WEDNESDAY AFTERNOON WINNER: The Delmarva Shorebirds opened their series in Fredericksburg with backto-back wins thanks terrific pitching and late offense. Juan Nunez set the tone on the mound by tossing the longest by a Delmarva pitching this year by going five innings, facing the minimum of three batter in four of his five innings. With the game tied at two in the seventh, Douglas Hodo broke the tie with a two-run single. He'd provide another run scoring hit in the eighth to up the lead. Samuel Basallo & Jackson Holliday each drove in a run as well with Moises Chace covering the final four innings for the Shorebirds out of the bullpen with seven strikeouts, a season-high for any Delmarva pitcher as he earned the win in a 7-4 victory.

TODAY'S OPPONENT: The Shorebirds will look to make it three straight over the Nationals on Thursday night with **Jared Beck** taking the mound against Nationals prospect pitcher, **Jarlin Susana**. Susana is currently the No. 6 prospect in Washington's organization and was acquired along with four other minor leaguers in the Juan Soto/Josh Bell trade last August.

TWIN KILLING CATCHERS: The Shorebirds have gotten tremendous contributions from their catching duo of **Samuel Basallo** and **Creed Willems** to start the 2023 season. The two have combined for 31 hits, 6 doubles, 7 home runs, and 26 RBIs as the two have very identical offensive numbers through the first 11 games of the season. The two catchers have combined for an OPS of 1.271 and have been the focal point of Delmarva's hot start offensively. Willems has an RBI in five-straigt games and 8/9 starts to begin the year. Basallo has driven in a run in three-straight including four game with multiple RBIs.

LIVING UP TO THE HYPE: The first pick in 2022 Draft, **Jackson Holliday**, continues his impressive start to his first full-season in professional baseball as he has two 4-RBI games this season and is tied for second in the Carolina League in extra base with 6, only behind his teammate **Creed Willems** who has 7. Holliday has found himself on base often as he owns an on-base percentage of .510 thanks to 10 walks. He has drawn at least one walk in every game but one this season with a hit in seven of his nine starts. He has reached base in every game he's played in this season.

TEACH ME HOW TO DOUGIE: Douglas Hodo came through late for the Shorebirds in Wednesday's win over Fredericksburg by driving in a total of three runs in his final two hits in the seventh and eighth inning in the 7-4 win over the Fred Nats. Hodo has reached base in all seven games he's played in, drawing a walk in each of the first six as he obtains an on-base percentage of .500 currently with his 3 RBIs on Wednesday a young careerhigh for the 2022 6th round pick.

HALT THE WALKS: The Delmara pitching staff has been haunted by walks in the first ten games of the season as they have allowed 76 free passes after yielding a season-high 15 on Tuesday night versus Fredericksburg. Tuesday was Delmarva's fourth game this year with ten or more walks but are now 3-1 in those games.

THE BALTIMORE KID: Maxwell Costes has made the most of his playing time as the Baltimore native has a hit and an RBI in three of his first five starts including his first professional home run on Sunday afternoon on the first pitch he saw in the at-bat. Costes is 2nd all time at the University of Maryland in home runs as he hit 40 across his four-year career there.

PAYBACK TIME: Delmarva looks to reverse their fate from 2022 against the Fred Nats as their North Division rival had the upper hand in 2022 by going 7-17 versus the Nationals. Virginia Credit Union Stadium was especially not kind to the Shorebirds as they went 1-11 in games at Fredericksburg including losses in their first 9 contests there.

TODAY'S STARTER: 7'0 southpaw, Jared Beck makes his second start and third appearance of the season on Thursday night against the Fred Nats.

LAST OUTING (4/14 vs KAN): Beck last appeared out of the bullpen a week ago when he pitched three innings versus the Kannapolis Cannon Ballers. Beck entered the game with his team down 5-1 and Kannapolis continued their hot hitting that night by adding five runs on seven hits and departed with the team behind 10-1 in an eventual 14-4 win for the Cannon Ballers.

vs. FREDERICKSBURG: Tonight will be the second time Beck faces the Fred Nats but the first time as a starter. The left-hander came out of the bullpen on August 31 in Fredericksburg and threw 2 innings in his third career appearance and allowed 4 hits with 2 strikeouts and 2 walks. He allowed 3 runs but only 1 was earned in a 12-8, comeback win for the Nationals.

2022 SEASON HIGHLIGHTS: Beck appeared four times out of the bullpen for the Shorebirds after being drafted in the 13th Round of the 2022 Draft by the Orioles from Saint Leo University in Florida. He was effective in his brief action in Delmarva that covered 10 innings with 10 strikeouts and 4 earned runs allowed. At Saint Leo's, he led the team in strikeouts with 105 in 68.1 innings as he concluded his final college season with a 4-4 record in 13 starts.

FELIPE ROJAS ALOU JR.

Returns to the Shorebirds for his second season as manager and his 16th in the Orioles organization. Previously, he served as the Director of the Orioles' Dominican Republic Academy. He was a 40th round pick by the Kansas City Royals in the 1998 amateur draft, he played in the minor leagues for the Royals from 1998 to 2001, and in the short-lived Canadian Baseball League in 2003. His father, Felipe, played in the Majors for 15+ years before managing the Expos ('92-'01) and Giants ('03-'06). Alou's brother, Luis Rojas, was the manager of the Mets and is currently on the Yankees coaching staff. This will be Felipe's 16th season in the Orioles organization.

Enters his first season as the Shorebirds Pitching Coach in 2023 after spending last season as a O's Pitching Coach in the Florida Complex League. From there, Bleday spent two season in the Astros minor league ranks before making the jump to coaching in 2019.

Josh Bunselmeyer takes over as the Shorebirds Hitting Coach in 2023 after spending the last three seasons as a hitting coach for the Orioles between the Florida Complex League and the Dominican Summer League. Before coaching, Bunselmeyer played independent ball for the three season in the Frontier League as a utility player after playing college baseball for Saint Louis University.

FUNDAMENTALS COACH



Daniel Fajardo Is back in Delmarva for his second season as the Shorebirds Fundamentals Coach. After playing eight seasons in the Orioles minor league system and parts of two with the Shorebirds, Fajardo made his professional coaching debut with the 'Birds in 2022 bringing a wealth of knowledge from his time as a catcher. A 2019 Shorebirds Mid-Season All-Star, Fajardo was a Shorebirds fan-favorite hitting for a career .251 average with 124 RBI and 106 Runs Scored.

Collin Murray is the Shorebirds Development Coach and this is his second season as a coach in Delmarva and in the Orioles' organization.
