#### RIDERS FALL SHORT ON FRIDAY NIGHT:

The Frisco RoughRiders loaded the bases in the top of the ninth but fell to the Corpus Christi Hooks 6-4 on Friday night from Whataburger Field, ending a four-game winning streak. In the top of the ninth, Luis Mieses scored on a wild pitch, cutting the Hooks (5-14) lead to 6-4, but **Abimelec Ortiz** grounded out to end the game. Frisco (13-6) struck first when **Aaron Zavala** clubbed a sacrifice fly in the top of the first inning. Then, in the bottom of the second, Corpus Christi's Luis Encarnacion laced an RBI single to tie the game 1-1. In the top of the fourth, **Keyber Rodriguez** cranked a solo homer to power the Riders back in front 2-1. Corpus Christi answered in the bottom of the fourth when Rowdey Jordan drilled a three-run homer to give the Hooks a 4-2 lead. In the bottom of the fifth, Luis Castro connected on a fly ball to left, but Zavala made a leaping catch at the fence to rob him of a homer. The Hooks expanded their lead to 6-2 in the bottom of the sixth on a John Garcia RBI single. In the top of the seventh, **Cam Cauley** reached on an error to plate **Alejandro Osuna**, cutting the Hooks lead to 6-3. Mieses' run scored in the top of the ninth brought up Ortiz as the go-ahead run, but his groundout ended the ballgame. Hooks reliever Wilmy Sanchez earned his third save of the season, allowing just one run on the wild pitch in the top of the ninth. Alejandro Torres (1-1) garnered the win while Riders starter Ben Anderson (0-3) picked up the loss.

Outfielder **Alejandro Osuna** is off to a great start scoring runs in 2025. Osuna's 18 runs scored are tied for the most in franchise history through 19 games played. The player he is tied with (Ryan Cordell, 2016) had a 1.114 OPS, but Osuna just has a .734 OPS. Osuna's base running seems to be causing more runs, even though he is not putting himself in situations to score more runs than Cordell at the plate (Cordell had five home runs, nine doubles to this point vs. Osuna's one home run and five doubles). Osuna's 18 runs scored are also tied for the most in the Texas League this season (tied with Peyton Wilson, NWA, who has a 1.196 OPS).

#### KEYBERRRRR, IT'S COLD IN HERE:

Keyber Rodriguez has been fantastic at the plate for the RoughRiders. Over his 14 games this season, he is hitting .347 (17-for-49). 414. 449. 863. In a six-game hitting streak, he is slashing . 455 (10-for-22). 500. 636/1.136 with one double, a home run, three RBIs, two runs scored, two walks and three stolen bases. Over the season, he has three three-hit games.

**LITTLE SEBASTIAN? BIG SEBASTIAN:**Top prospect **Sebastian Walcott** has been off to an incredible start with the RoughRiders. The 19-year-old is the second-youngest player in the Texas League in 2025. During an 12-game on-base streak, he is hitting .333 (14-for-42)/.473/.571/1.044 with four doubles, two home runs, 10 RBIs, 11 walks, 12 runs scored. In that streak, he has walked 11 times while striking out 11 times. His career .861 OPS in Double-A is the fifth-best in the Texas League as 19-year-old since 2005 (min. 100 ABs). The top three are **Oscar Taveras** at .971 (2012, SPR), Mike Trout at .955 (2011, ARK) and Daric Barton at .914 (2005, MID).

#### FLYING THE COOP:

Cooper Johnson has started out well in 2025 on both offense and defense. At the plate, he is hitting .268/.423/.561/.984 with three doubles, three home runs, seven RBIs, 10 walks and seven runs scored. He is sixth in the Texas League in both SLG and OPS. On defense, Johnson leads the Texas League with eight caught stealings behind the plate, throwing out eight of 12 base runners against him. His 67 percent caught-stealing rate is the best in MiLB currently.

