**YESTERDAY...** Bowling Green dropped the fifth game of the series against Rome 4-3 on Saturday. The Hot Rods brought in the first run of the game on an RBI single from Alika Williams, taking a 1-0 lead. The Braves offense exploded for four runs in the fourth, scoring all of their runs in the inning, taking a 4-1 lead. Hill Alexander added a run with his 10th homer of the season in the sixth and picked up his second RBI with a base hit in the eighth, bringing the score to 4-3. Both teams were scoreless for the ninth inning, ending in a Braves win, 4-3.

**DOUBLE-DIGIT DINGERS...** Hill Alexander collected his 10th homer in a Bowling Green uniform on Saturday against Rome. He is now the ninth Hot Rods hitter to reach the double-digit homer mark. Alexander is just the sixth active Bowling Green player to have 10 or more homers with Greg Jones, Ruben Cardenas, and Niko Hulsizer all moving up to AA Montgomery.

**RACE TO 70...** The Charleston Riverdogs, the Tampa Bay Rays Low-A affiliate, became the first team to win 70 games in minor league baseball. With both teams playing a Braves affiliate, Charleston came up with their 70th win over the Augusta Green Jackets, beating Bowling Green to 70 by one game.

**ADDING HOMERS...** Three home runs for Bowling Green on Friday made up a majority of the offense. This boosts their season total to 172 long balls, placing them first in the MiLB. Two other High-A teams have joined them in the top five, including fellow High-A East member Greensboro with 153, sitting in fifth place. High-A Central Great Lakes has moved into the fourth spot with 156.

**GETTING CLOSE...** With his 21 st bomb of the year, Evan Edwards is tied for second place in single-season home runs in Hot Rods history. Edwards and Ronaldo Hernandez ('18) are tied at second place, just one behind franchise leader Derek Dietrich, who had 22 homers in 2011. Jordan Qsar is also within striking distance of the record. He is currently sitting in third place with 20 homers in 2021. Grant Witherspoon has put himself in fifth place with 18 homers this season.

YESTERDAY'S NOTES... Alexander had his ninth multi-RBI and 11th multi-hit games of the season... His homer makes him the ninth Hot Rods hitter to hit double-digit home runs this year... Williams had his first multi-hit game for Bowling Green... Edward ended a seven-game hit streak... BG is 7-4 this year when having an equal amount of hits as their opponent... The Hot Rods are 45-17 when scoring first... Bowling Green is 48-23 against right-handed starting pitchers... They are 14-10 in the month of August...

**NOW PITCHING: TAJ BRADLEY...** The righty is making his second start against Rome this week after receiving a no-decision on Tuesday. In the first game, Bradley tossed 5.0 innings, giving up just one run while striking out four. Since making his first Hot Rods start on August 6th, Bradley has posted a 2-0 record with a 3.15 ERA, walking five and striking out 22.

August 29, 2015

On this day in Hot Rods history, Bowling Green took down the Dayton Dragons 7-5. Hunter Lockwood got Bowling Green on the board in the top of the fourth with a solo homer, tying the game at 1-1. In the top of the fifth, the Hot Rods scored four runs, highlighted by RBI base hits from Thomas Milone and Alec Sole. Cristian Toribio brought in the final run for the Hot Rods in the sixth inning with a single, expanding their lead to a final 7-2. Hyrum Formo tossed six innings, giving up three runs on six hits while walking one and striking out two.

Personal: Bradley was one of three players selected in the 2018 MLB Draft out of Redan High School... He was the highest selection out of his teammates...
