

The Frisco RoughRiders blanked the Corpus Christi Hooks 3-0 on Saturday night from Riders Field, Frisco (8-12, 46-42) starter Jose Corniell and relievers David Davalillo, Daniel Missaki and Avery Weems combined for the the pitching staff's fourth shutout of the season. The RoughRiders struck first in the bottom of the fourth when Sebastian Walcott drilled a two-run homer to take a 2-0 lead. Abine He hough moles study in still the bottom of the sixth, expanding Frisco's lead to 3-0. In the top of the ninth, Corpus Christi (8-12, 30-58) put a runner in scoring position before Weems fanned the next three batters to earn his second save of the season. Davalillo (1-1) drew the winning decision, spinning 4.2 shutout innings while punching out four batters. Corniell fired twono-hit frames in his Double-A debut. Hooks reliever Bryce Mayer (1-2) took the loss, allowing three runs over 4.1 innings of long relief.

VS. THE HOOKS:

The RoughRiders are 9-7 against Corpus Christi this season, including 5-5 at home against the Astros affiliate. **Abimelec Ortiz** leads the RoughRiders in OPS (1.013) against Corpus with four home runs and 18 RBIs in 16 games while **Sebastian Walcott** has clubbed five of his 10 home runs against the Hooks.

WALK IT LIKE I TALK IT:

Aaron Zavala walked twice on Friday, collecting his 207th career walk in a RoughRiders uniform to break the all-time franchise record, previously held by **Guilder Rodriguez**. Making it much more impressive, Zavala accomplished the feat in 312 games with a 15.1 percent walk rate over four seasons (2022-2025) while Rodriguez needed 524 RoughRiders games from 2009-2015 and a 9.8 percent walk rate.

HOLD ME CLOSE AND DON'T LET GO: In their last eight games, the RoughRiders have had the lead or a tie game in the eighth inning in each contest, but they are 4-4. The Riders have blown four saves during that span. Their bullpen ERA of 4.00 in July is 6th in the Texas League.

Keyber Rodriguez has been swinging a hot bat for the Riders recently. Since June 15th, in his last 21 games, he is hitting .364 (28-for-77)/.443/.455/.898 with seven doubles, five RBIs, 10 walks, 10 runs scored and just nine strikeouts. In July, he is batting .341 (14-for-41) over 11 games.

CAULEY! CAULEY, CAULEY ANYTIME:

Cam Cauley has been incredible for the RoughRiders lately on offense. In his last 55 games since May 7th, he is batting .271/.335/.463/.798 with 16 doubles, seven home runs, 22 RBIs and 14 stolen bases. In his last 20 games, he is slashing .294/.344/.529/.873 with six doubles, four home runs, 11 RBIs and seven steals.

EVERY DAY SHOULD BE BRATT-URDAY:

Starting pitcher Mitch Bratt has been one of the best in the Texas League this season and was dominant on Saturday against Arkansas, going six innings on one-run baseball. He is four in the league in ERA (2.73) while second in the league with 100 strikeouts this season. He is also seventh in innings (80.0), fourth in WHIP (1.11), first in strikeout rate (30.8 percent), first in walk rate (4.0 percent), first in left on base rate (82.7 percent) and second in swinging strike rate (13.9). Among full-season pitchers, his strikeout to walk ratio of 7.69 is second in all of Minor League Baseball.

SWIPE CITY:

The RoughRiders have now stolen at least one base in 18 of their last 21 games. Over those 21 games, they have stolen 34 total bases, which is third in the league. **Sebastian Walcott** is tied for first in the league with 10 steals in that span while **Cam Cauley** is sixth with seven. Overall this season, the Riders are sixth in the league with 102 stolen bases.

<u>DEFENSE WINS CHAMPIONSHIPS:</u>
After the RoughRiders committed 20 errors in 23 April games, which was sixth in the league, they have the fewest in the league overall with 61. They also have just committed just 41 errors in their last 65 games. That mark is also second-best in Double-A. Their 58 stolen bases allowed are the fewest in Double-A and are the third-fewest in Minor League Baseball.

Rangers top prospect Sebastian Walcott has showed off incredible consistency this season. In April, he hit .244 with a .766 OPS, in May, produced a .257 average and .811 OPS, but struggled with extra-base hits in June, hitting .239, but just a .640 OPS. This season, his walk rate of 12.2 percent is a career high while he is striking out at just 21.6 percent, a career low. This season, he is on pace for 34 steals over 124 games, which would best his prior career high of 27 last year. The only teenagers since 2005 to steal 30 or more in Double-A are **Euris Andrus** (51, 2008), Jackson Chourio (43, 2023), Nelson Rada (35, 2024) and Mike Trout (31, 2011). Chourio was the only one on that list with 30+ stolen bases and double-digit home runs (22). Walcott participated in the Futures Game for the second season in a row over the All-Star Break, going 0-for-1 with a sacrifice fly and a groundout to shortstop while playing third base defensively. base defensively.
