LAST TIME OUT

The Bowie Baysox gave up a season-high 17 hits and gave up 13 runs in a 13-5 loss to Somerset on Friday night. Somerset scored five runs in the first two innings and knocked starter Cameron Weston out of the game after he recorded just two outs. Bowie trimmed a six-run deficit down to just two with four runs in the fifth and sixth innings, including a homer by TT Bowens. However, the Patriots pulled away with four runs in the sixth and two in the seventh and hit four homers on the night to even up the series two games apiece.

BASALLO IS HOT

C Samuel Basallo ended the month of May as Bowie's best hitter. The Orioles No. 2 prospect led Baysox hitters with a .297 AVG. His OBP jumped from .276 in April to .373 OBP in May. Basallo's season-long eight-game hit streak came to an end on Friday but he is still on a nine game on-base streak. Over his last 10 games, the 19-year-old is batting .361 (13-for-36) with two homers, a double, nine RBI and an OPS of .995.

TT HITS TATERS

OF/1B TT Bowens smacked his second homer of the series on Friday with a solo homer in the sixth. The 26-year-old collected a team-high three hits on the night, his third three-hit game of the season. Bowens is a on a season-long nine game hit streak, his second nine-game hit streak of the season, and is also on a 10 game on-base streak. The undrafted free agent out of Central Connecticut State is tied for fourth in the Eastern League in RBI (31).

BUILT BY THE BULLPEN

Bowie's bullpen leads the Eastern League and all of Double-A in innings pitched (234.1) and strikeouts (280). Conversely, Bowie's starters have thrown the fewest number of innings in the league and in all of Double-A (186.1). The bullpen has accounted for 22 of Bowie's 24 wins on the regular season. The Baysox bullpen owns a 1.21 WHIP, which is good for fifth-lowest in all of Double-A.

KISSING MAY GOODBYE

After batting a league-best .256 in the month of April, Bowie batted a league-worst .214 in the month of May. Bowie scored the most runs in the league in the month of April (118) but scored the fourth-fewest runs (111) in the month of May. The Baysox also struck out the most times in the month (271).

TIME FOR TRACE

RHP Trace Bright makes his 10th start of the regular season. The Orioles No. 16 prospect most recently dealt 4.2 innings and allowed two runs (one earned) on one hit over two walks and five strikeouts on Sunday vs Richmond in a no-decision. The Baysox are 4-5 this season when Bright pitches. The 23-year-old threw 4.1 shutout innings in his last road start at Binghamton on May 15 to lower his road ERA this season to 2.51. This is Bright's first career start against Somerset.

PREVIEWING THE PATRIOTS

Entering this week, the Somerset Patriots are fourth in the Northeast Division at 22-23. The Double-A affiliate of the Yankees most recently took three of seven at New Hampshire but have won two of their last three. Nine of the Yankees' top 30 prospects, per MLB Pipeline, are on the active roster- OF Spencer Jones (No. 2), LHP Brock Selvidge (No. 10), C/1B Ben Rice (No. 12), C Agustin Ramirez (No. 20), RHP Zach Messinger (No. 21), RHP Trystan Vrieling (No. 22), RHP Jack Neely (No. 24), RHP Danny Watson (No. 27), and IF Benjamin Cowles (No. 29).

TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

RHP Blane Abeyta makes his 10th start of the season. The 25-year-old gave up five runs on five hits across four innings in his last start on Sunday in New Hampshire. Abeyta has given up five or more runs in six of his nine starts this year. The right-hander is in his second season with the Patriots after working as a starter for much of last year. Abeyta pitched against the Baysox twice last year, went six innings in both starts and posted an ERA of 1.50.

2024: Delivered 4.2 IP and gave up 2 R (1 ER) on 1 H over 2 BB and 5 K on Sun. 5/26 vs RIC in no decision. Has punched out five or more batters in seven of nine starts. Finished month of May with a 3.68 ERA over 22 IP. Looking to pitch five innings for first time since 4/26 vs RIC. First career start vs Somerset. Finished month of April with a 2.41 ERA over 18.2 innings pitched with 23 strikeouts. Went five innings each in three straight starts from 4/14 - 4/26. Named to Bowie Opening Day roster.

