**JUNE 3<sup>rd</sup> ROCHESTER (22-33) at WORCESTER (28-28) 6:05 pm**

**Rochester Red Wings RHP Cade Cavalli (2-1, 4.82) vs. Worcester Red Sox RHP Robert Stock (3-2, 3.28)**

**Red Sox vs. Red Wings** – The Worcester Red Sox and the Rochester Red Wings (AAA-Washington) open a 6-game series at Polar Park this evening at 6:05 pm. This series marks Rochester's first visit to Worcester this season. Their next trip to Polar Park will come in 15 weeks when the Red Wings close out the 2025 regular season with another 6-game set here vs. the WooSox. But first let's enjoy this week/weekend with the best weather by far since the season began 68 days ago. The clubs will play tonight at 6:05 pm, tomorrow morning at 11:05 am, Thursday & Friday evenings at 6:05 pm, and then over the weekend on Saturday at 4:05 pm and Sunday at 1:05 pm. Tonight's game is live on NESN+ and can be heard on NASH 98.9 FM and The Pike 100.1 FM.

**What Have You Done For Me Lately** – The WooSox are coming off a 6-game series split at Scranton/Wilkes-Barre including a come-from-behind, 7-4 victory on Sunday in the series finale. Worcester is 3-4-3 in their first ten series played this season...three wins, four losses, and three splits. The WooSox are 6-5 in their last 11 games and 10-8 in their last 18. Over a longer stretch they are 14-19 since April 25 after winning 10 of their previous 11 games from April 13-24. Rochester comes into play tonight following a 6-game sweep at home vs. Columbus that extended their season-high winning streak to 7 straight. They are 9-1 in their last 10 games.

**Blazing a Trail to Worcester** – The Boston Red Sox today officially transferred 1B/3B **Blaze Jordan** from Double-A Portland to Worcester. Jordan, 22, has been one of the best players in the Eastern League this season batting .320 in 44 games with 6 HR, 37 RBI, and a .928 OPS while not making an error all season playing 28 games at 1B and 14 games at 3B (0 errors in 200 total chances). Blaze has been especially hot in the month of May when he hit .390 in 26 games last month (32-for-82) with 5 2B, 6 HR, 24 RBI, 18 runs scored along with a 1.161 OPS. As of today he ranks 3<sup>rd</sup> in the Eastern League in batting average (.320), tied for 2<sup>nd</sup> in RBI (37), tied for 3<sup>rd</sup> in runs (30), tied for 6<sup>th</sup> in hits (48), tied for 7<sup>th</sup> in total bases (72), 1<sup>st</sup> in OBP (.415), 6<sup>th</sup> in slugging (.513), and 2<sup>nd</sup> in OPS (.928). Jordan was Boston's 3<sup>rd</sup> round pick (#89 overall) in the 2020 First-Year Player Draft out of DeSoto Central High School in his native Southaven, Mississippi. He won the 2019 High School Home Run Derby at Progressive Field in Cleveland during the MLB All-Star break and was named the 2019-20 Gatorade Mississippi High School Player of the Year. In 403 career Minor League games, the 6'0", 220 lbs. corner infielder has a .290 average with 49 HR & 278 RBI.

**Win Some and Lose Some** – Worcester is 28-28 on the year and thus at the .500 mark for the 15<sup>th</sup> different time this season. These occasions have come at...1-1, 2-2, 3-3, 8-8, 9-9, 14-14, 16-16, 18-18, 20-20, 21-21, 24-24, 25-25, 26-26, 27-27, and 28-28. The WooSox were a season-low 4-games below .500 (4-8) on April 11, but turned things around to reach a season-high of 5-games above .500 on April 24 (14-9).

