**YESTERDAY:** The Flying Squirrels beat the Curve, 8-4. **Nick Sinacola** started and threw five scoreless innings. **Will Bednar** also threw two scoreless frames. **Victor Bericoto** opened the scoring with a solo homer in the third, his ninth of the season. In the fourth, **Matt Higgins** opened a 2-0 lead with an RBI single. Richmond scored a run on a wild pitch in the fifth and **Diego Velasquez** added an RBI single. A four-run sixth opening the Flying Squirrels' lead to 8-0. Bericoto was hit by a pitch with the bases loaded, **Turner Hill** brought in a run with a sacrifice fly, **Andy Thomas** hit an RBI single and Bericoto scored on a wild pitch. Altoona scored four runs in the ninth inning to cut the score to 8-4. Thomas and Munguia each had three hits in the game for the Flying Squirrels.

**TODAY'S GAME:** The Flying Squirrels face the Altoona Curve, Double-A affiliate of the Pittsburgh Pirates in the finale of a six-game series at The Diamond. The two teams first met for a six-game series in Richmond from June 4-9 with Richmond winning the first two before Altoona won the last four. From July 30-August 4 in Altoona, the Curve won the first four games before the Flying Squirrels won the final two. The two teams will also face off to close the season at Peoples Natural Gas Field from Sep-tember 10-15. The Flying Squirrels are looking for their first six-game series win of the second half. They last took a full series with four wins in six games at Portland from June 18-23. In the second half, they have lost four and split three six-game series.

**THE FLYING SQUIRRELS** snapped a six-game losing streak with their win on Wednesday night and have won three-of-four. They are 5-11 in their last 16 games since August 9. In their last six games dating back to Sunday's series finale in Harrisburg, the Flying Squirrels are batting .296 (59-for-199), which is the highest in the Eastern League. In that span, they have scored a league-best 35 runs (5.8 runs per game) and homered six times. They had only hit six home runs in their previous 19 games from July 27-August 17.

**THE CURVE** have gone 5-14 in their last 19 games since August 3. Last week, the dropped four-of-six against the Baysox at home. Altoona's roster features four of Baseball America's top-30 Pirates prospects, including LHP Anthony Solometo (No. 5), SS Tsung-Che Cheng (No. 7), OF Jase Bowen (No. 27) and OF Tres Gonzalez (No. 28). Chen is also rated by Baseball America as having the best change-up in the Pirates system. MLB.com's top-30 Pirates prospects list including two Altoona players, including Solometo (No. 7) and Cheng (No. 18).

**FOR RICHMOND:** Right-hander **Dylan Cumming** makes his 10th Double-A start and 15th appearance. He started the series opener on Tuesday and allowed three runs (two earned) over 4.2 innings, striking out four, but issued a season-high five walks. In his previous start last Wednesday at Harrisburg, he set a career high with 11 strikeouts, the most by a Richmond pitcher this season. For the season, he ranks second in the Giants system in strikeouts (125). He also ranks first in the organization in K/9 (11.68) and third in strikeout percentage (29.6%). Cumming began the year with High-A Eugene, going 3-0 with a 1.87 ERA in nine games (seven starts). He was named the Northwest League Pitcher of the Month in April after going 1-0 with a 0.50 ERA (1 ER/18.0 IP) in five games (four starts). On April 17 against Vancouver, Cumming started and threw three innings in a combined no-hitter with Nick Sinacola and Seth Corry. Cumming spent last year with Low-A San Jose in his professional debut season, going 7-3 with a 2.93 ERA in 34 games (seven starts). He worked as a reliever most of the season before making starts across July, August and September. Cumming began his collegiate career at Chicago State, where he pitched three seasons before the program was disbanded in 2020. He pitched his final two seasons at Liberty University in Lynchburg, Va., and was with the Burlington Sock Puppets in the 2022 summer, where he was selected as an Appalachian League All-Star. Cumming signed with the San Francisco Giants as a non-drafted free agent on February 25, 2023. *For more on Cumming, see page two*.

FOR ALTOONA: Left-hander Anthony Solometo makes his 14th Double-A start of the season and his fourth against the Flying Squirrels. On Tuesday in the first game of the series, he threw 4.2 innings and surrendered three runs (two earned) in a no-decision. Solometo also pitched at The Diamond on June 5 and surrendered two runs over two innings in a loss. On June 9 in Richmond, he threw two scoreless innings. Solometo was placed on the development list on June 19 and returned to Altoona on August 8. Tonight marks his third start since returning to the Curve. Solometo was selected in the second round (37th overall) by the Pirates in the 2021 MLB Draft. He is rated by Baseball America as the No. 5 Pirates prospect and No. 7 by MLB.com.

