#### **Looking Back**

Reading and Portland split a doubleheader last night. Reading won the first game 5-2, thanks to home runs from Carlos De La Cruz, Baron Radcliff and Madison Stokes. David Parkinson pitched 4.2 innings in the resumption in his ninth win and Orion Kerkering earned his sixth save. Portland took the second game 6-0 as Reading was shut out for the fourth time this season and were held to just three hits.

#### Abel's Strong Run

Mick Abel stayed hot with six-shutout innings Wednesday night. Over his last three starts (dating back to Aug. 23) Abel is 1-0 with a 1.00 ERA, with just five hits allowed and 15 strikeouts. He owns a WHIP of 0.72 and opponents are hitting just .091 against Abel. After last night, Abel qualifies for a variety of Eastern League leaderboard ranks: ERA (10th), Strikeouts (T9th), BAA (1st) and WHIP (4th).

#### He Dunn Gets On Base

Oliver Dunn matched a season-high Wednesday night with three walks. He has now reached base in 15-straight game. He now has 80 walks on the season, which puts him in sole possesion of first place in the Eastern League in walks. Dunn also has the following Eastern League ranks is various other categories: AVG (4th), HR (5th), RBI (T2nd), OBP (1st), SLG (2nd), OPS (1st), Hits (T5th), 2B (2nd), 3B (T4th), XBH (1st), TB (2nd) and Runs (T6th).

#### Closer On Lock

Orion Kerkering picked up his sixth Double-A save Friday night, as he threw a scoreless ninth inning. Kerkering has now converted on his last six save oppurtunities and hasn't allowed a run in his last six outings and 13 of his last 14. Dating back to July 26 (14 apppearneces) Kerkering is 6/6 in saves, with a 1.29 ERA and 18 strikeouts.

#### Around the Organization

The Phillies fell to the Marlins 3-2 last night to begin a three-game weekend series with Miami. Lehigh Valley rolled Buffalo 11-2 as Weston Wilson hit two home runs (30/31) to set the IronPigs single-season home run record. Lehigh Valley is tied with Durham for first place with 14 games to play. Jersey Shore was rained out last night, but sits half a game behind Brooklyn with three to play and holding the tiebreaker. Plus Brooklyn only has two games left to play. Clearwater defeated Palm Beach 7-3 to improve to 79-49 overall. Emaarion Boyd had two hits and stole his 55th base of the seasson. The Threshers have two games to play and will begin the Florida State Leage Playoffs next week.

#### Welcoming the Dogs

Portland enters tonight with a 29-32 record in the second half, which is third in the Northeast Division and six-games back of Binghamton. Overall, the SeaDogs are 69-61 after narrowly missing out on the first half title. Last week, Portland won two-of-six against Somerset and close the regular season against Hartford at home next week. Portland has the following Red Sox top prospects on its team: Marcelo Mayer (1), Roman Anthony (2), Kyle Teel (4), Nick Yorke (6), Wikelman Gonzalez (9), Blaze Jordan (12), Nathan Hickey (15), Angel Bastardo (16) and Chase Meidroth (20).

Wikelman Gonzalez will start the second game tonight for Portland. Gonzalez started against Reading on July 16 and went six innings and allowed no runs on four hits, with nine strikeouts. Last Saturday he warned the win, pitching six-shutout innings against Somerset and allowed just one hit, with five strikeouts.
