YESTERDAY: The Flying Squirrels were shut out by the RubberDucks, 5-0. Akron scored three runs in the first to take the lead. Milan Tolentino brought home a run with a sacrifice fly and Dayan Frias hit a two-run single. In the second inning, Joe Lampe hit a two-run double to open a 5-0 lead. Richmond relievers **Ben Madison**, **Seth Corry** and **Eric Silva** held Akron hitless over the final 3.2 innings. Richmond outthit Akron, 5-4, in the game, but the Flying Squirrels issued nine walks.

TODAY'S GAME: The Flying Squirrels face the Akron RubberDucks, Double-A affiliate of the Cleveland Guardians, in the finale of a three-game series. The two teams split a six-game series at The Diamond in the Flying Squirrels' first home series of the season from April 9-14. From April 30-May 5, Richmond dropped five-of-six in Akron, part of a 1-11 road trip. The RubberDucks return to Richmond for a six-game series at The Diamond from September 3-8. The Flying Squirrels are 1-1 in rubber games this year.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS lost the final three games of last week's series against the Senators at The Diamond after winning their previous four games. They went 3-3 the previous week against the Baysox. For the year, the Flying Squirrels are hitting .225 and averaging 3.71 runs per game (167 runs/45 games) at home compared to a .236 batting average and 4.80 runs per game on the road (211 runs/44 games). The Flying Squirrels are 11-5 in their last 16 road games since June 12.

THE RUBBERDUCKS are in first place in the Southwest Division second-half standings. They opened the second half winning 13-of-15 games before dropping the final two games of last week's series at Reading and the first game of this series. They also lead the Eastern League with 51 wins this season. Akron's pitching staff leads the Eastern League in ERA (3.25), shutouts (12) and innings pitched (781.0). Akron's roster includes five of Baseball America's top-30 Guardians prospects, including 1B/OF C.J. Kayfus (No. 10), LHP Parker Messick (No. 17), OF Petey Halpin (No. 19), SS Gabriel Rodriguez (No. 20) and 3B Dayan Frias (No. 24). Halpin is also rated as the best defensive outfielder in the organization. MLB.com's top-30 Guardians prospects list includes four Akron players, including Halpin (No. 15), Messick (No. 21), Kayfus (No. 27) and Frias (No. 28).

FOR RICHMOND: Right-hander **Trevor McDonald** makes his third Double-A start. He last pitched last Saturday in the second game of a doubleheader against the Senators and allowed two runs over five innings in his longest outing of the season to date. He made his Double-A debut on July 5 against the Baysox and allowed three runs (two earned) over four innings. He was promoted to Double-A on June 30 from High-A Eugene. He began the season on the injured list with a groin injury and did a rehab assignment with the ACL Giants the final two weeks ago. He was assigned to Eugene in June and made five starts for the Emeralds, going 0-1 with a 4.86 ERA. McDonald was selected in the 11th round of the 2019 MLB Draft out of George County High School in Lucedale, Miss. He missed part of the 2023 season with a hamstring injury. McDonald is rated by Baseball America as the No. 18 Giants prospect and No. 12 by MLB.com. **For more on McDonald, see page two.**

FOR AKRON: Left-hander Matthew Boyd makes a rehab start. He is in the process of returning from Tommy John surgery last year. Boyd made his first rehab appearance for the ACL Guardians on Tuesday against the ACL Angels and allowed one unearned run over three innings, striking out seven. Boyd was originally drafted by the Blue Jays in 2013 out of Oregon State. He was traded to the Tigers on July 30, 2015 along with Daniel Norris and Jairo Labourg for David Price. After eight seasons with the Tigers, he signed as a free agent with the Giants before the 2022 season but did not pitch that season after suffering an elbow strain while working to return from surgery to repair a torn flexor tendon. The Giants traded Boyd to the Mariners that August along with Curt Casali for former Richmond pitcher **Michael Stryfeler** and current Richmond catcher **Andy Thomas**. After spending the 2022 season with Seattle, he returned to Detroit for the 2023 season and made 15 starts before being shut down with an elbow injury last July. Boyd signed with the Guardians on June 29.

BLANK SPACE: Last Wednesday, the Flying Squirrels pitched their 10th shutout of the season, beating the Senators, 5-0. The 10 shutouts are tied for the second-most in the Eastern League, even with Harrisburg and Erie and trailing only 11 by Akron. It is also the most shutouts in a season for the Flying Squirrels since they had 12 in 2016.

