughRiders posted an eight-run fifth inning and **Jack Leiter** set a career high with 10 strikeouts in Wednesday's 10-4 win over the Amarillo Sod Poodles at Riders Field. Leiter (2-2) carried a shutout into the sixth inning before allowing a pair of singles and a home run. The RoughRiders (15-19) have won the first two games of the series against Amarillo (15-20). Leiter allowed just four hits and three runs in six innings. He has now struck out 54 batters in 37 innings this season. **Nick Tanielu** started the scoring for the second day in a row with a solo leadoff home run in the fifth. He capped off the same inning with a two-run blast as Frisco totaled eight runs on seven hits. Tanielu's second homer of the inning scored **Dustin Harris**, who had an RBI double moments earlier. **Evan Carter** tripled for two RBIs during the fifth inning as well. **Trevor Hauver** got Frisco to double digits with an RBI single in the eighth inning. Frisco went 6-for-10 with runners in scoring position on Wednesday. **Alex Speas** and **Antoine Kelly** chipped in scoreless innings coming out of the Frisco bullpen, which has allowed just one run through the first two games of the series.

SINGLE-INNING HISTORY:

On Wednesday, Nick Tanielu hammered two home runs in the fifth inning for the Riders. It was the first time in franchise history that a player hit two home runs in the same inning. It was also the fourth multi-home run game for Tanielu in his career. The 30-year-old veteran is on fire at the plate, riding a seven-game hitting streak while batting .385/.467/.923/1.390 with four home runs and eight RBIs.

PERFECT TIMING:

The RoughRiders took down the Amarillo Sod Poodles 3-2 on Tuesday for their first win in games decided by one run or two runs on the season. **Dustin Harris'** solo home run in the eighth was also the first game-winning hit for the RoughRiders in their final at-bat on the year and the first time they won when tied in the sixth inning or later.

TOP 100 RERANKING:

MLB.com has reranked their Top 100 prospects and the RoughRiders have four Top 100 players that have seen some movement. Outfielder **Evan Carter** is now the No. 11 prospect in baseball (previously No. 36) while pitcher **Owen White** is No. 51, infielder **Luisangel Acuña** places at No. 58 and pitcher **Jack Leiter** is at No. 80. The Rangers fourth-round pick in 2022, pitcher **Brock Porter**, is the No. 81 prospect as well. He is currently pitching for Low-A Down East.

PITCHING STRUGGLING:

Over the last 18 games, Frisco has a 7.28 ERA, which is the worst in the Texas League over that stretch. The Riders allowed 24 home runs over that stretch, which is the second-most in the league. The Frisco bullpen has a 5.46 this season, which is eighth in the league. After the tough two weeks, Frisco is still seventh in the league with a 5.53 ERA.

THOMAS THE TANK ENGINE:

Through his first 16 games of the season, Saggese was hitting just .203/.254/.281/.535, but he has been on a tear ever since. Over his last 16 games, he is hitting .362 (25-for-69)/.405/.536/.941 with four doubles, a triple, two homers, 4 RBIs and 12 runs. In the month of May, he is batting .351/.373/.491/.864 and has three four-hit games to his name. Saggese is the No. 15 prospect in the Rangers organization by MLB.com.

IT'S ABOUT STRAHM TIME:

RoughRiders outfielder **Kellen Strahm** has been on fire on this road trip after getting off to a tough start this season. Through his first 13 games, he was hitting just .125/.250/.146/.396, but since April 25th to begin the series in Amarillo, he is batting .317/.394/.492/.886 with three doubles, a triple, two home runs and six RBIs while walking eight times. Over the last 16 games, he has raised his average 109 points and his OPS 277 points. It was very similar to last season as Strahm was hitting just .136/.337/.226/.563 on May 14th last season through his first 22 games before slashing .305/.406/.445/.851 over his last 82 games of the season.

ACUÑA MATATA:

RoughRiders infielder **Luisangel Acuña** has been on fire to start his 2023 season. The Rangers No. 3 prospect is hitting .318 (47-for-148)/.378/.459/.837 through the first 34 games while ranking second in the Texas League in hits (47), tied for sixth in doubles (10), fifth in total bases (68) and tied for second in stolen bases (116). Over his last 30 games, he is batting .338/.404/.500/.904. When the 21-year-old arrived in Frisco in 2022, he had a wRC+ of 68 while it has nearly doubled this season (123).

WALK THIS WAY:

On the season, Frisco's 177 walks are first among Texas League teams while their .360 team OBP is third in Double-A. **Dustin Harris** is second in the league with 27 walks while **Evan Carter** is ninth in OBP (.410) in the league and third in the league with 26 walks.

ABOUT RYAN

-Went to La Salle High School in Pasadena, California. There, his senior year, he owned a 1.16 ERA while striking out 48 in 42.1 innings, but played primarily infield.

-Went to UCLA camp as an infielder and asked one of the coaches if he could pitch the last inning of one of the games. He ended up throwing well enough that UCLA invited him out for a visit as a pitcher. He came back two weeks later and committed on the spot.

-At UCLA, he was named Pac-12 Pitcher of the Year and a consensus First Team All-American in 2019 as a junior. Over 16 games (13 starts), Garcia went 10-1 with a 1.44 ERA. In 94.0 innings, he whiffed 117 batters while walking just 26 and holding opponents to a .160 batting average. In his career with the Bruins, he went 20-2 with a 2.11 ERA. His 2.11 career ERA is seventh in UCLA history.

-His best start during his junior year came against Utah on April 26th, 2019. Over a 9.0-inning complete-game, shutout he struck out 14 batters while allowing just three base runners (two hits and one walk). The 14 strikeouts were the most by a UCLA starter since Trevor Bauer in 2011.

-Led the Wareham Gatemen of the Cape Cod League to a championship in 2018, going 2-0 with a 1.28 ERA over 10 outings.

-Now lives in Surprise, Arizona, about two blocks away from the Rangers Spring Training Complex.

2023 SEASON

-In his Double-A debut on April 11th at San Antonio, Garcia allowed just two solo home runs while tying a career-best five innings.

-Allowed career-high eight runs over 2.2 innings against Wichita on 5/10 during a day game.

2022 SEASON

-Was activated in late May while continuing his rehabilitation from injuries.

-His thought for the 2022 season was "I have built a house this season, coming back from injury, and next season, I will be able to fortify the house."

-Averaged 11.8 K/9 over his 14 games (13 starts).

2021 SEASON

-Missed the entire 2021 season with a right lat strain. That required two months of rest and then trying to build back up, but he strained his lat three different times and was unable to get back on the mound.

2019 SEASON

-Three starts into his professional career, he went on the Injured List with a right elbow strain and underwent "Tommy John" surgery on March 16th, 2020.

-During his TJ rehab, he built a computer from scratch and is very interested in technology.
