## AMAZIN' STARTS HERE

**BROOKLYN CYCLONES (2-6, 35-39)**

**LAST TIME OUT:** Brooklyn failed to grab its second-straight victory on Saturday night, falling to Aberdeen by a final score of 8-3. The game was tied at two after three innings, but the IronBirds would outscore the Cyclones 6-1 the rest of the way, including a three spot in the bottom of the eighth. Despite the defeat, RF **Wilfredo Lara** pieced together a strong effort, going 3-for-4 at the dish with a home run, two runs scored, a swiped bag, and an outfield assist. The three hits for Lara tied a season-high. SS **Jesús Báez** launched his first career High-A home run in the first inning. RHP **Jake Stevenson** hurled 2.0 innings of scoreless relief, striking out two without allowing a hit.

**THIS DATE IN CYCLONES HISTORY:** On June 30, 2006, the Brooklyn Cyclones outlasted the Aberdeen IronBirds, 1-0, in 15 innings at Maimonides Park. 3B **Jonathan Malo** provided the game-winning RBI double to close out the 4-hour and 19-minute contest. In 2008, after Hudson Valley scored two in the top of the ninth to tie the game, the Cyclones walked off winners, 6-5, thanks to a IB **Ike Davis** RBI infield single in the bottom of the frame. In 2011, the 'Clones clobbered four home runs to defeat Hudson Valley, 16-5, on the road. RF **Javier Rodríguez** went 3-for-5 with two doubles and a grand slam, accumulating six runs batted in. In 2012, CF **Brandon Nimmo** broke a two-all tie in the bottom of the seventh with a grand slam for his first home run as a Cyclone, as Brooklyn beat Aberdeen, 6-2. In 2023, RHP **Blade Tidwell** struck out 11 over 7.0 innings of one-run ball to earn the win in the Cyclones' 5-1 win vs. Jersey Shore.

**TRAVELING CIRCUS:** Starting with Tuesday's game in Aberdeen, the Cyclones will have just six home games over the next 28 days. Brooklyn's next full six-game home series will take place from July 23-28 vs. Rome. So far, Brooklyn is 1-4 in the stretch. The Cyclones will play three games at home vs. Hudson Valley from July 1-3 and another three vs. Jersey Shore from July 19-21 immediately following the All-Star break. Brooklyn is also amid their longest stretch without an off day during the 2024 season. After Sunday's series finale, the Cyclones will play Monday, July 1, through Saturday, July 6, with three games on Coney Island and another three in Hudson Valley before back-to-back days off on July 7 and 8.

**NICK SQUARED:** OF **Nick Morabito** and IF **Nick Lorusso** have been two of Brooklyn's biggest offensive contributors as of late. The duo each put together multi-hit games in last Sunday's win over Jersey Shore. Lorusso is eighth in the South Atlantic League in slugging (.487), ninth in OPS (.853), tied for ninth in total bases (113), 10th in extra-base hits (27), and tied for 10th in RBI (40). Lorusso is second among New York Mets' full-season minor leaguers in OPS (.853). He is also third in slugging (.487), tied for fourth in extra-base hits (27), home runs (11), RBI (40) and triples (3), and fifth in total bases (113). Morabito is tied for 11th in Minor League Baseball in stolen bases (33). Since making his South Atlantic League debut on May 7, the former second-round pick is tied for second in the league in steals (22) and tied for ninth in runs scored (29). The 21-year-old leads all full-season Mets farmhands in batting average (.322), on-base percentage (.428), and stolen bases (33). He also is second in hits (79), tied for third in runs scored (43), fourth in OPS (.840), and fifth in walks (38).

**THE TONG SONG:** RHP **Jonah Tong** tied a career-high with 11 strikeouts over 6.0 innings of one-run ball in a no-decision on Wednesday night in Aberdeen. Since making his South Atlantic League debut on May 2, the 21-year-old is tied for third in the circuit in strikeouts (56) and fifth in ERA (3.38). Tong has been as good as any pitcher in Minor League Baseball this year, tossing 26.0 consecutive innings without allowing an earned run to start the year. Among full-season Minor Leaguers with at least 60.0 innings of work, the Markham, Ont. native is second in FIP (2.18), third in strikeout rate (35.9%), sixth in strikeout-to-walk rate (25.8%), and tied for 10th in strikeouts (92).

