**LAST OUTING:** Went 3.0 scoreless innings at Memphis on May 28. In his season long outing, Clarke allowed two hits and zero earned runs on 50 pitches.

AGAINST OPPONENT: This is Clarke's third career outing against Memphis. His first appearance came on June 8, 2018 in Memphis while pitching for Reno. He went 6.1 innings, allowing three hits, one earned run with seven strikeouts in a no-decision. Kevin Herget was the starter for the Redbirds in that game. His second career outing against Memphis came on Tuesday.
