Streaking: Shortstop Joshua Kuroda-Grauer enters today on a 20-game on-base streak, going 2-for-4 yesterday with a two-run single.

Hello, Truist Park: Third baseman Tommy White and Lugnuts 2025 Opening Day starter Gage Jump (now in Double-A) will represent the Athletics' organization at the 2025 All-Star Futures Game in Atlanta, alongside Fort Wayne's Leo De Vries. White, the A's No. 6 prospect, joins Luis Morales (2024), Denzel Clarke (2022), Vladimir Guerrero Jr. and Bo Bichette (2017) and Angel Perdomo (2016) as active Lugnuts to play in the Futures Game.

Lugnuts in the News: July 2nd was an eventful day for former Nuts! Consider...

- 2023 Nut **Jacob Wilson** and 2017 Nut **Vladimir Guerrero**, **Jr**. were voted in as American League All-Star starters, with Guerrero making his fifth All-Star Game appearance while Wilson becomes the first Athletics starter shortstop since Bert Campaneris in 1974 and the second rookie to start at shortstop in All-Star Game history, joining Ron Hansen in 1960. Wilson ranks 2nd in the MLB in avg. (.339) and hits (108).
- 2012 Nut **Kevin Pillar** announced his retirement following a 13-year playing career with 10 different teams. A 32nd-round selection in 2011, Pillar went 6-for-6 with a grand slam in a 6-RBI night at the Dayton Dragons on May 13, 2012, and found a fire extinguisher in his locker after the game. He went on to be the 2012 Midwest League Most Valuable Player.
- 2018 Nut Vinny Capra was Clayton Kershaw's 3,000th strikeout victim last night. Capra, a 20th-rounder in 2018, played 25 games for the Nuts on his way up the Blue Jays' ladder. He had been claimed off waivers by the White Sox from the Milwaukee Brewers on May 15.

DK at the Helm: The 19th manager in Lugnuts history is **Darryl Kennedy**, entering his second year in the A's organization. Kennedy distinguished himself as a catcher at Manatee Community College before starring at the University of North Florida and was named an NCAA All-American in 1991 en route to North Florida's Hall of Fame, inducted in 2017. Kennedy played in the Minor Leagues for seven seasons, including parts of four seasons in Triple-A. Following his 1997 retirement, he immediately began managing, leading the Gulf Coast League Rangers to the 1998 GCL Championship. Kennedy won a second title with the GCL Rangers in 2000, moving on to stops in the Florida State League, Northwest League and Texas League through 2006. Upon joining the Royals' organization, Kennedy managed in the Appalachian League, Carolina League, Pioneer League, Arizona League and Texas League through 2020. He served as bench coach for the KBO's Hanwha Eagles from 2021 through 2023 before joining the A's as Double-A Midland's assistant hitting coach in 2024.

History vs. Fort Wayne

The Lugs are 226-241 vs. the TinCaps, 121-103 in Lansing, 105-138 at The Fort. Last year: 8-10, 4-5 at Fort Wayne.

2019 was the last time the Nuts opened in FW, splitting a four-game home-and-home series. Before that: 2009 to open Parkview Field, a three-game TinCaps sweep.

2017: Bo Bichette (1-for-2, 2 BB, .384) and Vladimir Guerrero, Jr. (1-for-4, HR No. 7, .316), played their final game with the Lugnuts before departing, first to the All-Star Futures Game in Miami during Major League Baseball All-Star Break, and then to A-Advanced Dunedin with a promotion. The Lugnuts lost at home to West Michigan, 3-2. Trivia question: Who replaced Bo and Vladdy in Lansing? Answer: SS Luis De Los Santos, who played 13 games last year for the Toronto Blue Jays and is with the Syracuse Mets this year, and 3B Luis Silva, who batted .196 with the Lugnuts and was done in pro ball after 2017.

Happy Birthday, Francisco Solano (1979), who posted a 2.91 ERA in 4 GS as an 18-year-old for the 1998 Lugnuts. He went 1-6 with a 5.52 ERA in 1999 as a 19-year-old for Charleston and never pitched again in pro ball.



No-No History: Facing the Cedar Rapids Kernels on June 13, 2024, relieved Jake Garland to open the 6th inning and tossed 2 2/3 hitless innings, walking one and striking out three, as part of the Lugnuts' 8-0 combined no-hitter of the Kernels... it was the 4th no-hitter in franchise history as well as the first home no-hitter since 2003.

At Pella High School: 2016 lowa Gatorade Player of the Year as a senior... Des Moines Register's All-lowa Baseball Player of the Year as both a junior and a senior, 2015 and 2016... 2015 Perfect Game Underclass High Honorable Mention... as a senior: 10-1, 0.64 ERA, 123 K, batting .421 with six homers and 12 steals... as a junior: 11-1, 0.56 ERA, 74 IP, 112 K, 10 BB, batting .520 with 14 doubles, nine triples, 13 homers, 57 RBIs, 51 runs, 15 steals... won 28 career games and totaled 337 career strikeouts.

Onward to Des Moines: Entered the 2017 Big Ten season ranked by Baseball America as the No. 8 freshman... two-way player, hitting .270 in 31 starts as a DH (and three starts as a pitcher hitting for himself)... 2018 Academic All-Big Ten...