**DOUBLE TROUBLE:** The Flying Squirrels have turned 82 groundball double plays this year, which is the most in the Eastern League. Richmond pitcher **John Michael Bertrand** has induced 19 double plays this year, which is the most in the minor leagues. The Flying Squirrels turned four double plays on July 27 against Binghamton, which is tied for the most in a game this season in the league. They matched that feat with four double plays in the first four innings at Harrisburg last Friday night with Bertrand pitching. Those four double plays were tied for the most in duced by a pitcher in the Eastern League dating back to 2005, which is the first year those statistics are readily available. It has been accomplished by three other Richmond pitchers, including **Daryl Maday** in 2010, **Clayton Blackburn** twice in 2014 and **Garrett Williams** in 2019. Bertrand's 19 GIDPs this year are tied for the fourth-most in a season in franchise history, trailing 27 by **Craig Westcott** in 2012 (second-most in the Eastern league since at least 2005), 21 by **Clayton Tanner** in 2010 and 20 by **Mike MacDonald** in 2010.

**BERICOTO BASHING:** In his last 56 games dating back to June 6, **Victor Bericoto** is hitting .299 (67-for-224) with five homers, 12 doubles, nine walks and 33 RBIs. After leading the Giants organization in homers (27) last year, Bericoto hit just one homer in his first 34 games this season through May 21. From May 22-28, he homered three times in five games. He went deep again on June 14 at New Hampshire and added a homer on June 18 at Portland, but he had not homered in 34 games before belting a two-run shot on August 9 off the scoreboard in left-center at The Diamond.

**TAKE THE JAIRO:** Last Sunday, **Jairo Pomares** hit his team-leading 11th home run of the season, a 445-foot blast at FNB Field in Harrisburg. It snapped a stretch of 29 games without a home run. He went deep again in his next game on Tuesday at The Diamond against the Curve. For the season, Pomares' 12 homers are tied for fifth-most in the Giants organization. He is also eighth with 32 extra-base hits. Last homestand, Pomares hit a walk-off double for an extra-innings win over the Yard Goats in the second game of a doubleheader on August 10.

TO THE MUNGUIA: In his 17 August games, Ismael Munguia is batting .354 (23-for-65), fourth-highest in the Eastern League, with five doubles and five RBIs, adding four stolen bases. He has at least one hit in 14-of-17 games played this month. Last year, he hit .282 over 75 games with the Flying Squirrels. In his Richmond career, Munguia is batting .289 (125-for-432) in 109 games, which is the fifth-highest career mark in franchise history (min. 450 PA).

**PACKING THE HOUSE:** The Flying Squirrels drew an average of 7,113 fans in April for their home games at The Diamond to open the season, their highest April average in franchise history. The previous high was 6,891 in 2014 followed by 6,571 in 2019. This season, the Flying Squirrels are leading all 30 Double-A teams and are ranked 10th among the 120 minor league clubs in average home attendance (6,579), just shy of the highest average attendance in franchise history (6,689 in 2013).

BOULEVARD TO THE BAY: This season, 12 former Flying Squirrels players have reached the majors for the first time. That is BOULEVARD TO THE BAY: This season, 12 former Flying Squirrels players have reached the majors for the first time. That is the most in a season in franchise history. In 2014, 11 alumni made their MLB debuts, including Joe Panik, Adam Duvall, Andrew Susac, Matt Duffy, Jackson Williams, Edwin Escobar, Hunter Strickland, Chris Dominguez, Gary Brown, Brett Bochy and Chris Heston. The Flying Squirrels alumni to debut in the majors this season are Erik Miller (2023 Flying Squirrels), Landen Roupp (2022-23), Kai-Wei Teng (2022-23), Nick Avila (2022), Randy Rodriguez (2022-23), Mason Black (2023), Gerson Gara-bito (2021), Spencer Bivens (2023), Raymond Burgos (2023), Hayden Birdsong (2023-24), Parker Dunshee (2022) and Grant MCCray (2024). Dating back to 2022, 21-of-the-last-23 Flying Squirrels alumni who have reached the majors have debuted with the San Francisco Giants, with Garabito (Rangers) and Dunshee (Braves) being the only exceptions. Last year saw 10 former Flying Squirrels players debut in the big leagues, including a team-record five from that season's Richmond roster.

**LOTTA INS, LOTTA OUTS, LOTTA WHAT-HAVE-YOUS:** The have been 60 players who have seen action for the Flying Squirrels this year, which ties the franchise record for a single season. In 2018 and 2019, the Flying Squirrels also had 60 different players see time on the field. This season, there have been 31 different pitchers used by the Flying Squirrels, which includes appearance si by **Andy Thomas** on June 1 against the SeaWolves and **Luis Toribio** on August 10 against the Yard Goats. There have been 31 different hitters who have seen at least one plate appearance with Richmond this season.

PROSPECT WATCH: Two of Baseball America's top-30 Giants prospects are on the Richmond roster, including OF Vaun Brown (No. 11) and SS Diego Velasquez (No. 26). On Baseball America's Best Tools list, LHP John Michael Bertrand is rated as having the best control. MLB.com's top-30 Giants prospects list features two Richmond players, including Velasquez (No. 17) and LHP Jack Choate (No. 21)




