**Mike Vasil to the 2023 SiriusXM All-Star Futures Game:** New York Mets pitching prospect and former Binghamton RHP **Mike Vasil** is representing the Mets in the 2023 SiriusXM All-Star Futures Game tonight at T-Mobile Park in Seattle. Vasil was the Eastern League Pitcher of the Month for May as a member of the Rumble Ponies. The seven-inning game will air on Peacock and SiriusXM at 7 p.m. ET.

**Last Time Out:** The Binghamton Rumble Ponies fell to the Portland Sea Dogs 6-1 at Hadlock Field on Friday night. Brandon McIlwain had a multi-hit game and drove in the Ponies' only run in the first inning on an RBI double. Rowdey Jordan extended his hitting streak to four games with a single.

**Moreno Magic:** RHP **Luis Moreno** has earned the loss in just one of his last nine starts and 10 appearances. He is tied for second in the Eastern League with six wins. He struck out seven batters over 5+ innings in his last start on Sunday against Hartford, and has now struck out 7+ hitters in four-straight starts and in five of his last six starts. In his last start, he tossed five scoreless innings before allowing a run in the sixth without recording an out. Moreno's last start against Portland was a good one on 6/15 at home: W, 6 IP, 4 H, 2 ER, 2 BB, career-high 10 strikeouts.

**Jordan's Brand: Rowdey Jordan** is having a great series. In the first four games, Jordan is 7-for-14 (.500 AVG), with two doubles, a homer, three RBIs, four runs, three walks, four stolen bases, and a three-hit game. He reached base safely in his first eight plate appearances in the series. Over the last 28 days, Jordan is batting .325 with 10 XBH, 13 RBIs, 15 R, and a .974 OPS.

**The Big Club:** The New York Mets won their sixth-straight game with a 7-5 seriesopening win over the San Diego Padres in 10 innings last night. Francisco Álvarez totaled four hits, and Francisco Lindor and Daniel Vogelbach both had three hits. Lindor homered (19), Vogelbach drove in three runs and Álvarez smacked an RBI single in the 10th inning to put the Mets up 5-3. In the series at Arizona, RHP Kodai Senga and RHP Carlos Carrasco both tossed eight innings in back-to-back games. It marked the first time the Mets have had starting pitchers go 8+ innings in back-toback team games since August 2 & 3, 2015, when Noah Syndergaard and Bartolo Colon did so, per Sarah Langs.

Last Start: Moreno struck out seven batters over five-plus innings of work on Sunday against Hartford at home. He allowed just one run on four hits with three walks. He tossed five scoreless frames and then allowed a run in the sixth inning without recording an out. Moreno has now totaled 7+ strikeouts in fourstraight starts and five of his last six starts. Moreno has one loss since May 2 at Somerset, a streak that spans nine starts and 10 appearances.

In his last four starts, Moreno has combined to pitch 23 innings with 33 strikeouts. He has allowed just four runs over that span with 14 hits and eight walks issued.

**2022**: Began the season with St. Lucie (A) and went 4-0 with a 2.68 ERA in nine appearances and three starts. Was assigned to Brooklyn (A+) on June 1, 2022, where he went 4-7 with a 2.92 ERA. He tallied 70 strikeouts in 77.0 innings for Brooklyn and totaled 107 strikeouts across the two levels in 2022.

**BACKGROUND**: Signed with the Mets as an international free agent on June 8, 2019. He is entering his fourth season and fifth year with the Mets' organization in 2023. Coming into 2023, he has appeared with the DSL Mets, St. Lucie, and Brooklyn.

#### Reid Brignac - Manager - 2nd season with Binghamton - 4th year in the Mets organization.

In 2022, Brignac led a team that saw five players make their major league debut with the Mets after starting the season with the Rumble Ponies (Francisco Álvarez, Brett Baty, Jose Butto, Nate Fisher, and Bryce Montes de Oca), tied for the second-most in franchise history. This past fall, Brignac was one of two Mets staff members selected to be a part of the Arizona Fall League coaching staff, serving as the manager of the Peoria Javelinas. Following his retirement as an active player in 2018, Brignac was the manager of the St. Lucie Mets (Low-A) in 2021 before coming to Binghamton last year. As a player, Brignac appeared in parts of nine seasons in the major leagues with the Tampa Bay Rays, Colorado Rockies, Atlanta Braves, Philadelphia Phillies, New York Yankees, and Miami Marlins. He was drafted by the Rays in the second round of the 2004 MLB Draft.

AJ Sager - Pitching Coach - 1st season with Binghamton - 2nd year in the Mets organization. Sager served in the same role for the Brooklyn Cyclones (High-A) last season. Sager previously spent twenty seasons with the Detroit Tigers organization, including six seasons as the pitching coach with Triple-A Toledo. He pitched for parts of five seasons in the major leagues, playing for the San Diego Padres, Colorado Rockies, and Detroit Tigers as part of a 12-year professional career. In 123 major league appearances, the right-hander was 12-15, with five career saves and a 5.36 ERA.

He previously served as the bench coach for the Brooklyn Cyclones (High-A) in 2021. He is entering his fifth year in the Mets organization.
