NOTES AND NUGGETS

IN GOOD STANDINGS

Omaha enters today's game in 1st place in the 20-team International League, a remarkable 23 games over .500 at 39-16 (.709)

- 39 wins are the most of any team in Minor League Baseball this season, 4 ahead of the next winningest team ... of 120 full season Minor League teams, Omaha's .709 winning percentage is the 2nd-best, just behind the MiLB-best Modesto Nuts (35-14 / .714 / Mariners Single-A)
- 23 wins in May were the most of any Minor League Baseball team ... 23 wins were also the most in a single month for an MiLB team since the Ogden Raptors went 24-4 in July 2019.

TOO CLOSE FOR COMFORT

Omaha has won 6 straight series and 25 of its last 30 games ... 21 of those 30 games have been decided by 3 runs or less, including 18 of the team's 25 wins in this stretch.

- Omaha's relievers had just 4 saves in the first 26 games, but 16 of 30 games since have had a save awarded (from 7 pitchers), the most saves of any team in the Minors since May 1 ... **Will Klein** has 5 saves in that span, while **Dan Altavilla**, **Carlos Hernández**, **Walter Pennington**, **Sam Long** each have 2 ... **Steven Cruz** and **Evan Sisk** each have 1 save in the last 28 games.
- In total, 38 of Omaha's 55 games this year have been decided by 3 runs or fewer (69%), including 12 of 16 losses this season.

I'M DIFFERENT, YEAH, I'M (RUN) DIFFERENT (IAL)

Omaha has outscored its opponents 330 to 247 this season, a +83 run differential.

- A +80 run differential ranks as the best in the International League and is the second-highest mark at the Triple-A level trailing Oklahoma City (Dodgers Triple-A) at +93 ... Omaha ranks 4th in Minor League Baseball in run differential ... Modesto leads all Minor League teams at +142 (3518 to 216).

YOU CAN COUNT ON ME

Two factors contributing to Omaha's success this season include the starting pitchers going deep into games and the offense providing their starters run support.

- When Omaha's starter can get through at least 5.0 innings this year, the team has a 19-3 record (2.863 winning %), compared to 20-13 (.606 winning %) when starters don't make it through the 5th inning.
- When the offense can provide 3+ runs of support, the Storm Chasers are 26-4 (.867 winning %), while the team is just 13-12 (.520 winning %) when the offense offers 2 runs of support or less to the starting pitcher.

PENNY PUNCHIES

Lefty **Walter Pennington** was named the International League's Pitcher of the Week for his performance last week in Omaha's series win over Indianapolis.

- Pennington struck out 12 batters over 6.1 scoreless innings and allowed just one hit while not walking a batter ... 12 K was tied 2nd in the league, with the most strikeouts among pitchers with 6.0 or more scoreless innings.
- He appeared in 3 games, including a start in the second game of a doubleheader sweep on Thursday ... he struck out 4 over 2.0 perfect innings in relief on Monday, tied a career high with 6 strikeouts over his 3.0-inning start and then struck out 2 over 1.2 perfect innings on Sunday to finish the game and earn the win.

RELIEF AID

Omaha's bullpen remains one of the best in the International League and even across the entire Triple-A level.

- The Storm Chasers bullpen has combined to hold opposing hitters to a Triple-A best .203 average (tied 3rd in MiLB), while the .665 opposing OPS ranks 2nd-best and a 3.71 ERA against the Omaha bullpen is 3rd-best in Triple-A.
- Last Friday's win was the 13th time this season Omaha's bullpen has combined to not allow a run ... that is an average of once ever 4.23 games this year of the relievers combining for a shutout.
- The two longest scoreless streaks (by games pitched) at the Triple-A level in 2024 are active streaks from Omaha pitchers ... **Dan Altavilla** and **Evan Sisk** have each not allowed a run over their last 13 games, 13.2 innings since April 23 for Altavilla and 13.0 innings since April 20 for Sisk.
- LHP **Walter Pennington** has 62 strikeouts in 39.0 innings this season, largely pitching in relief (21 relief appearances/2 opener starts) ... his 62 strikeouts are tied 5th-most in the International League, while 50 strikeouts as a reliever lead Minor League Baseball ... his 40.8% strikeout rate is 2nd in MiLB (min. 35.0 IP).
- Altavilla, Sisk and Pennington aren't the only Omaha relievers dominating right now ... **John McMillon** has offered 5 straight scoreless outings and retired 11 straight hitters while **Colin Selby** has 4 straight scoreless outings.

IT'S GONNA BE MAY

The month of May the Storm Chasers produced this year is arguably one of the greatest single months in the modern era of the club.

- 23 wins in May 2024 marks the most wins the team has had in a single month in the modern era (2005-present), passing the August 2005 Omaha Royals who went 21-9.

