**GONE FISHING:** The Sounds shutout the Stripers in a 2-0 win Thursday night, marking Nashville's third shutout victory of the season and the second at home. The other two shutout wins came against the Charlotte Knights on April 2 and Louisville on May 10. This was the 20th shutout win when allowing three hits or less since 2021 and the 63rd overall shutout win when allowing three hits or less in a game since 2005 during the regular season.

**I AM SPEED:** Thursday night's game against the Stripers marked the shortest completion of a game (9 IP) this season for Nashville (1:57). It marked the quickest game in the International League this season and the second fastest in Triple-A level behind Tacoma and Sugar Land's game on April 7 (1:54). They are the only two Triple-A contests that have been completed under two hours this season so far. The last time the Sounds had a sub-two hour nine-inning game was on June 25, 2022, against the Stripers as well (1:59) in the first year the pitch clock was implemented in its modern form across all full-season minor league levels.

**LOCKED IN:** Tyson Hardin was tremendous on the mound in Thursday night's game against Gwinnett and worked 6.0 scoreless innings on two hits and struck out five Stripers batters to earn his second quality start in three Triple-A starts for the Sounds. It was his ninth career quality start and third against a Braves affiliate. He tossed a quality start in his first career Triple-A start on May 17 vs. Iowa (7.0 IP, 4 H, 2 R, ER, 7 K, 3 BB). The Sounds have won all three games that Hardin has started since joining Nashville, including taking his first career Triple-A win on May 23 against Durham (5.2 IP, 4 H, 2 R, ER, 7 K, 3 BB). Over his first three starts with Nashville, the Brewers no. 17-rated prospect owns a 0.96 ERA (2 ER / 18.2 IP) with 18 strikeouts and seven walks. He currently leads the Brewers organization with 61 strikeouts this season across 10 starts between Double-A Biloxi and the Sounds and a organization-high 48.0 IP.

**FOUR-LOKO:** Reiss Knehr tallied his fourth win of the season, posting two scoreless innings and striking out three hitters as he retired all six Gwinnett batters that he faced. This win ties Knehr's longest win streak of his career, the first one came during the 2021 season across seven starts from May 28-July 1 with Double-A San Antonio (3.47 ERA, 36.1 IP, 24 H, 14 ER, 30 K). He added two quality starts during that streak, earning the victory in both of them. Knehr's fourth win is tied for the most wins on the team with Easton McGee, while he is tied for the third-longest active win-streak in the International League and tied for fifth in Triple-A. He has posted a 2.35 ERA, allowing just four runs in 13 relief appearances for the Sounds this season.

**LU-THREES LARA:** Luis Lara earned his second triple of the season, both coming against the Stripers, on a liner to right field to score Cooper Pratt and gave the Sounds the 1-0 lead in the bottom of the seventh inning. Lara has been hitting lights out for the Sounds this season, leading the team in batting average (.346), hits (66), runs (47) and stolen bases (18). The .346 batting average ranks fourth in the International League and sixth in Triple-A. He also leads the International League in runs, ranks second in hits, third in OBP (.450), tied for fifth in walks (35), seventh in total bases (99), and eighth in OPS (.968).

**NINE AND DINE:** Luis Matos extended his current hitting streak to nine straight games with a RBI double in the bottom of the seventh inning on Thursday night. His current streak is tied for the sixth-longest active streak in the International League and he's hitting .355 (11-for-31) since May 7.

**YO QUERO:** Jeferson Quero clubbed his sixth homer of the season with a two-run home run to left field on Wednesday night. That homer marked his third two-run blast of the year, his fifth off right-handed pitchers and his third at First Horizon Park this season. Quero has posted a hit in seven-of-his-last-11 games and his first homer since May 14 against the Iowa Cubs. He recorded his 11th multi-hit game of the season which is fifth on the team. The multi-RBI game marked his ninth of the year, which ties for the second-best on the team behind Eddys Leonard (10). Quero's 32 RBI are the fifth-best amongst qualified Brewers minor league players this season and second on Nashville's roster behind Leonard (33).

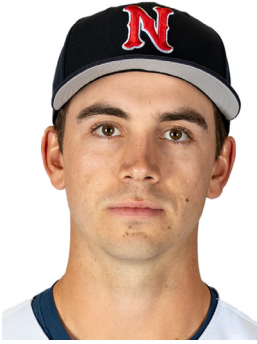

- Activated from the 60-day IL and optioned to Nashville on August 30, 2025...Made one start and four relief appearances for the Sounds.
- Recalled to Milwaukee on September 21 and made two starts to end the regular season before pitching twice in relief during the 2025 postseason.
- Entered 2024 as the no. 6-rated prospect in the MIL system (*Baseball America*)
- Began the 2024 season with Nashville (3 G, 0-1, 5.25 ERA) before having his contract selected on May 10...Made his Major League debut vs. St. Louis...Earned the win and became the first player in franchise history to throw at least 6.0 IP without a run or walk allowed in Major League debut (6.0 IP, 2 H, 4 K).
- Was 2-0 with a 2.57 ERA in five starts for the Brewers in 2024...Team was 5-0 in his starts and he had two quality starts.
- First pitcher in Brewers history to win each of his first two Major League games... joined by Logan Henderson in 2025.
- Placed on the 15-day IL on 6/5/24 with a left flexor strain, later transferred to the 60-day IL on 6/25 after undergoing "Tommy John" surgery.
- Named 2023 International League Pitcher of the Year and Co-Minor League Pitcher of the Year for the Brewers (Carlos Rodriguez) after going 9-1 with a 3.79 ERA in 26 G (25 GS) for Nashville.
- Led Triple-A and was second among Brewers farmhands with 166 strikeouts in '23.
- Brewers Co-Minor League Pitcher of the Month in June 2023 and Minor League Pitcher of the Month in August 2023.
- Traded to Milwaukee from San Diego as part of the Josh Hader deal on August 1, 2022...At the time was the no. 9-rated prospect in the Padres organization.
- Ranked fifth in Minor League Baseball in 2022 with 172 strikeouts in 137.0 IP.
- Made six starts his first professional season in 2021...Went 0-0 with a 1.20 ERA.
- Graduated from Oak Ridge HS in California
- Began his collegiate career at the University of New Mexico before transferring to San Joaquin Delta College where he was named Rawlings/ABCA Pacific Association Division I National Pitcher of the Year as a sophomore (14-0, 2.38 ERA, 102.0 IP, 139 K)
- Transferred to University of Houston and was a First-Team All-American Athletic Conference as a senior in 2021 (6-6, 2.63 ERA, 85.2 IP, 105 K).
- Father, Jim, was a pitcher drafted by Milwaukee (1984) and San Francisco (1986) but did not sign due to injury.