**Consistency** – Worcester is 13-13 at home compared to 15-15 on the road. Their 28-28 record overall puts them in 4<sup>th</sup>-place and a season-high 12½ GB of 1<sup>st</sup>-place Lehigh Valley. Rochester is 22-33 and tied for 8<sup>th</sup>-place in the IL East and 18 GB of the front-running IronPigs who have the best overall record in the league at 41-16 and are closing in on the first half championship with less than three weeks remaining in the 1<sup>st</sup> half (which ends after games of June 22).

**Hot Sox**

-OF **Roman Anthony** went 0-for-5 on Thursday to snap his streak of reaching base in 24 games in a row (from May 1-28). He has still reached base safely in 44 of his last 46 games since April 9. Among those 44 games on base he has had 37 games with at least one hit and the other 7 games with at least one walk. He also had a 17-game on-base streak from April 9-29. The only times he has not reached base in 46 games came on April 30 vs. Toledo (0-for-4) and May 29 at Scranton/WB (0-for-5). He has reached base safely in 32 of his last 72 plate appearances (15 games) with 17 hits and 15 walks. Roman had his 10-game hitting streak snapped on May 21 (going 0-for-3 with 2 walks), but he has hit in 18 of his last 21 games (25-for-80, .313). He has also hit safely in 29 of his last 35 games (41-for-127, .323) with 29 walks, 6 2B, 1 3B, 4 HR, 10 RBI, and 28 runs scored.

-OF **Jhostynxon Garcia** has hit in 10 of his first 11 games since joining the WooSox on May 20 going 18-for-46 (.391) with 2 2B, 4 HR, 9 RBI, and 7 runs scored.

-INF/OF **Tyler McDonough** has hit safely in 10 of his last 14 games (17-for-49, .347).

-1B/OF **Ryan Noda** has hit in 6 of his first 8 games with the WooSox (8-for-24, .333) with 1 2B, 7 BB, 4 RBI, and 2 runs scored.

-OF **Trayce Thompson** has hit in 10 of his last 15 games (16-for-56, .286) with 2 2B, 3 HR, 7 RBI, and 10 runs scored.

**Among the League Leaders** – Several WooSox are among the Top Ten in the International League in a variety of categories.

**Roman Anthony** is 1<sup>st</sup> in walks (45), 3<sup>rd</sup> in runs (41), 6<sup>th</sup> in hits (59), 5<sup>th</sup> in OBP (.430), 9<sup>th</sup> in OPS (.922), and 5<sup>th</sup> in total bases (96).

**Nate Eaton** is 9<sup>th</sup> in hits (54), 4<sup>th</sup> in doubles (16), and 5<sup>th</sup> in extra-base hits (22).

**Isaiah Campbell** is 5<sup>th</sup> in saves (5).

**RHP Robert Stock** is 8<sup>th</sup> in SO (58) and 5<sup>th</sup> in lowest batting average against (.202).

**May June Be Better and not Wetter** – Worcester is 1-0 in June and they are scheduled to play 25 games in the 30 days in June (12 at home and 13 on the road). The WooSox finished 13-14 in the month of May after going 1-1 in March and 13-13 in April. For those who keep track of such things, this May in Worcester ended with more rain this past Saturday (for the 11<sup>th</sup> straight Saturday) and thus May of 2025 supplanted May of 2024 as the second rainiest month of May in the city’s history with 8.5 inches of the wet stuff. The rainiest Worcester May came in 1984 with 9.94 inches that month.

**Month to Month** - WooSox hitters batted .246 in May with 29 HR & 114 runs scored while Sox pitchers were 13-14 with a 4.84 ERA during the month with 32 HRA and 132 runs allowed. Worcester hit .273 in April with 25 HR & 145 runs scored and WooSox pitchers were 13-13 in April with a 4.74 ERA along with 26 HRA and 128 runs given up.