#### **POWER BRINGS WINS:**

The RoughRiders have shown off their punch to begin the season and have been great on offense during their first 19 games. Frisco's 20 home runs through 19 games are tied for first in the Texas League. They are fourth in BA (.258), second in SLG (.412) and second in OPS (.768). **Josh Hatcher**, **Cooper Johnson** and **Luis Mieses** have all hit three home runs, tied for the team lead. Over this stretch where they have won 11 of their last 15 games, Frisco is hitting .262/.360/.428/.788 while also ranking second in runs per game (6.1) and tied for first in home runs (17).

#### HATCHIN' HITTIN':

Josh Hatcher was incredible for the RoughRiders in 2024 and he has picked up right where he left off in 2025. Hatcher hit .300/.350/.448/.798 over 107 games with Frisco last season. He was one of just three qualified hitters in all of Double-A baseball to hit .300 or better. To start 2025, he reached safely in all 13 of 15 games he's played in, batting .381 (24-for-63)/.388/.603/.991 with five doubles, three home runs, 18 RBIs, a stolen base and 11 runs scored over his first 15 games. His .381 batting average is 9th in all of Minor League Baseball. Hatcher already has eight multi-hit games and is 7-for-10 when putting the first pitch of an at-bat in play with two home runs.

#### VERSUS THE HOOKS:

The Riders dominated Corpus Christi last season, going 17-7 against the Hooks. This was in large part due to their dominance on the mound, owning a 3.01 ERA (71ER/212.0IP) in their 24 head-to-head meetings a year ago. Since 2021, the Riders are 50-35 against Corpus Christi despite their losing record against the Hooks in their franchise history (273-280). At Whataburger Field, the Riders are 28-18 since 2021

He completed his final year of high school online while playing baseball.

- After spending two months at GPA, he played in the MLBD raft League during the summer of 2021, going 1-1 with a 2.57 ERA while playing for the West Virginia Black Bears.
- -Baseball America ranked Bratt as the No. 3 Canadian prospect going into the 2021 draft.
- -Committed to play baseball at Florida State

-Made one start for Team Canada in the 2023 World Baseball Classic as a 19-year-old against Team USA, going 0.1 IP, 3 H, 6 R, 6 ER, facing MLB All-Stars Mookie Betts, Mike Trout, Paul Goldschmidt, Nolan Arenado, Kyle Tucker, Tim Anderson and JT Realmuto.

#### **2025 SEASON**

- -Ranked as the No. 17 prospect in the Rangers organization by MiLB.com.
- -Recorded RoughRiders first quality start of the season on 4/11 at NWA, allowing two runs over six innings with six strikeouts to no walks. He moved up a day in the rotation, pitching on five days rest.

#### **2024 SEASON**

- -Ranked as the No. 21 prospect in the Rangers organization by MiLB.com.
- -After tough first start of the season (3.0 IP, 8 H, 7 R, 7 ER, 0 BB, 4 K vs. JS) with Hickory, has gone 6-3 with a 2.30 ERA over his last 16 games (14 starts) with 80 strikeouts to 16 walks over 74.1 innings.
- -In last 10 games in Hickory (nine starts), went 4-1 with 1.35 ERA, striking out 55 over 53.1 IP to 11 walks, holding opponents to .182 batting average.
- -Dominated with Hickory while a head in the count, allowing a. 163 average and .240 slugging (a sopposed to .298 average and .638 slugging when behind in the count).
- -First Double-A start was 5.0 shutout innings at San Antonio on 8/1.

#### **2023 SEASON**

- -Spent all of 2023 with High-A Hickory and was selected as an MiLB.com Organizational All-Star.
- -Despite being 19 at the beginning of the season and turning 20 midway through the year, he ranked fifth in the South Atlantic League in ERA (3.54) among those with at least 15 starts.
- -Was placed on the Injured List from 7/18-8/31 with lat tightness.
- -Played under Carlos Cardozain the 2023 Arizona Fall League with the Surprise Saguaros, going 1-0 with a 6.46 ERA over six games (one start).

#### **2022 SEASON**

- -Was named an MiLB.com Organizational All-Star with Low-A Down East, entering the season as the youngest pitcher in the Carolina League at 18 years old.
- -He finished the season third in ERA (2.45).
- -Named the Rangers Starting Pitcher of the Month for July, going 3-1 with a 1.96 ERA.
