#### LAST GAME

The Bavsox kicked off their seven-game series against the Altoona Curve with a 4-1 victory on Tuesday night. Bowie was powered by a pair of two-run home runs - one from Coby Mayo in the third and one from Billy Cook in the eighth. The Bowie pitching staff worked in and out of trouble through out the night, as they would strand 11 Altoona base runners throughout the evening, holding the Curve to just a single run on 11 hits. Right-handed starter Jean Pinto made his Double-A debut, going 4.1 innings with a season-high 83 pitches. The right-hander was able to scatter seven hits, strike out four, and walk three, only allowing an RBI single to Connor Scott in the fourth. Right-hander Conner Loeprich finished the fifth for Pinto and dominated through his 2.2 innings, before right-hander Ofreidy Gomez recorded the final six outs for his third save of the season.

#### TODAY'S OPPONENT

The Altoona Curve enter tonight's matchup with a record of 31-31 - third place in the Eastern League Southwest division and three games behind first place Erie in the final week of play in the first half. This is already the third matchup between the Curve and Baysox this season, with Altoona holding the 7-4 edge in the season series, including winning four of five at People's Natural Gas Field in April. The Curve are coming off a series in which they lost five of six on the road against Somerset. Altoona is a tough team to strike out, as the Curve have the fewest strikeouts (509) in Double-A, and fifth-fewest in Minor League Baseball. Altoona's roster is headlined by five of the Pirates' top 30 prospects, via MLB Pipeline - SS Liover Peguero (No. 6 PIT), LHP Anthony Solometo (No. 9 PIT), OF Matt Gorski (No. 15 PIT), OF Matt Frazier (No. 21 PIT), and RHP Braxton Ashcraft (No. 29 PIT).

### TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

Right-hander Braxton Ashcraft looks to get the ball in game one of today's double-header for the Curve. The No. 29 prospect in the Pirates system, per MLB Pipeline, Ashcraft will be making his Double-A debut today. He has just 37 starts and 142 innings under his belt in this, his fourth professional season. Tommy John Surgery cut his 2021 season short and prevented him from taking the mound in 2022. Ashcraft allowed opponents to hit .279 against him at High-A Greensboro (29 hits in 26.1 innings), but does fill the zone, with just five walks and 29 strikeouts. A second round pick of the Pirates in 2018, Ashcraft features a high-90s fastball, a cutter-like slider that sits in the upper-80s, a low-80s curveball, and a rarely featured changeup. Game two's projected starter for the Curve is left-hander Nick Dombkowski. This will be just the second start of the season and fourth of the career for Dombkowski. The southpaw has allowed nine home runs across his 33 innings this season, along with 34 total hits. Dombkowski last worked Friday in Somerset, where he went a career-long 4.2 innings, allowing a single run on just two hits. In his career against the Baysox, Dombkowski has a 2.70 ERA (3 ER in 10 innings), including three perfect frames against Bowie across two appearances at PNG Field in April.

#### THE A-MAYO-ZING COBY

INF Coby Mayo has been a balanced mix of power, patience, and run production at the plate for the Baysox. Mayo sits second at the Double-A level with 22 doubles, while his 36 extra-base hits lead Dobule-A and are the second-most in all of Minor League Baseball. The No. 8 Orioles'/ No. 99 overall prospect, per MLB Pipeline, also has an active nine-game hitting streak, along with an active 33-game on-base streak - the second-longest in the Eastern League this season. Mayo took home Eastern League Player of the Week honors this past week, after going 10-for-24 (.417). with two doubles, a triple, three home runs, and 8 RBI. Mayo sits third in the league with a .420 on-base percentage, is second with a .579 slugging percentage, and leads the league with a .999 OPS. Last night's two-run home run was his fourth in his last five games

#### LET HIM COOK

Billy Cook is enjoying one of the hottest stretches of his professional career. Cook has hits in 12 of 13 games for the first time in his minor league career. He's hitting .333 (17-for-51) in that stretch with six doubles and three home runs. Cook has bounced back nicely in 2023, hitting .300 with 19 extra-base hits over the past two months, after hitting just .103 with one extra-base hit in the month of April.

#### LEADING THE WAY, AWAY FROM HOME

After starting 4-10 away from home this season, the Baysox have won 10 of their last 13 road contests - including taking each of the past two road series. The Baysox have had strong pitching outside of Prince George's Stadium more often than not this season, with their 3.33 road ERA as a staff leading all of Double-A. However, lately, its been the bats coming to life. Bowie is averaging 5.62 runs per game during this 13-game stretch away from home, including six performances of seven runs or more. In the 11 road games prior, Bowie averaged just 3.09 runs per game, losing nine of those contests.

#### DONTA' DAZZLES

Donta' Williams has enjoyed a steallar offensive bounce back over the past month. After hitting just .158 across the first two months of the season, with nearly three times as many strikeouts (45) as hits (18), including a 4-for-51 (.078) stretch in May, Williams has bounced back, hitting .323 in the month of June. Overall, since snapping his 4-for-51 stretch, Williams is hitting .320 (16-for-50) with five doubles and three home runs, while his on-base percentage has also climed 68 points.

#### **COACHING STAFF**

Manager - Kyle Moore

2023 will be Kyle Moore's second season as the manager of the Baysox, and his 14th within the Orioles' organization. After leading Bowie to a division-best 41-26 through the back half of last season, Moore continues to display consistency at the helm of recent successful teams throughout the Orioles system. Moore led Class-A Delmarva to a minor league-best 90 wins as manager in 2019. The Shorebirds were named MiLB.com's Team of the Year and Moore won South Atlantic Manager of the Year honors. Moore's career managerial record sits at 254-216 (540) entering the 2023 season.
