That's the Season: The Nashville Sounds closed out the 2023 season with an 8-4 win on Sunday afternoon over the Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp, their fifth victory of the series. The Sounds finished 2023 at 83-65 (.561) overall, just one game back of St. Paul (84-64) in the overall 2023 IL West Division standings. Nashville ended with the best record in the IL West in the second half of the season with a 43-31 mark (.581). Unfortunately, the Sounds missed the International League Championship Series by finishing 4.5 games behind Durham in the overall league second half standings. The Sounds had the best record over the last 18 games of the season in Triple-A, boasting a 14-4 mark from September 5 on. It was Nashville's 13th season of winning at least 80 games in franchise history. After following last year's division-winning squad, the Sounds have won 80+ in back-to-back seasons for the first time since 1993-94.

Repping Hit City: A total of 82 players (39 position and 43 pitchers) appeared for the Sounds in 2023. That's the most in a single-season in franchise history. Of those 82, 14 appeared strictly on MLB rehab assignment (7 position and 7 pitchers). Also, 42 have played for the Brewers this season (highlighted in bold). The Best of the Best: Four Nashville Sounds have been named the 2023 Milwaukee Brewers Robin Yount Performance Award recipients, given to the Brewers Minor League Players of the Year and Pitchers of the Year. Jackson Chourio and Tyler Black were named the Co-Players of the Year and Robert Gasser and Carlos Rodriguez were honored as Co-Pitchers of the Year. The awards were announced by the Milwaukee Brewers on Monday, September 25.

The Sounds Player Awards: The Nashville Sounds player awards were announced on Saturday, September 23 in a pregame ceremony. Keston Hiura was named the Most Valuable Player, Robert Gasser was awarded the Pitcher of the Year award, Caleb Boushley was honored as the Community Player of the Year and the fans voted Patrick Dorrian as the Fan Favorite. Congratulations gentlemen!

Sweet, Sweet Victory: Rick Sweet became the winningest Sounds manager in the season finale, passing Trent Jewett (1998-2000, 2003-04) for the most victories in the team's 45-year franchise history. It was his 321st win as skipper in the conclusion of his fourth season (3rd consecutive) at the helm. The 71-year-old skipper became Nashville's manager at the end of the first affiliation with Milwaukee in 2014, then returned when Nashville reunited with the Brewers in 2021. Among Sounds' managers to be at the helm for at least 200 games, Sweet's .563 win percentage is the second-best, trailing only Carl "Stump" Merrill's mark of .622 (178-108, 1980-81). Across his 33 seasons as a minor league manager, Sweet is 2,275-2,103. He has the second-most wins among active minor league managers, trailing only Single-A Myrtle Beach skipper Buddy Bailey, who has 2,355.

Home Run Happy: The 2023 Nashville Sounds tied the single-season franchise record with 183 home runs. The previous record, also 183, was set during the 1999 season. A total of 33 different hitters crushed at least one home run this season, with team MVP Keston Hiura leading the charge with 23. Patrick Dorrian (21), Alex Jackson (12), Cam Devanney (11) and Jon Singleton (10) also registered a double-digit tally in long balls, respectively. The team hit the 11th-most long balls in the league.

That's Gas Bro: Robert Gasser finished as the International League leader in strikeouts (166) and win percentage (.900). It's the first time a Sounds pitcher has led the league in strikeouts since Todd Van Poppel fanned 157 for the top spot in the 1999 Pacific Coast League. Gasser's 166 strikeouts were the fourth-most in a single-season in franchise history and most since becoming a Triple-A team (1985-present). The Sounds have had a pitcher lead the IL in win percentage in back-to-back seasons, as Caleb Boushley paced the league with a .857 win percentage (12-2) last season.

Be a Leader: Nashville's pitching staff led Triple-A with the lowest ERA (4.48), WHIP (1.41) and fewest walks allowed (536). The bullpen also has the best ERA among relievers (4.10), WHIP (1.37) and far and away the fewest walks allowed (263, next fewest is Tacoma with 329).

Paint it Black: Tyler Black finished the 2023 season with a 14-game hitting streak, extending the streak with a single in the first and added a double in the fifth. Black batted .453 (24-for-53) with 16 runs, nine extra-base hits, 11 RBI and a 1.276 OPS since the streak began on September 7. He led the league in average, on-base percentage (.540), and OPS during the streak, also tying for the league lead in hits (with Canaan Smith-Njigba of Indianapolis) and triples (2, with six others).
