JUMBO SHRIMP CLOSE OUT HOMESTAND WITH WIN CH

A four-run sixth inning guided the Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp to an 8-3 Easter Sunday win over the Durham Bulls Sunday afternoon from 121 Financial Ballpark. In the sixth inning, Jacksonville plated four runs to blow the game wide open. Jerar Encarnacion knocked a single to right field and went to third on a single from Charles Leblanc. Two batters later Jacob Amaya walked to load the bases. A wild pitch brought home Encarnacion from third. Then, Alex De Goti brought in Leblanc and Amaya with a two-run single to push the lead to 5-1. Following an error that put two runners on, Xavier Edwards doubled, scoring De Goti to give the Jumbo Shrimp a 6-1 lead.

FIRST THINGS FIRST

For the eighth game in a row to start the season, Jacksonville got their leadoff man on to begin their first at-bats when **Xavier Edwards** walked on the first at-bat of the bottom of the first inning from Durham starter **Luis Patiño** Of those eight leadoff baserunners, five have come on swings on the first pitch, with the lone exceptions being a single on an 0-1 pitch to **Garrett Hampson** on March 31 at Gwinnett and a 1-1 pitch to Edwards Friday night against Durham. Six of those eight leadoff baserunners have also come via hits; **Brian Miller** reached on an error to start the Jumbo Shrimp's contest on April 2 at the Stripers and Edwards walked to start the bottom of the first on Sunday against Durham.

A-B-C, EASY AS 1-2-3

Jacksonville is coming off their best overall performance of the year in Sunday's 8-3 win over Durham. The three runs allowed was the second occurrence in 2023, where the pitching staff allowed three runs or fewer. The Jumbo Shrimp's 12 strikeouts ranking as the second-most and the most for the Jumbo Shrimp since fanning 17 Durham Bulls on May 20, 2022. Jacksonville also recorded two 1-2-3 innings; they now have just 23 in their 75.2 innings pitched this season.

SHRIMP BITES

Jordan Groshans has at least one hit in all eight games so far this season, going 8-for-30 (.267/.313/.300/.613) at the plate with one double, three RBIs and five runs scored.

CHARLOTTE'S WEB

Jacksonville makes their first trip to Charlotte in 2023, starting tonight. Since the club's first season back in Triple-A, Jacksonville owns a 28-23 record against the Knights. The two teams played each other to a razor thin margin last year (16-14). Against Charlotte, the Jumbo Shrimp hitters slashed .288/.367/.470 with an .837 OPS (2nd-highest) among 2022 division opponents. The pitching staff owned 4.51 ERA (3rdlowest) among 2022 division opponents.

THE ENDS JUSTIFY THE MEANS

Only three teams in the IL (Iowa, Omaha and Norfolk) have scored more runs than Jacksonville through the season's first eight games. Despite the club's 55 runs scored, the Jumbo Shrimp rank 10th in average (.251), 17th in on-base percentage (.312), 11th in slugging percentage (.434) and 11th in OPS (.746). With runners in scoring position, though, Jacksonville's slash line jumps up to .272/.324/.478/.802, figures that rank second, 11th, third and third, respectively.

ON THE OTHER SIDE THOUGH...

While the Jumbo Shrimp are tied for fourth in the league in runs scored, they also have ceded the most runs in the IL by a huge margin. Jacksonville has yielded 63 runs, an average 17.9 per game. Charlotte, which is tied for fourth in the 20-team league entering play on Tuesday, has surrendered 48 tallies (5.3 per game) and are closer to 11th-place than to Jacksonville. The Jumbo Shrimp have issued the fourth-most walks (45) in the circuit, while ranking 19th in batting average against (.275) and 19th in hits allowed (81). The club has surrendered at least five runs in all but two game so far.

GO C.J., GO C.J., GO C.J., GO

On Jacksonville's slugging offense, perhaps no one has shined more than **C.J. Hinojosa**. Through five games thus far in 2023, Hinojosa is 9-for-21, slashing a robust .429/.435/.905/1.340 with two doubles, one triple, two home runs, nine RBIs and three runs scored. The Houston native ranks tied for sixth in the International League in RBIs, fourth in batting average, second in slugging and third in OPS. He has knocked in at least one run in every game he's played so far this year, with hits in four of his five contests.

-Palacios was signed as a non-drafted free agent on July 2, 2016 by the Miami Marlins when he was 16 years old.

-He was first introduced to the states in 2019 to pitch for the GCL Marlins.

-In 2018, Palacios led the DSL with a 0.597 WHIP in 63.2 innings. He struck out 62 and walked four. They slashed just .155/.173/.183 off him.

2023 SEASON

2022 SEASON

-Palacios posted a 2.65 ERA in April in 17.0 innings. He struggled in the month of May (5.23 ERA in 31.0 innings), but pitched better in June (4.13 ERA in 24.0 innings).

Palacios earned a promotion from Low-A Jupiter to High-A Beloit on July 22. He was promoted again, this time to Double-A Pensacola, on September 9.

2021 SEASON

-Palacios pitched better at home with Low-A Jupiter in 2021. In six starts at home, he went 4-2 with a 2.83 ERA. However, in six road starts, he posted a 1-4 record and 5.10 ERA in 30.0 frames

-Palacios held right-handed hitters to a .166 average and .549 OPS in 206 plate appearances. Left-handed batters batted .315 with a .969 OPS in 56 plate appearances.

-Opponents batted .167/.208/.313/.521 in 52 plate appearances with runners in scoring position.

2019 SEASON

-Palacios split the season as a starter and reliever. In four starts, he collected a 1.69 ERA (16.0 IP, 13 H, 2 BB, 17 K). In six relief appearances, he had a 0.74 ERA (24.1 IP, 12 H, 0 BB, 25 K).

ADDITIONAL CAREER NOTES

-Palacios hails from Cagua in Venezuela. Cagua was established in 1620 as "Cagua La Vieja", a town of original Spaniards. Cagua was rebuilt in its current location in 1622 with the new name of "Nuestra Señora del Rosario de Cagua," which was changed to "San José de Cagua" during the 18th century. The city is now known simply as Cagua. The origin of the name comes from the indigenous Cumanagoto word "Cahigua," which means snail.