**BROOKLYN-BOUND BÁEZ:** INF **Jesús Báez** clobbered his first High-A home run in Saturday's loss and is 6-for-21 with a pair of doubles, two runs scored, and a stolen base through his first five games at the High-A level. Báez is the No. 15 prospect in the Mets' organization according to *Baseball America* and No. 22 by MLB Pipeline. At 19 years old, Báez checks in as the youngest player on Brooklyn's roster and is the first player in franchise history born in 2005. In 64 games at the Single-A level, Báez accumulated a .262 average (66-252) with 25 extra-base hits, 10 home runs, 39 RBI, and eight stolen bases. The Santo Domingo, D.R. native departed the Florida State League with the most total bases (112) in the circuit. Báez was also second in hits (66), tied for second in home runs (10), RBI (39), and extra-base hits (25), fourth in runs scored (40), sixth in slugging (.444), and tied for sixth in doubles (16). Among full-season Mets farmhands, the infielder is tied for first in doubles (16), second in total bases (123), third in hits (72) and extra-base hits (28), tied for third in runs scored (43), tied for fourth in home runs (11) and RBI (40), and fifth in slugging (.451).

**OMAR-I-GONE:** OF **Omar De Los Santos** rejoined Brooklyn's roster on Monday from Double-A Binghamton. In 13 games with the Rumble Ponies after being transferred on May 20, the 24-year-old was 3-for-22 (136) at the plate with two home runs, three runs batted in, and two stolen bases. Despite appearing in only two games for the Cyclones since May 19 at Bowling Green, De Los Santos is still sixth in the South Atlantic League with 26 stolen bases. The Santo Domingo, D.R. native set Brooklyn's single-season stolen base record (37) in 2023 and broke UT **Jaylen Palmer**'s all-time franchise mark for stolen bases (63) earlier this season on May 2 vs. Aberdeen. Since the start of the 2022 season, De Los Santos is tied for fifth across Minor League Baseball in swiped bags (135). Aberdeen OF **Luis Valdez** (133) is tied for seventh.

**LOCATION, LOCATION:** The Cyclones have several players with intriguing home and road splits in 2024. INF **Nick Lorusso** has mashed at Maimonides Park. In 27

vs. ABERDEEN: Brooklyn hits the road for its first six-game series of the season's second half against the Orioles' High-A affiliate. Aberdeen boasts five of Baltimore's top 30 prospects per MLB Pipeline: OF **Enrique Bradfield Jr.** (5), INF **Mac Horvath** (11), LHP **Luis De León** (17), RHP **Jackson Baumeister** (18), and C **Creed Willems** (29). The Cyclones took 4-of-6 from Aberdeen in the first meeting (April 30-May 5) and split a six-game set in the most recent rendezvous (June 4-9). Aberdeen does not return to Brooklyn in the 2024 regular season, hosting the final 12 meetings. In 2023, Brooklyn went 7-5 against Aberdeen on Coney Island and 3-3 at Leidos Field. The Cyclones were 11-6 in Lakewood and 4-5 on Coney Island. In 256 meetings dating back to 2002, Brooklyn leads the all-time series, 134-122 (.523)

home contests, the 23-year-old is hitting .357/.439/.684 with a 1.123 OPS on Coney Island with six home runs, 18 RBI, and 13 walks to 15 strikeouts. Lorusso leads all South Atlantic League qualifiers in home batting average (.357), on-base percentage (.439), slugging (.684), and OPS (1.123). In 35 road affairs, Lorusso hits .194/.315/.343 with a .658 OPS, adding five home runs and 22 RBI with 24 walks to 41 K's. On the other hand, OF **Nick Morabito** is loving his time on the road. He is hitting .311/.408/.417 with a .825 OPS, adding two home runs, five RBI, and 21 stolen bases. Since his SAL debut, the 21-year-old is third in the circuit in road hits (32) and tied for third in runs scored (21) while swiping eight more bases (21) than any other player in the league. In Brooklyn, Morabito has collected a .250/.314/.281 line with a .595 OPS, two extra-base hits, an RBI, and a stolen base over 15 games. INF **Junior Tilen** has also thrived at home posting a .300/.357/.420 mark with a .777 OPS, two home runs, and 13 RBI in 28 games. On the road, Tilen is hitting .160/.260/.245 with a .505 OPS, a home run, and seven runs batted in over 30 contests.

