## RIDERS HIT FOUR HOMERS, DROP GAME TO HOOKS:

The Frisco RoughRiders launched four home runs, but fell 9-5 to the Corpus Christi Hooks from Riders Field on Thursday night. **David Garcia** rammed his second-career multi-homer game in the defeat. Frisco fell behind early when Enmanuel Valdez doubled in the first run for Corpus Christi in the first inning and Justin Dirden added an RBI single to make it 2-0. In the second, Bryan Arias hit a solo shot off of **Cody Bradford** (3-3), who took the loss for Frisco in his start, pushing the score to 3-0. Bradford allowed six runs over his four innings. The Riders found the scoreboard in the bottom of the second and made it 3-1 when Garcia hammered a solo home run off of the waterfall in right for his second home run of the season. Corpus Christi then pushed the lead further to 6-1 with a Yainer Diaz RBI double in the third and a Jose Alvarez solo shot in the fourth. **Dustin Harris** answered back for Frisco with a solo home run of his own in the fourth, his fifth long ball of the season, and Garcia launched a two-run shot in the sixth to draw the Riders to a 6-4 deficit. In the top of the seventh, Dirden crushed a three-run home run to separate the Hooks and balloon the lead to 9-4. **Blaine Crim** lifted a ninth-inning solo homer, his team-best eighth of the year, but it was not enough as the Riders were handed a 9-5 loss. **Grant Wolfram** and **Tim Brennan** both threw two scoreless innings out of the Riders bullpen in the defeat. Thursday marked Brennan's first outing since September of 2021.

## LIMITING THE HITS:

The Riders pitching staff owns the second-best opponent batting average in the Texas League (.232), only trailing the Arkansas Travelers (.228). The Riders have struggled allowing base runners overall, ceding 178 walks (4.9 per game), which is the second-most in the Texas League behind Corpus Christi (220).

## POWER SURGE:

The RoughRiders exploded for eight long balls in the series finale against Tulsa on Sunday. The eight home runs tied a franchise record for the most home runs in a game by any Frisco squad, equaling the RoughRiders total from July 22nd, 2011 when Frisco defeated Corpus Christi, 19-4. **Trey Hair** also became the first Riders batter to knock three home runs in a game since 2012 when Chris McGuinness accomplished the feat on June 22nd, 2012. Over the last nine games, the Riders have blasted 22 home runs, which is second in all of Minor League Baseball to Tulsa (24). On the season, the Riders 49 home runs are third in the Texas League overall.

## DURAN, DURAN: DOUBLE TROUBLE

Riders infielder **Ezequiel Duran** leads all of Minor League Baseball in doubles with 16. After a monster Sunday, in Tulsa, going four-for-four with two doubles, two home runs, five runs scored and five RBIs, Duran is now hitting .383 (23-for-60)/.435/.783 over his last 15 games with seven doubles, one triple, five home runs, 17 RBIs and one steal. The Rangers No. 4 prospect by MLB.com has a .919 OPS this season now. In May, Duran is seventh in the Texas League in OPS (1.128) and first in extra-base hits (13).

## AYYY, IT'S THE FOSC:

Riders infielder **Justin Foscue** has caught fire for Frisco. After starting in Extended Spring Training because of back tightness, he joined the club on April 19th. Foscue went 1-for-7 in his first two games, but in his last 18, the former Mississippi State Bulldog has hit .314 (22-for-70)/.442/.586 with 11 doubles, a triple, two home runs, 13 RBIs, 15 walks and 11 runs. He is riding a 17-game on base streak, where he owns a .462 OBP and a 1.027 OPS.

## JONNY ON THE SPOT:

Riders infielder **Jonny Ornelas** has been tearing the cover off of the baseball in recent days. Ornelas has batted .365 (46-for-126)/.407/.492/.899 in his last 30 games and .381 (37-for-97) with .975 OPS over his last 23 games. He has six games with at least three hits this season to lead the club. Ornelas is also the youngest player on the Riders and the 21-year-old is the 10th-youngest in the Texas League. Ornelas owns a .351 average on the season, which is tied for third in Double-A and the best in the Texas Rangers organization. Ornelas owns 47 hits, the second most in the Texas League.

## THE VIPER STRIKES AGAIN:

Known as "The Viper" since his college days at Alabama, Frisco reliever **Chase Lee** has struck quickly and often this season. Over his 13 outings, Lee has allowed just five hits (.102 BAA) while not allowing a run and going 3-for-3 in save opportunities. In his 15.0 innings, Lee has whiffed 19 while walking just six. Lee spurs a bullpen that is the best in the Texas League in ERA (4.03) and BAA (.201).

## REARVIEW MIRRORS:

Since the 2019 season ended and the standings reset on September 3rd, 2019, the RoughRiders have not been in second place for 989 days. From the season-opening game in 2021, the RoughRiders held first place the entire season and have now been in first place for every game in 2022 as well.

### ABOUT JACK

-Leiter was drafted in the first round (No. 2 overall) in 2021 by the Rangers out of Vanderbilt University. With the Commodores, Leiter was a unanimous First Team All-American and a finalist for both the Golden Spikes Award and the Dick Howser Trophy.

-Threw first regular-season, complete-game no-hitter to start SEC play since 1971 against No.16 South Carolina on March 20th, 2021. He walked the first batter of the game before retiring the last 27 he saw with 16 strikeouts on 124 pitches. Followed up that no-hitter with 7.0 no-hit innings in his next start (20.2 consecutive no-hit innings over three starts from March 20th - April 2nd).

-Drafted in 20th round in 2019 by NYY out of Delbarton School (NJ). Named 2019 New Jersey Gatorade POY, striking out 95 in 57 innings as a senior.

-The family lineage is strong with Jack. His father, Al, pitched in 19 MLB seasons (1987-2005), making two All-Star teams and winning both the 1993 and 1997 World Series. His uncle, Mark, played 11 seasons in the majors (1990-99; 2001) and his cousin, Mark Jr., pitched two seasons (2017-2018) with Philadelphia and Toronto. Al now works as an analyst for MLB Network.

### 2022 SEASON

-Leiter entered the 2022 season as the No. 17 prospect in baseball according to MLB.com. He is listed as the No. 1 prospect in the Rangers organization as well.

-Leiter dazzled in his professional debut, striking out seven over his three innings against the Arkansas Travelers on April 9th. The righty helped draw the largest crowd since 2019 at Riders Field for the debut (9,322).

-Threw the Riders first quality start of the season on May 7th against Arkansas. Leiter retired the last 15 batters he saw, allowing just two hits (one in the first and one in the second inning).

### 2021 SEASON

-After being drafted second overall in the 2021 draft, Leiter did not pitch in the minor leagues. Instead, he returned to Vanderbilt to workout, continue college and prepare for 2022. Did not finish degree, but got closer.

### MORE INFO

-Leiter was high school teammates with Yankees No. 1 prospect (No. 8 in baseball) Anthony Volpe at Delbarton School (NJ).