**Season Series vs. Rochester** – Back in mid-April, the WooSox took 5 of 6 from the Red Wings in Rochester. Worcester grabbed the series-opener on April 15, 7-2. The clubs were snowed-out the next afternoon. Worcester swept the make-up doubleheader on April 17 throwing a 7-inning no-hitter in an 8-0 whitewashing in Game 1 and then needing extra innings (8) to edge the Red Wings, 4-3 in the nightcap. Worcester's 20-7 win on April 18 set a WooSox franchise-record for most hits in a game (26) and tied their club-high for runs in a game (20) while their 6 HR were a season-high. The Red Wings turned the tables the next afternoon scoring 4 runs in both the 1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> innings en route to a 12-3 victory for their only win of the series. The Sox made it 5 out of 6 with a 7-0 shutout win on April 20.

**Stats vs. Rochester** – Worcester batters are hitting .329 in the first six games of the season-series with the Red Wings (73-for-222) with 25 2B, 1 3B, 10 HR, and 49 runs scored along with an OPS of 1.007. Sox pitchers are 5-1 with a 3.96 ERA (22 ER in 50 IP) giving up 24 runs and 8 HR allowed.

**Rolling in Rochester** – Worcester went 5-1 in Rochester this past April 15-20 and have won 29 of their last 38 games in Rochester since the latter part of the 2021 season.

**Worcester/Pawtucket vs. Rochester**– Worcester leads Rochester in the all-time series against each other (since 2021) with 50 victories compared to 41 for the Wings. The Red Wings are 27-20 all-time at Polar Park while the WooSox are 30-14 in Rochester winning 29 of their last 38 games in the Finger Lakes region. Furthermore, Worcester/Pawtucket is up on Rochester with 374 wins against 364 losses in the remarkably close last 45½ years of facing each other since the 1979 season.

**Doing One Better** – The WooSox have won their last four 1-run decisions since May 23 and are now 8-8 in 1-run games on the year after starting the season by dropping 8 of their first dozen 1-run decisions.

**Home Run Derby** – The WooSox have maximized their use of the long-ball all season as 31 of their total 60 HR on the year have come with runners on base. Worcester batters have belted (29) solo HR, (19) 2-run homers, (7) 3-run blasts & (5) grand slams.

**Streaks Appeal** – The WooSox have had a pair of season-high 5-game winning streaks (from April 13-18 and again from April 20-24). Worcester had a season-high 5-game losing streak from April 25-30 and they have also had a 4-game losing streak (May 8-11) and a 3-game losing skid (April 5-9).

**A Winning Tradition** – The 2024 Worcester Red Sox went 79-71 to post a winning season for the fourth time in as many years of existence and for the third year in a row under manager Chad Tracy. Trace is only the second Red Sox Triple-A manager to ever post three consecutive winning seasons. Darrell Johnson did so from 1971-73 (the first two years when the Red Sox Triple-A club was in Louisville before moving to Pawtucket in 1973). Worcester finished 35-40 during the first half last year but then improved to 44-31 in the second half. Overall the 2024 WooSox went 40-34 at home and 39-37 on the road. The 2021 WooSox had a 74-54 record during their abbreviated inaugural season, the 2022 WooSox finished 75-73, and the 2023 club posted a 79-68 mark.

**2024 WooSox Batters Led the Way** – Worcester led all 20 International League clubs in a host of team offensive categories last season. The WooSox led the league with 869 runs scored (Scranton/Wilkes-Barre was next with 846 runs scored). The Sox also led the IL with 786 walks (Toledo was a distant 2<sup>nd</sup> with 676 walks). Worcester paced the league by a wide margin with an impressive .369 on-base pct. as the WooSox were the only team in the IL with an OBP of over .359 (Scranton/WB was 2<sup>nd</sup> at .358). Furthermore, Worcester had the 2<sup>nd</sup> best OPS in the league at .795 (Columbus was 1<sup>st</sup> at .804).

**2024 Rankings** – Worcester finished 5<sup>th</sup> in the IL in team batting with a .259 average. On the pitching side, the Sox were 10<sup>th</sup> in team ERA (4.84). Sox pitchers allowed the 2<sup>nd</sup> fewest HR in the league (141 HRA while Nashville had 139 HRA). Defensively, the WooSox were 11<sup>th</sup> with a .979 field pct. (107 errors in 5126 total chances).

