**CASTILLO WINS TENTH:** Maximo Castillo logged his longest start of the season, and Samad Taylor smacked a two-run homer as the Fisher Cats beat the Yard Goats 3-2 at Dunkin' Donuts Park last night. Castillo improved to 10-3 with seven innings for four-hit ball. He allowed a pair of runs before yielding to Brandon Eisert to finish up for his first career save. Taylor's homer, his team-leading 16<sup>th</sup>, came in the third inning and gave the Fisher Cats a 3-0 lead. Tanner Kirwer walked twice and reached on an error. His four stolen bases tied a franchise record.

**BATTING CROWN:** Otto Lopez (now in the Majors), leads Double-A Northeast with a .330 average, and will likely be named batting champion. By rule, he would have to have 2.7 plate appearances per game. Even though he would fall short of that mark by seven plate appearances (over 118 games), his effort would be recognized anyway. An assumption of 0-for-7 would still give him a .322 average. Samad Taylor currently sits third at .300. One can only wonder how Gabriel Moreno would have fared had he not suffered a thumb injury. MLB's #34 prospect was hitting .373 in 32 games for the Fisher Cats.

**UP NEXT AND THE CHASE FOR .500:** The Fisher Cats return home Tuesday for two weeks of games against Binghamton and Portland. New Hampshire has a chance to reach the .500 mark for the first time since they were 1-1 on May 6. The Fisher Cats have only recorded four seasons in which they have played winning baseball, and made the playoffs each time, winning three titles (2004, 2011, and 2018).

**BOB LIPMAN'S THIS DATE IN FISHER CATS HISTORY:** August 20, 2012—Marcus Stroman earned the win with an inning of relief for the Fisher Cats in a 3-2 victory at Binghamton. Then 21, Stroman was drafted by the Jays in the first round (22<sup>nd</sup> overall) out of Duke. After making seven appearances for Short-Season Vancouver, he triple-jumped to Double-A, and was used eight times in relief for an inning before heading to the suspended list for 50 games. In this game, John Tolisano drew a bases-loaded walk in the seventh to break a 2-2 tie.

**MANCHESTER BOSTON REGIONAL AIRPORT FLIGHT TO THE MAJORS:** The Blue Jays open a series with the Tigers with a 63-56 record, and according to 538.com with a 23-percent chance of making the playoffs. Robbie Ray starts for Toronto, which went 9-2 on the first Rogers Centre homestand...Syracuse took a pair from Triple-A Buffalo 4-3 and 2-1. Nate Pearson tossed a 1-2-3 inning in the opener. A pair of homers by Cullen Large wasn't enough. Richie Urena knocked in the only run of the nightcap with a first inning double..Vancouver rolled past Tri-City 9-4...Ft. Myers won the completion of Wednesday's game with Dunedin 6-2, but the Jays won the nightcap 2-0. FCL Jays lost 6-5 to the Phillies. Brock Lundquist, on a rehab assignment, went 1-for-4 with a double in his first action in seven weeks.

## STARTERS:

Elvis Luciano will start off injury tonight and be backed up by Nick Frazee. Luciano left his July 18 start here at Dunkin' Donuts Park after one inning. The 21-year old native of the Dominican Republic has been in the Blue Jays organization since being claimed Rule V in December of 2018. He pitched out of the Toronto bullpen in 2019, appearing in 25 games. Frazee made his Double-A debut last Saturday in Harrisburg, allowing three runs in 4.2 IP. He was selected by the Jays in the 22<sup>nd</sup> round of the 2019 draft (Texas State) and has only 80.2 IP of pro experience after starting this season with Adv. A Vancouver.

For Hartford, David Hill makes his 18<sup>th</sup> start of the season, and 12<sup>th</sup> for the Yard Goats. Earned his only win on July 3 vs. Altoona. Made a pair of starts in New Hampshire on August 3 and August 8, working into the fifth inning each time against the Fisher Cats. Was hit for a pair of early homers August 8 by LJ Talley and Demi Orimoloye, but the Yard Goats rallied for a 10-5 win.

**2019:** Luciano was selected in the Rule 5 draft in December 2018 from the Royals, and spent all of 2019 with the Blue Jays. Made his MLB debut on March 31, 2019. Appeared in 25 games, all out of the bullpen, going 1-0 with a 5.35 ERA.

**2018:** Was in the Royals system, appeared in 13 games – 2 with Pioneer League Idaho Falls – and 11 (all starts) with Burlington, NC (Appy League). KC had acquired Luciano as part of a trade which sent OF Jon Jay to Arizona.

**2017:** In Arizona's system, pitched for Arizona League Diamondbacks and Pioneer League Missoula.

**Career/Personal Notes:** On the opening day roster for the Fisher Cats for the first time. Although he has pitched in the Majors, had not pitched higher than Rookie League level prior to this season.