**RUSTED IRON:** RHPs **Dakota Hawkins** (6.0 IP) and **Josh Hejka** (3.0) combined on a three-hit shutout in Friday's 7-0 win at Aberdeen. The shutout was the eighth of the year for the Cyclones' pitching staff and the first since Hawkins (5.0 IP), RHP **Joey Lancellotti** (1.0), and RHP **Joshua Cornielly** (3.0) combined on the first nine-inning no-hitter in franchise history vs. Aberdeen on June 4. Four of Brooklyn's eight shutouts in 2024 have come against the IronBirds. The Cyclones also blanked Aberdeen on May 3 and 4 on Coney Island. Since the start of 2023, eight of the 'Clones 19 shutouts (42.1%) have been against the 'Birds. Hawkins and Hejka combined to retire the final 19 batters in order in Friday's contest and did not allow a walk in the game. It was the first time Cyclones' pitching did not allow a free pass in a contest since a 1-0 loss at Greenville in Game 1 of a doubleheader on August 31, 2023. It was the first zero-walk performance by Brooklyn in a nine-inning game since an 8-5 win at Asheville on August 26, 2023.

**YOU'LL GET NOTHING AND LIKE IT:** RHPs **Dakota Hawkins** (5.0 IP), **Joey Lancellotti** (1.0), and **Joshua Cornielly** (3.0) combined on the first nine-inning no-hitter in Brooklyn Cyclones history June 4's 3-0 win vs. Aberdeen. The only previous no-hitter came on August 23, 2009, when RHP **Brandon Moore** tossed a seven-inning no-no in a 5-0 win during Game 1 of a doubleheader at Aberdeen. It is one of four no-hitters in Minor League Baseball in 2024. The effort was the first no-hitter by a Mets minor league affiliate since RHP **Joander Suárez** hurled a seven-inning one on September 7 at Hartford. It was also the first nine-inning no-hitter thrown in the borough of Brooklyn since RHP **Sal Maglie** tossed a no-no for the Dodgers against the Philadelphia Phillies on September 25, 1956, at Ebbets Field.

**ATOP THE HEJ-ES:** RHP **Josh Hejka** earned his first save of the season on May 5 vs. Aberdeen, making his Cyclones' franchise-record-setting 48th pitching appearance in the process. The 27-year-old broke a tie with **Hunter Parsons** (47) for the most pitching appearances in Cyclones franchise history. In his 63 career outings for Brooklyn since 2019, Hejka has accumulated a 6-3 record with a 2.41 ERA (28 ER in 104.2 IP) and eight saves, walking just 25 and striking out 95.

**SO LONG, STANLEY:** OF **Stanley Consuegra** was transferred to Double-A Binghamton on Monday. Consuegra departs Brooklyn as the franchise's all-time leader in numerous offensive categories. Last Wednesday, the veteran surpassed UTL **Jaylen Palmer** (204) for the most games played in franchise history (209). Consuegra also set the Cyclones' all-time doubles record (40) on June 8 vs. Aberdeen and the all-time hits mark (186) on May 29 at Jersey Shore. He is also the franchise's all-time leader in extra-base hits (81), home runs (35), RBI (121), and outfield assists (19). Consuegra also holds the single-season mark for home runs (23), and extra-base hits (42), and is tied with INF **Ronny Mauricio** (63) for single-season RBI. Consuegra ended his time in Brooklyn with a bang, hitting .282/.389/.518 with a .907 OPS since May 17. The Santo Domingo, D.R. native had scored 16 runs and added eight doubles, six home runs, and 20 RBI. In that time, Consuegra was tied for fourth in the South Atlantic League in extra-base hits (14), tied for eighth in total bases (57), and ninth in slugging (.518).

