Leading Off

Reading returns to Altoona for the first time since the last week of the 2022 season for game three of this week's six-game series. Altoona won the series 3-2 in Reading from Apr. 25-30.

Bringing the Boom

Reading hit four home runs en route to an 8-2 win over Altoona yesterday afternoon. Wilson, Kroon, Martin and McDowell all homered and Martin collected three hits. Kroon, Radcliff, Wilson and McDowell all each had two-hits apiece. Tyler Phillips started and allowed just one run over 5.1 innings, then the bullpen combined to allow just one-earned run over the games' final 3.2 innings.

Home Run Merchants

With four-more homers yesterday, Reading is now up to 99 long balls this season, which ranks third in the league behind Somerset then Erie. Over the last seven days, Reading has the most homers in the Eastern League with 12 total, and five more than any other team over that span.

Skipper Milestone Watch

Reading Manager Al Pedrique sits just ten wins shy of 1,000 in his Major/Minor League managerial career. Pedrique is in his first season with the R-Phils and last managed with the Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp in 2021. He also had a stint as a manager at multiple levels in the Yankees system.

Traveling in Style

Reading's record on the road this season (20-20, .500) is vastly better than at home (16-28, .364). The R-Phils are also scoring over half-a-run more per game on the road than at the friendly confines. Reading has homered more at home than on the road, but has allowed 72 long balls at home to 43 while away. Reading's ERA on the road is nearly a full-run lower than it is at FirstEnergy Stadium (4.45 to 5.30).

Johan To The Show

Johan Rojas made his big-league debut last Saturday. He had three hits and a remarkable defensive play in center. Rojas became the first player to make it to the bigs who began his career at the Phillies Dominican Academy, which opened in 2017 (HT: Steve Potter/Larry Shenk). With Rojas departed, the R-Phils now have a void to fill in center field. So far, De La Cruz has played center twice, Stokes twice and Kroon one time. Manager Al Pedrique said he plans to approach the center field position on a committee basis moving forward.

Around the Organization

The Phillies fell to Milwaukee last night and finish this week's series this afternoon in Philadelphia. Lehigh Valley won 5-1 at Toledo as Weston Wilson hit his 22nd homer of the year and Nick Podkul also went deep. Jersey Shore fell to Winston Salem 8-7 with all seven runs for the BlueC-laws in the third inning. Clearwater beat Tampa 8-7 as Felix Reyes had three hits and three RBI to raise his season-total to 43 RBI in 41 games.

This Day in Baseballtown History

July 20, 2012: At Trenton, Cody Asche's 2-run homer in the 1st inning snaps the R-Phils' streak of 29 consecutive scoreless innings and propels Reading to an 8-3 victory over the Thunder. Reading had endured three straight shutout defeats at Portland.

Curve Work

Altoona enters tonight with a 6-8 record in the second half, and 40-42 record overall in 2023. The Curve were in New Hampshire last weekend and lost Friday. Saturday was suspended and Sunday's game cancelled due to inclement weather. After this week, Altoona is on the road for a six-game series at Harrisburg. Top Prospects Henry Davis and Liover Pegeuro both are no longer with Altoona and now on the Pittsburgh Pirates roster.

Throw A "Curve" Ball

Beau Sulser gets the start tonight for Altoona. He's making just his second start for Altoona, after signing with the Pirates on June 29. In his lone start for Altoona, Sulser went two innings and allowed four runs in a loss at New Hampshire last Friday. Sulser split 2022 in the Pirates and Orioles organizations, appearing in games for both big league teams as well as their triple-A affiliates in Indianapolis and Norfolk. He began 2022 in the Pirates system then was claimed off waivers in May, finished the year with Baltimore before being claimed by the Pirates and then released. Sulser spent all of 2021 with Indianapolis, 2019 with Altoona and both 2017 and '18 with West Virginia. He was drafted by the Pirates in the 10th Round of the 2017 Draft out of Dartmouth. The 29-year-old made his major league debut on Apr. 26, 2022.

Started game and went one inning with two strike outs in Seattle. Went six innings on Apr. 29 vs Altoona, allowing just one run in win. Followed with second win on May 5 over six innings at Hartford. Roughed up on May 12 for nine runs in 3.2 innings against New Hampshire. Allowed six runs to Harrisburg on May 26, but followed with four-straight outings allowing two-earned runs or less from June 2-21. Opponents are hitting .198 off Abel, which would rank in top-10 of Eastern League, but Abel does not qualify. Currently striking out 10.4 hitters per nine and walking hitters at a 5.2 walk per nine rate. Leads team in walks issued at 35. Opponents are hitting just .198 off Abel this season.

2022: Split season between high-A Jersey Shore and double-A Reading. Started 18 games for Blue Claws, going 7-8 with a 4.01 ERA. Had 103 strikeouts over 85.1 innings and jsut 38 walks. Struck out 10.9 hitters per nine innings. Promoted to double-A Reading on August 20. Made five starts for Reading, going 1-3 with a 3.52 ERA. Formed rotation with Phillies' top-prospects Andrew Painter and Griff McGarry. Struck out season-high ten hitters on July 29 at Wilmington, while still with Jersey Shore.

Career: Began pro career with single-A Clearwater in 2021. Made 14 starts for Threshers and went 1-3 with 4.43 ERA. Struck out 66 hitters over 44.2 innings (13.3 K/9) and hel opposing hitters to a .174 average. Made debut on May 5 and threw last game of 2021 on July 21. Was placed on 7-day IL on August 3 and would miss rest of season with shoulder troubles.

Draft/Prep: Selected by Phillies in First Round (No. 15) in 2020 Draft out of Jesuit High School in Portland Oregon. Missed most of Senior season due to Covid. Abel was ranked as the top high school pitcher in the 2020 Draft class. Barely pitched at Jesuit, but showcased on summer showcase circuit in high school. Growing up, helped Cedar Mill Little League Team win a state title. Played 1B and pitcher for Jesuit High School. Sophomore season cut short due to injury to non-throwing shoulder that required surgery. Junior Year, went 10-0 with 1.26 ERA and 111 strikeouts over 72.1 innings. Led team to State Title and was named Oregon Gatorage Player of the Year and Junior All-American by Max Preps in 2019. Also in 2019, was selected for U-18 USA Team and going into 2020. Abel was selected a preseason All-American by MaxPreps and Baseball America. Ranked as fourth-best collegiate prospect in nation. Committed to Oregon State after Freshman Year of high school.

Scouting Report: With a tall frame, Abel projects as a right-handed starter. Has a quick arm and fastball sits in mid-to-upper 90s. Also showcases a mid-80s slider, which is a plus pitch for Abel. Has a slower curveball and changeup. As Abel develops, scouts look for him to hone in on his command and improve strike throwing. Growing in that area could help him reach ceiling as front-half of the rotation big league starter.