2023: Began first full season in minors in High-A Aberdeen and struck out 127 batters in 82.2 IP. Led IronBirds in strikeouts. Finished 4th in South Atlantic League in strikeouts. Punched out a career-high 10 batters in just 3.1 innings in 2023 season debut against Wilmington. Posted a 5.04 ERA in the first half but pitched better in second half of season, posting a 3.55 ERA with 62 strikeouts over 38 innings. Earned promotion to Double-A Bowie on August 22. Went at least four innings and struck out at least four batters in each of his first four Double-A appearances. Completed first Double-A stint with a 2.12 ERA in 17 innings over 20 strikeouts.

2022: Debuted professionally with FCL Orioles. Assigned to Single-A Delmarva on August 27. Struck out three over three shutout innings in Delmarva debut against Lynchburg. Finished first professional season with a 1.86 ERA in 9.2 innings.

College: Pitched three seasons at Auburn. Best season was his junior year in 2022 where he struck out a career-high 94 batters in 80.2 innings over 18 appearances (17 starts). Led team in starts, innings and strikeouts. Was only Auburn pitcher to start all 17 weekends of the season. His 94 strikeouts were fourth most by an Auburn pitcher since 2000. Helped Auburn reach Men's College World Series and earned the win in Tigers first CWS win since 1997.

Personal: Drafted in the 5th round of the 2022 MLB Draft by the Baltimore Orioles out of Auburn. Highest drafted pitcher signed by Baltimore that year after not coming to terms with third round pick Nolan McLean. Full name is Bob Ike Bright. Grew up an Orioles fan because he has family that lives in Havre de Grace.

During select games during the 2024 season, the Baysox will take the field as the Cangrejos Fantasmas De Chesapeake, as the Baysox look to continue to embrace the culture of local U.S. Hispanic communities.

Boasting a desire to better represent the Chesapeake Bay area, Bowie’s “Cangrejos Fantasmas de Chesapeake” identity came to light after research presented the existence of the small, yet active Atlantic Ghost Crab species in the bay.



CHESAPEAKE BAYSOX

On Sunday, May 26, the Bowie Baysox will take the field as the “Chesapeake Baysox.” This alternate identity was created to celebrate and learn about the conservation of the nearby Chesapeake Bay. The uniform tops are detailed with stenciled outlines of local wildlife, design, and architecture around the Chesapeake Bay.

In addition to activities around Prince George’s Stadium promoting the conservation of the Chesapeake Bay, the jerseys will be auctioned off following the May 26 contest, with proceeds benefitting the Chesapeake Bay Foundation.



BOWIE PIT BEEF

The “Bowie Pit Beef” is an alternate identity of the Bowie Baysox that pays tribute to the culinary culture of Maryland. The Baysox will take the field as the Bowie Pit Beef on both June 23 and August 4.

Pit Beef consists of top round cuts of beef, thinly sliced and prepared over a charcoal fire. The meat is cooked quickly at high temperatures and has a slight smoked flavor. The sandwich got its name on Baltimore’s east side in the 1970s, before being popularized by the 1980s.



COACHING STAFF

ROBERTO MERCADO

Manager

The 17th manager in Baysox franchise history, Mercado spent each of the past two seasons as the manager of the High-A Aberdeen IronBirds. He was honored with the Orioles organization’s Cal Ripken, Sr. Player Development Award following his first season with Aberdeen in 2022. Prior to the start of his professional career, Mercado spent 17 years on the coaching staff at New Britain High School in Connecticut. He began as an assistant coach in 2004 before being promoted to head varsity coach in 2011. In addition to coaching the New Britain baseball team, Mercado served as the Dean of Students for over 18 years. He also spent time as an assistant coach of the Yarmouth Dennis Red Sox in the Cape Cod Baseball League from 2014-2022 and was a coach in the Goodwill Series, where high school baseball players from the United States competed overseas in both Australia and New Zealand in 2017 and 2018.

AUSTIN MEINE

Pitching Coach

Meine joins Mercado in the move from High-A Aberdeen. Meine served as the IronBirds pitching coach in 2023, where he helped Aberdeen post the third-lowest ERA (3.81) and second-most strikeouts (1,363) across the South Atlantic League. He previously spent two seasons on staff at the University of North Carolina at Charlotte, where he guided the 49ers to the two highest single-season strikeout totals in program history. Meine has also worked on staff at the Premier Pitching and Performance facility in Missouri. He pitched collegiately at Lindenwood University.

JOSH BUNSELMAYER

Hitting Coach
