**Today:** The Lansing Lugnuts, High-A affiliate of the Athletics, play the third in a six-game series at the Lake County Captains – the 255th all-time meeting between Lansing and Lake County and the ninth meeting of the 2025 regular season. The Nuts and Caps split a six-game series in Lansing at the end of April and start of May. Lansing is coming off winning five of six games at home against South Bend.

**Wednesday: Captains 5, Lugnuts 4.** Christian Knapczyk homered on the first pitch of the bottom of the first inning, and Lake County held off a last ditch Lugnuts rally in the ninth inning to beat the Nuts for a second consecutive day. The game was pushed back an hour at first pitch, and then played in a brisk 2:02.

**On Deck:** The Lugnuts and Captains play through Sunday, then the Nuts return to Michigan's state capital to open a six-game series with the Beloit Sky Carp.

**Prospecting:** The Nuts have six of MLB Pipeline's Top 30 A's prospects: No. 7 prospect (**Tommy White**), No. 10 (**Joshua Kuroda-Grauer**), No. 12 (**Steven Echavarria**), No. 17 (**Ryan Lasko**), No. 18 (**Rodney Green, Jr.**) and No. 28 (**Nate Nankil**).

**Welcome to The Show:** Both ESPN's Jeff Passan and MLB.com's Martín Gallegos reported late Thursday night that 2022 Lugnuts outfielder **Denzel Clarke** is being called up to the Athletics. Clarke would become the third Nut to make his MLB debut this season, joining **Max Muncy** and **Gunnar Hoglund**, and the 196th all-time Lugnut to go from Lansing to the Majors.

**Movement:** On Tuesday the Lugnuts added pitchers **Nathan Dettmer**, debuting tonight, and **Diego Barrera** from Single-A Stockton, promoting pitcher **Kyle Robinson** and activating third baseman **Tommy White** from the Injured List.

**Season Series:** Lansing's lineup is slashing just .196/.297/.279 against Lake County this season, though **Tommy White** was an outlier earlier this year, going 7-for-15 with one double, one homer and four walks in his first five games against the Captains. White wore the golden sombrero in the series opener.

**Keeping the Captains in the Park:** Wednesday marked Lake County's first two home runs of the season against the Nuts, coming in the eighth meeting between the two teams. The Captains are slugging just .341 against Lansing's pitching corps.

**Atop the League:** First baseman **T.J. Schofield-Sam** (.351) leads Lake County infielder **Christian Knapczyk** (.348) for the Midwest League batting title. Schofield-Sam went 2-for-4 Wednesday, extending his on-base streak to 14 games. It was his eighth multi-hit game this month and his 16th this season.

**At the Plate:** The Lugnuts rank second in the Midwest League in batting average (.262), second in base hits (354), second in doubles (82), second in on-base percentage (.360), third in total bases (516) and are the toughest team to strike out (280). The Lugnuts are also third in the league in grounding into double plays (33).

**In the Field:** The Nuts are the best defensive group in the league, posting a .981 fielding percentage with only 28 errors committed in 1,443 chances, topping second-place West Michigan (29 errors, 1,472 chances, .980) ranks higher. The Lugnuts rank third in the league in fewest stolen bases allowed (33 in 47 attempts).

**On the Mound:** Lansing's pitching corps is first in the league in holds (19), first in complete games (2), first in fewest HBPs (14), first in fewest balks (3), first in fewest walks (145) and fifth in saves (11).

**DK at the Helm:** The 19th manager in Lugnuts history is **Darryl Kennedy**, entering his second year in the A's organization. Kennedy distinguished himself as a catcher at Manatee Community College before starring at the University of North Florida and was named an NCAA All-American in 1991 en route to North Florida's Hall of Fame, inducted in 2017. Kennedy played in the Minor Leagues for seven seasons, including parts of four seasons in Triple-A. Following his 1997 retirement, he immediately began managing, leading the Gulf Coast League Rangers to the 1998 GCL Championship.

### MAY 23RD IN LUGNUTS HISTORY

**2013:** Daniel Norris struck out 10 in four shutout innings, allowing three hits and two walks, and the host Lugnuts beat Lake County, 6-1. It was the Lugnuts' eighth straight victory (with the streak ending the next game, May 25, at South Bend).

**2014:** An ugly one at Parkview Field: The TinCaps built a 6-1 lead with three runs in each of the first two innings, gave up four runs in the third (including an L.B. Dantzler three-run homer) to narrow the score to 6-5, and then broke the game open with a six-run bottom of the third that saw starter Matt Dermody and manager John Tamargo, Jr., get ejected after Dermody drilled Dustin Peterson purposefully, followed by a member of the TinCaps in the home dugout shouting at Dermody as he walked past on his way back to the clubhouse (the path to the clubhouse leads directly past the dugout at Parkview). Tamargo got involved, shouting back, and the two sides needed to be separated. The TinCaps went on to romp, 17-6, scoring in seven of their eight at-bats (blanked in only the sixth).

**High School:** Attended Claudia Taylor "Lady Bird" Johnson High School in San Antonio (blue, navy, silver, the Jaguars)... school is known for its marching band... graduated Class of 2020... senior season was ended early due to COVID; tossed 18 hitless, scoreless innings and was named 2020 6A Texas High School 1st Half Pitcher of the Year.

**Aggieville:** Majored in Kinesiology at Texas A&M... "plans to become a baseball coach," according to A&M bio... as a freshman in 2021: 17 G, 12 GS, 3-2, 4.37, 55 2/3, 27 BB, 49 K... sophomore: 19 GS, 6-3, 4.99, 92 IP, 25 BB, 82 K... junior: 17 GS, 1-4, 6.32, 72 2/3, 42 BB, 65 K...
