**Tonight's Game:** The Nashville Sounds take on the Norfolk Tides in game two of their six-game series tonight at First Horizon Park. The Sounds are coming off a thriller extra-inning comeback win last night over the IL East-leading Tides. Southpaw Robert Gasser starts for Nashville, facing Norfolk's Chris Vallimont.

**Robert Gasser:** 23-year-old southpaw Robert Gasser gets the ball for Nashville tonight. The Houston, Texas resident pitched 4.0 scoreless innings in his first start in game one of an April 6th doubleheader at Memphis. He is touted as the No. 10 prospect in the Brewers system by MLB Pipeline. Gasser was traded to the Brewers organization from San Diego as part of the Josh Hader trade on August 1, 2022. He was originally drafted by San Diego in the second round of the 2021 First-Year Player Draft out of the University of Houston.

**Chris Vallimont:** 26-year-old Chris Vallimont starts for the Tides tonight. The righty is making his second appearance (first start) of the 2023 campaign, tossing 4.0 hitless innings and earned the save vs. Gwinnett on April 6. In 2022, Vallimont went 7-9 with a 5.63 ERA (104.0 IP/65 ER) in 26 games (21 starts) between Norfolk (16), Double-A Bowie (3) and Double-A Wichita (7) in the Twins organization. He was claimed off waivers from Minnesota on May 25, 2022. Vallimont was originally drafted by Miami in the fifth round of the 2018 First-Year Player Draft out of Mercyhurst University in Erie, Penn.

**2023 Standings:** The Sounds have spent the following number of days in the International League West Division standings in 2023: First: 1, Second: 4, Third: 2, Fourth: 1, Fifth: 1, Sixth: 1, Seventh: 0.

**Action Jackson:** Alex Jackson completed Nashville's five-run comeback last night, smashing an 11th-inning three-run bomb to walk off the Tides. He also hit a three-run homer last Saturday in Memphis. Jackson is the only Sounds player to have multiple 3-RBI games this year.

**Keston Crushing:** Infielder Keston Hiura went deep for the third time in '23 with a two-run homer in last night's win, his second straight game with a homer. He has hit safely in seven of his last eight games and boasts a 1.049 OPS to start the year.

**Four Four-Baggers:** Jackson, Hiura, Jon Singleton and Tyler Naquin all went yard in last night's win. The last time the Sounds knocked four homers in a game was August 26, 2022 at Durham, when Joey Wiemer (2x), Brice Turang and Singleton each left the ballpark. The last time it happened at home was July 17, 2022 against Memphis (Tyler White, 2x, Weston Wilson, Brian Navarreto).

**Extra, Extra!:** The Sounds have now played in four extra-inning contests through their first 10 games of the season, all coming at First Horizon Park. The only other club in baseball to play four extra-innings games so far this season is Cleveland. Last year, it took Nashville 42 games to play four extra-inning contests, and 87 games to play four extra-inning contests at home.

**Erceg's Excellence:** Reliever Lucas Erceg has not allowed a hit in 7.0 scoreless innings this season, the longest no-hit streak in Minor League Baseball. Erceg is 2-0 and has fanned nine of 23 hitters faced (39%).

**That's a Relief:** Sounds relievers held Norfolk scoreless after having to eat up 10.2 innings after Boushley's short outing on Tuesday. Though they've worked the most innings in the league, the Sounds bullpen holds the lowest ERA at 1.93 and the second-lowest WHIP at 1.11 in the IL. The bullpen has posted a 0.51 ERA (17.2 IP/1 ER) over the last two games.

**Junk to The Show:** Janson Junk was recalled by Milwaukee yesterday and will make his Brewers debut this afternoon. Junk has a 0.90 ERA in two games (one start) with Nashville this season. He ranks among IL leaders in opponent average (4th, .143), WHIP (4th, 0.80) and ERA (6th).

**The Future Brew Crew:** Nashville opens the 2023 season with five players on the roster who are listed on MLB Pipeline's Top-30 Milwaukee prospects. Outfielder Sal Frelick is the No. 2 prospect, left-handed pitcher Robert Gasser is the No. 9 prospect, left-handed pitcher Ethan Small is the No. 13 prospect, right-handed pitcher Janson Junk is the No. 15 prospect and right-handed pitcher Cam Robinson is the No. 24 prospect.

**How Sweet It Is:** Sounds manager Rick Sweet begins his fourth season overall and third consecutive season at the helm of the Nashville club. The reigning International League Manager of the Year, Sweet led the Sounds to a 91-58 record in 2022, 70-58 record in 2021 and a 77-67 record in 2014. He has served as the manager for Milwaukee's Triple-A club since the 2014 season and has compiled a 605-522 record during an eight-season span.