TODAY'S START

- Bubic is making his 2nd start with Omaha and 7th rehab start this season after opening this year on Kansas City's 60-day injured list, as he makes his recovery from Tommy John surgery early last season.
This is his 7th season in the Royals organization ... skipped over the Double-A and Triple-A levels to make his MLB debut in 2020 and has almost exclusively pitched in the big leagues since, outside of a short stint in Omaha in 2022 ... since debuting with Kansas City in 2020, Bubic's 325.0 innings and 60 games started for the Royals rank third among the club's pitchers in that span.

LAST OUTING: WEDNESDAY, MAY 29 @ INDIANAPOLIS

Made his 6th rehab start, his first with Omaha ... retired 11 of 13 batters he faced, with 7 strikeouts of the 11 outs recorded ... retired his first 8 hitters of the evening, then allowed a two-out walk and single in the 3rd inning and retired his final 3 hitters of the game

2024 HIGHLIGHTS

- Did not appear in any Cactus League games for the Royals ... opened the year on the 60-Day IL, sent to the Arizona Complex League to begin a rehab assignment on May 7, transferred to NW Arkansas on May 18, transferred to Omaha on May 27.
Over 6 total rehab outings this year, is 0-2 with a 4.50 ERA (6 ER in 12.0 IP) with 4 walks to 20 strikeouts (5.0 K/BB).

CAREER NOTES

- 2023: Only made three starts in his fourth Major League season ... placed on the Injured List on April 16 with a left flexor strain and underwent Tommy John surgery in late April.
Threw 6.0 scoreless innings on April 9 @ San Francisco ... allowed two hits and no walks while tying a Major League career-high with nine strikeouts.
2022: In his third season with the Royals, made 28 appearances (27 starts) across two stints tied with Daniel Lynch for the most starts made by a Royal and ranked 5th on the staff with 129.0 innings pitched ... For the second straight year, induced a team-leading 19 double plays, which ranked 4th in the American League, with an AL-best 1.33 GDP-per-9.0 innings rate.
Over his first 6 games (5 starts), was 0-3 with a 12.83 ERA (19 ER in 13.1 IP) with 11 walks and 10 strikeouts and was optioned to Omaha (AAA) on May 12 ... made 3 starts in Triple-A and pitched to a 6.59 ERA (10 ER in 13.2 IP) but struck out 17 batters in 13.2 IP (11.2 K/9) with just 4 walks (4.25 K/BB) ... recalled back to Kansas City on June 4 and finished the season in the majors.
2021: Began the season at the Alternate Site but was recalled on May 1 and remained with the Royals for the rest of the season ... tied 2nd among Royals pitchers with 9 quality starts, one behind Brady Singer (10) ... ranked third on the team with 130.0 innings.
Named the Royals Pitcher of the Month for September/October, as he pitched to a 2.20 ERA (8 ER in 32.2 IP) over 6 starts with 26 strikeouts to 9 walks (2.9 K/BB).
2020: Despite having never pitched at the Double-A or Triple-A levels prior to 2020, made his Major League debut and 10 starts for Kansas City in the shortened season, going 1-6 with a 4.32 ERA (24 ER in 50.0 IP) and 49 strikeouts.
Made his MLB debut in the Royals' 8th game of the season on July 31 vs. Chicago (AL) ... allowed 2 earned runs on 3 hits and 1 walk with 3 strikeouts ... earned his first MLB win in his eighth start, September 11 vs. Pittsburgh with 5.0 one-run innings and 6 strikeouts.
2019: Named Kansas City's Paul Splittorff Minor League Pitcher of the Year and the Wilmington Blue Rocks Pitcher of the Year, as he split the season between Lexington (A) and Wilmington (A+) ... led MiLB with 185 strikeouts (11.15 K/9), tied for the Minor League lead with two complete games, ranked 6th in WHIP (0.97), tied 9th in wins and ranked 10th in ERA.
Pitched in the SiriusXM All-Star Futures Game on July 7 in Cleveland and recorded the final two outs in the fourth inning ... also named the MiLB.com Fans' Choice for Best Starting Pitcher, an MiLB.com Organization All-Star, a Carolina League postseason All-Star and a Baseball America High Class-A All-Star.
2018: Spent his first pro season with Idaho Falls (R) and was named a Pioneer League midseason All-Star ... made 10 starts and struck out 53 in 38.0 innings (12.6 K/9).
COLLEGE (2016-2018): Attended Stanford University from 2016 to 2018 and pitched in 51 games (36 starts) for the Cardinal (Pac-12), with a 15-10 record, 2.82 ERA (70 ER in 223.1 IP) and 235 strikeouts.