**Players Aplenty** - The 2024 WooSox built on a pair of all-time Red Sox Triple-A records (previously set by the 2023 WooSox) as they made 281 player transactions during the 2024 campaign and set a new all-time Red Sox Triple-A record for players appearing in a single season. The WooSox used 84 different players in 2024 (37 position players and 47 pitchers) to better the mark of 79 players in 2023. Ironically, the 2021 WooSox broke a long-standing Red Sox Triple-A record when they used 72 different players to beat the 1995 Pawtucket Red Sox (during a strike year when replacement players were used for the first month+ of that season) and the 2006 PawSox who each employed 70 different players. When Chad Tracy made his Worcester debut in 2022, the WooSox quickly set a new record using 75 different players (that was immediately topped first in 2023 and again in 2024).

**WooSox to BoSox** - The WooSox sent 28 different players to Boston during the 2024 season (not counting rehab players). A total of 22 different players were promoted from Double-A Portland to Triple-A Worcester last season.

**PORTLAND SEA DOGS (AA) GAME RECAP** – The Portland Sea Dogs (27-21) open a 6-game series at home vs. Hartford tonight.

**WOOSOX PLAYER MOVES** – In addition to receiving INF **Blaze Jordan** from Portland (see page 1), the WooSox today also added INF **Nick Sogard** following his option from Boston over the weekend and reinstated C **Enderso Lira** from the development list. OF **Corey Rosier** and INF/OF **Karson Simas** have been transferred from Worcester to Double-A Portland. The WooSox have not yet added INF/OF Nate Eaton who was optioned by the Red Sox yesterday.

**Sogard**, 27, has played 14 games for Boston this season, hitting .245 (12-for-49) with eight runs scored, three doubles, and two RBI, while making 11 starts at first base and one at third base. The switch-hitter has also hit .188 (19-for-101) with 10 RBI in 28 games for Worcester. Originally selected by the Tampa Bay Rays in the 12<sup>th</sup> round of the 2019 First-Year Player Draft, the California native has hit .262 (33-for-126) with 21 runs scored, seven doubles, and 10 RBI in 45 career Major League games, all for the Red Sox (2024-25).

**Eaton**, 28, has played 53 games for Worcester this season, batting .277 (54-for-195) with 16 doubles, one triple, five home runs, 27 RBI, 24 walks, and an .810 OPS. The right-handed hitter has made 20 starts at third base, 18 at center field, 10 at right field, two as the designated hitter, and one each at second base, shortstop, and left field. Originally selected by the Kansas City Royals in the 21<sup>st</sup> round of the 2018 First-Year Player Draft, the Virginia native has played 72 career Major League games, batting .201 (32-for-159) with one home run and 13 RBI, all for the Royals (2022-23).

Blaze Jordan will become the 53<sup>rd</sup> different player used by Worcester already this season (30 pitchers and 23 position players) when he makes his WooSox debut playing 3B and batting fifth in the starting lineup. Last year at the end of May the WooSox had used 50 different players (29 pitchers and 21 position players) on their way to a Red Sox Triple-A record 84 players used during the 2024 season.

Since the start of the season (9½ weeks) the WooSox have sent RHP Hunter Dobbins (three times), RHP Robert Stock, C Blake Sabol, RHP Josh Winckowski, RHP Michael Fulmer, NF Nick Sogard (twice), RHP Luis Guerrero (three times), RHP Cooper Criswell (four times), INF Abraham Toro, RHP Nick Burdi (twice), Marcelo Mayer, Zack Kelly (twice), and Nate Eaton to Boston. Stock, Winckowski, Sabol (DFA), and Sogard are all back with Worcester. The Red Sox have also recalled rehabbers RHP Lucas Giolito, C Connor Wong, and INF/OF Romy Gonzalez from Worcester thus far this season.
