Today's Game

The Fightin Phils hit the road and begin a six-game series at the Binghamton Rumble Ponies, Double-A affiliate of the New York Mets. It is the seventh-of-18 games between the teams this season and first-of-six at Mirabito Stadium. The Rumble Ponies took four-of-six games at Reading from Apr. 15-20 and return to FirstEnergy Stadium from July 22-27. Binghamton leads the season-series 4-2.

Game 25 Recap

Down by one run with two outs in the bottom of the 10th inning, Felix Reyes launched a walk-off two-run home run to right-center field to give the Fightin Phils a 4-3 win over the Senators, winning two games in last week's series. The Fightin Phils jumped out to a 2-0 lead thanks to runs in the first and second innings. Robert Moore hit a leadoff home run, his team-leading fourth of the season, in the bottom of the first inning. Mitch Neunborn, who started the game, allowed two runs in the third to tie the game at two, a score that would hold all the way into the 10th inning. Wesley Moore allowed the placed runner to score in the top of the 10th to put Harrisburg up 3-2, but Felix Reyes played hero for the dramatic Fightin Phils victory on Sunday. The Fightin Phils stranded a season-high 17 men on base and were two-for-19 with runners in scoring position.

Walk it Off in Extras

Felix Reyes' walkoff home run was the Fightin Phils first walk off win of the season. Reading had four walk-off wins in 2024, with the last coming when Otto Kemp scored Aidan Miller on a catchers' interference on Sept. 4 vs Erie. But, the R-Phils did not hit a walk-off home run last season. Reyes' walk-off home run was the Fightin Phils first walk-off homer since Ethan Wilson hit one on July 16, 2023, vs Portland. Sunday was also Reading's first extra-inning game since Aug. 28 of last season. In total, the R-Phils had seven extra-inning games in 2024, going 2-5.

Rolling Reyes

Felix Reyes' walk-off home run was the cherry on top of a terrific week for the right-handed bat. Over five games, Reyes slashed .400/.412/.733 (1.145 OPS), while adding three runs, two doubles, one home run and five RBI, while striking out just one time in 17 plate appearances.

Starting and Ending it in Style

Robert Moore led off Sunday's game with a home run on the first pitch of the game. It was the first leadoff home run for Reading this season and the first since Aug. 2, 2024, vs Hartford from Marcus Lee Sang. Felix Reyes' walkoff home run was Reading's second game-winning homer of the season, with the first coming from Keaton Anthony on Apr. 13 at Somerset, in the top of the ninth inning.

Awesome Anthony

Entering play on Tuesday, Keaton Anthony has a team-best 10-game hitting streak (since 4/18) and 15-game on-base streak (4/12). Over his 10-game hitting streak, Anthony is slashing .324/.400/.471 (.871 OPS), with three doubles, one triple and four RBI. Anthony's 10-game hitting streak is the longest active hitting streak in the Eastern League and his 15-game on-base streak is tied for the longest on-base streak in the Eastern League, with Kyle Karros of Hartford.

Good Week for the Bullpen

The Fightin Phils bullpen ended the series on a high note. In total, five relievers pitched on Sunday with Mitch Neunborn getting the start. The group combined to allow just two-earned runs over 10-innings of work, while striking out 13 and walking just one. Following a tough start from Chuck King last Friday night, the bullpen comined for five-scoreless innings to keep Reading in the game.

On The Move

On Tuesday, the Philadelphia Phillies announced an array of transactions to the Fightin Phils roster. Josh Breaux and Cade Fergus were added to the roster from Lehigh Valley (AAA). Paul McIntosh was activated off the 7-day IL and Jordan Dissin was placed on the injured list. Cole Roberts was transferred to Jersey Shore (A+) and Colton Bender was released.

This Day in Baseballtown History

May 7, 2007: At Bowie, Joey Hammond goes 4-for-5 with two doubles, two runs scored, a stolen base and six RBI as the Phillies rip the Baysox, 11-2. Javon Moran also collects four hits, walks, steals a base and scores three runs. Bubba Nelson tosses 4.0 perfect innings, striking out five for the save.

Rumbling into Binghamton

Binghamton enters tonight with a 15-11 record, sitting in third place in the Northeast Division. In 2024, the Rumble Ponies finished with a 69-67 record. Binghamton was in Erie last week and went 3-3, having to play two doubleheaders due to two games being rained out. After this week, the Rumble Ponies are back on the road and face Hartford in a seven-game series at Dunkin' Park. Six of the Mets' top-30 prospects are on Binghamton's roster: Jett Williams (2), Ryan Clifford (4), Jonah Tong (6), Nick Morabito (17), Jonathan Pintaro (23) and Jack Wenninger (28).

Ponies Pitcher

Lefty Zach Thornton makes the start tonight for Binghamton. It will be Thornton's second Double-A start as he made his debut with Binghamton on Apr. 30 at Erie, allowing two runs on five hits over 4.1 innings, with two strikeouts. Thornton started the season with Brooklyn (A+) and went 3-0, with a 0.44 ERA over four starts with the Cyclones. He split 2024 between St. Lucie (A) and Brooklyn, combining to go 5-4 with a 4.10 ERA over 20 games and 12 starts. The 23-year old was drafted by the Mets in the fifth round of the 2023 draft out of Grand Canyon.

Chace posted a season-high with four-innings pitched, while matching his season-best with four strikeouts. It marked the first outing this season where Chace did not allow any runs. The righty scattered just three hits and ultimately took a no-decision. Chace was relieved by Jack Dallas in the top of the fifth.

2025 Season:

- Prior to the 2025 season, Chace was added to the Phillies 40-man roster (on 11/19/24) to protect him from the Rule-5 Draft
- The Phillies optioned Chace to Reading (AA) on March 8
- Chace appeared in one game for the Phillies during Spring Training (3/7 at PIT) and threw a perfect inning
- Started for the Phillies in the Spring Breakout Game (3/14 vs PIT) and tossed a 1-2-3 first inning, while striking out two hitters in his lone inning of work
- Opens the season ranked as the Phillies No. 5 Prospect (MLB Pipeline)
- Made first start of season Apr. 9 at Somerset, lasting just two innings and walking four batters
- Has not had a decision yet this season, pitching a season-high four innings Apr. 30 vs HBG
- First scoreless outing of season Apr. 30 vs HBG: 4.0 IP, 3 H, 1 BB, 4 SO

2024 Season:

- Began the season in the Baltimore Orioles organization, making 17 appearances (nine starts) with Aberdeen (A+)
- Traded to the Phillies on July 30, along with Seth Johnson, for Gregory Soto
- After making two starts with Jersey Shore (A+) was promoted to Reading (AA) on Aug. 13
- Went 3-1, with a 2.59 ERA in five August starts (7 ER, 24.1 IP), named Phillies Minor League Pitcher of the Month of August
- Set a brief career-high with 10 strikeouts over 4.2 IP on Aug. 24 at Binghamton
- Followed up with new career-high 13 strikeouts on Aug. 31 at Somerset, in best start of career. Had 19 swing and misses on night, with 13 against fastball; Named Eastern League Pitcher of the Week following start