**AMAZIN' STARTS HERE:** The Brooklyn Cyclones have several Top 30 prospects according to *Baseball America* and MLB Pipeline. The 'Clones have four of the Top 30 per BA: **Jesús Báez** (15), **Kade Morris** (21), **Jonah Tong** (22) and **Calvin Ziegler** (29). Ziegler is currently on the full-season injured list. Plus five of the Top 30 per MLB: Tong (20), Báez (22), Ziegler (23), **Wilfredo Lara** (24), and OF **Nick Morabito** (26).

**LAST TIME OUT:** Made his first appearance of the season out of the bullpen last Sunday vs. Jersey Shore...Entered in support of RHP **Douglas Orellana** with runners at second and third and one out in the top of the first...With the game scoreless, De La Cruz registered back-to-back strikeouts to end the inning...Tossed 2.2 frames of one-hit, shutout ball... Walked two and struck out three...Tossed 48 pitches and 29 strikes (60.42%)...Relieved by RHP **Ben Simon** to start the top of the fourth inning and Brooklyn leading 1-0...Cyclones carried a 3-0 lead into the seventh, but Jersey Shore rallied to tie the score...Brooklyn scored four times in the bottom of the eighth and defeated the BlueClaws, 7-3.

**PROSPECT RADAR:** After a stellar 2023 season, De La Cruz was deemed the New York Mets' No. 39 prospect entering the 2024 campaign by *Baseball America*.

**HOME COOKING:** De La Cruz has been outstanding on Coney Island in 2024...Through his first seven appearance (six starts) of the campaign, the southpaw is 1-2 with a 1.84 ERA (6 ER in 29.1 IP), 13 walks, and 38 strikeouts...De La Cruz has not seen the same level of success on the road...The 23-year-old holds a 2-3 mark in visiting parks, but yields a 6.35 ERA (16 ER in 22.2 IP), with 10 walks, and 24 strikeouts...Among South Atlantic League pitchers with at least 26.0 innings pitched at home, De La Cruz ranks fifth in ERA (1.84).

**FELIP-IN' AMAZIN':** The 23-year-old celebrated his birthday by shutting out Hudson Valley on May 25 over 6.0 innings with a career-high 13 strikeouts...De La Cruz was one shy of the single game Brooklyn franchise record of 14 set by LHP **Mike Cox** (8/25/01 vs. HV) and RHP **Brad Holt** (7/24/08 vs. VER)... He was the first Cyclone to strike out 13+ hitters in a single contest since RHP **Rob Gsellman** accomplished the feat on August 24, 2013, at Vermont...De La Cruz is the sixth Cyclones pitcher ever to hit the 13 punchout threshold and the third to strikeout 13 or more in 6.0 or fewer innings.

**WELCOME TO BROOKLYN:** The 22-year-old joined the Cyclones from Single-A St. Lucie last year on August 22 and thrived over three starts...De La Cruz accumulated a 2-1 record with a 2.45 ERA (5 ER in 17.0 IP) with five walks and 17 strikeouts...The southpaw hurled quality starts in two of his three starts, including going all six innings in the lid-lifter of a doubleheader on August 31 at Greenville...After allowing a leadoff home run, De La Cruz retired 18 of the final 19 batters he faced, including sitting the last 11 down in order...The southpaw was credited with a complete game, the first for a Brooklyn pitcher since RHP **José Butto** accomplished the feat, tossing six innings in a seven-inning loss at Aberdeen in Game 1 of a twinbill on June 30, 2021...After making his SAL debut on August 23 at Asheville, De La Cruz ranked third in the circuit in WHIP (0.94), fifth in batting average against (.183), and sixth in ERA (2.65).

**FLORIDA STATE FELIPE:** De La Cruz was among the best strikeout artists in the Florida State League in 2023...Among FSL pitchers with 90.0 or more innings pitched, the 22-year-old led the circuit in strikeout rate (28.7%)...The southpaw also led the league in strikeouts-per-9 innings (11.36) and swinging strike rate (15.5%), while ranking 2nd in xFIP (3.68)...In 21 appearances (19 starts) with St. Lucie, De La Cruz was 3-6 with a 4.68 ERA (47 ER in 90.1 IP), 41 walks, and 114 strikeouts.