**Obtained:** Signed by Arizona as a non-drafted free agent in 2017. Traded to Kansas City, and picked up by Toronto in the Rule 5 draft 12/12/18. On Toronto's 40-man roster.

### Next Game Starter

The Fisher Cats turn to Reilly Hovis Saturday night. He will be making his ninth start since joining the Blue Jays organization and his fourth start against the Yard Goats (1-0, 3.00 ERA).

Originally drafted by the Marlins in the ninth round of the 2015 draft (North Carolina), Hovis advanced to Double-A Jacksonville but was cut before the 2019 season. Was playing independent ball for his hometown Gastonia Honey Bears this season when offered the opportunity with the Blue Jays.

Hovis lost Sunday in Harrisburg, allowing seven runs (five earned) on ten hits. He allowed three consecutive homers in the first, allowing five runs, but did pitch into the fifth.

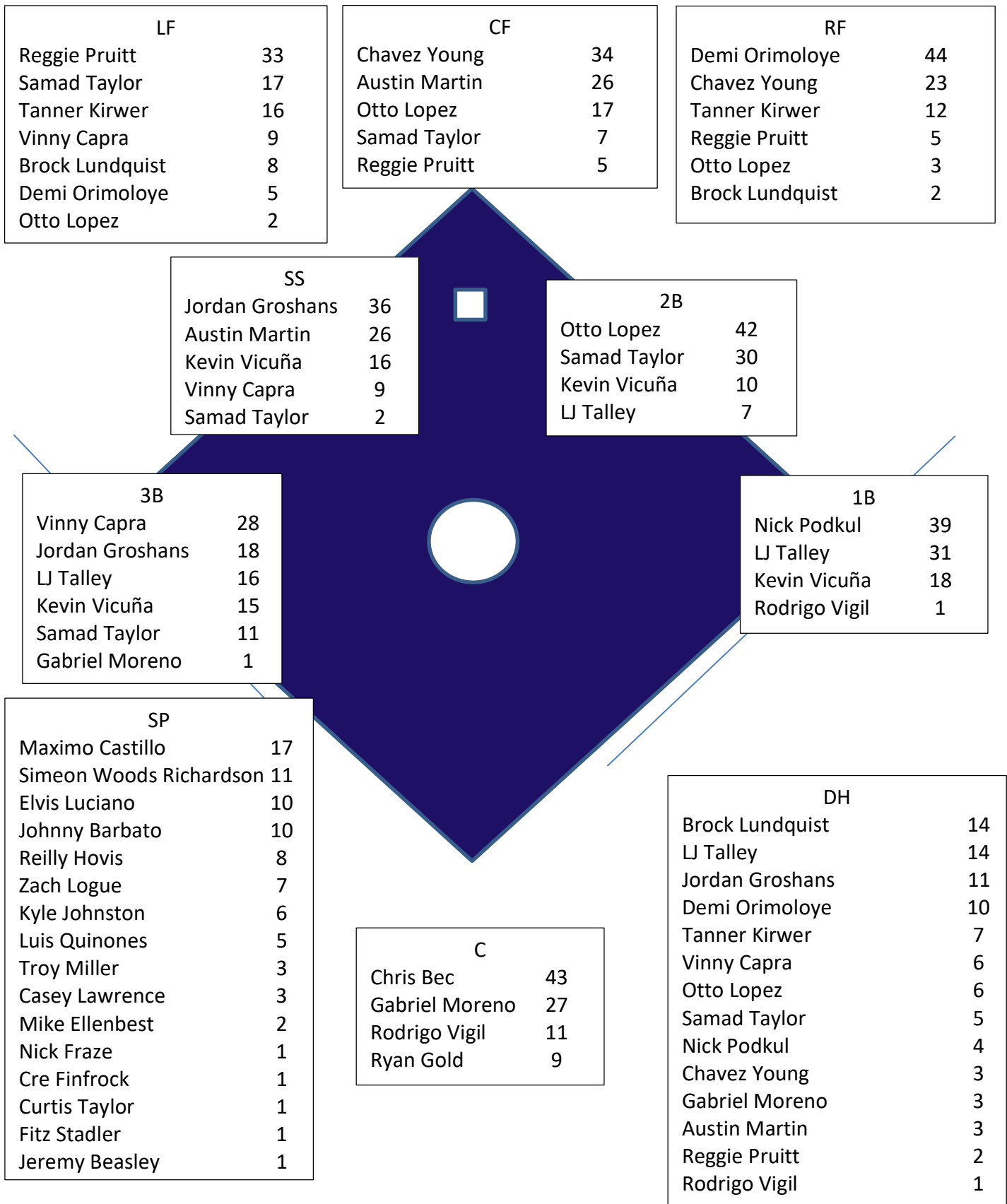