DOUBLE TROUBLE: The Flying Squirrels turned three double plays on Friday night. It was the third time this season the Richmond defense has recorded three double plays. On the season, Richmond leads the Eastern League with 62 double plays turned. For the year, the Flying Squirrels have turned 13 double plays with **John Michael Bertrand** pitching, which is the most in the league. The three double plays induced by Bertrand on Friday were tied for the most by a pitcher in a game this season in the Eastern League.

GLOW SHOW: Since June 29, **Jimmy Glowenke** is batting .320 (16-for-50) with two homers, six doubles and nine RBIs over 15 games. In that span, he has picked up three hits three times, including Friday's series opener at Akron. Last season, Glowenke hit .155 (11-for-71) in his first 21 Double-A games from May 31-June 30 before batting .290 (51-for-176) in his final 54 regular-season games from July 1-September 17.

BERICOTO BASHING: In his last 32 games dating back to June 6, **Victor Bericoto** is hitting .336 (44-for-131) with three homers, eight doubles, seven walks and 16 RBIs. After leading the Giants organization in homers (27) last year, Bericoto hit just one homer in his first 34 games this season through May 21. From May 22-28, he homered three times in five games. He went deep again on June 14 at New Hampshire and added a homer on June 18 at Portland, but he has not homered in his last 22 games. In his last 42 games since May 22, Bericoto is batting .382 (52-for-163) with six homers, nine doubles, 13 walks and 25 RBIs. Bericoto has picked up multiple hits in 12-of-24 games dating back to June 15 and is batting .344 (33-for-96) in that stretch.

SCORELESS WORK FROM SILVA: Reliever **Eric Silva** has thrown eight consecutive appearances dating back to June 19 without allowing a run, spanning 10.2 innings. He has 15 strikeouts in that time frame. That span has lowered his season ERA from 6.41 to 4.58. Since throwing an immaculate inning on June 9 against the Curve, Silva has gone 3-0 with a 1.26 ERA (2 ER/14.1 IP) with 20 strikeouts and four walks. Earlier this season, Silva threw six consecutive scoreless outings from May 1-21, spanning 9.2 innings with 10 strikeouts. Over his next six outings prior to his current scoreless streak, he posted a 10.38 ERA (10 ER/8.2 IP) from May 26-June 14.

PACKING THE HOUSE: The Flying Squirrels drew an average of 7,113 fans in April for their home games at The Diamond to open the season, their highest April average in franchise history. The previous high was 6,891 in 2014 followed by 6,571 in 2019. This season, the Flying Squirrels are leading all 30 Double-A teams and are ranked eighth among the 120 minor league clubs in average home attendance (6,725), outpacing the highest average attendance in franchise history (6,689 in 2013).

PROSPECT WATCH: Four of Baseball America's top-30 Giants prospects are on the Richmond roster, including OF **Vaun Brown** (No. 10), RHP **Trevor McDonald** (No. 18), RHP **Eric Silva** (No. 20), C **Adrián Sugastey** (No. 23) and RHP **José Cruz** (No. 28). On Baseball America's Best Tools list, Sugastey is rated as the best defensive catcher and **John Michael Bertrand** is rated as having the best control. MLB.com's top-30 Giants prospects list features five Richmond players, including McDonald (No. 12), Brown (No. 15), OF **Victor Bericoto** (No. 19), Sugastey (No. 23) and OF **Jairo Pomares** (No. 26).

BOULEVARD TO THE BAY: This season, 10 former Flying Squirrels players have reached the majors for the first time. That is tied for the second-most in a season in franchise history. Last year also saw 10 former Flying Squirrels players debut in the big leagues, including a team-record five from that season's Richmond roster. In 2014, a team-record 11 alumni made their MLB debuts, including **Joe Panik**, **Adam Duvall**, **Andrew Susac**, **Matt Duffy**, **Jackson Williams**, **Edwin Escobar**, **Hunter Strickland**, **Chris Dominguez**, **Gary Brown**, **Brett Bochy** and **Chris Heston**. The Flying Squirrels alumni to debut in the majors this season are **Erik Miller** (2023 Flying Squirrels), **Landen Roupp** (2022-23), **Kai-Wei Teng** (2022-23), **Nick Avila** (2022), **Randy Rodriguez** (2022-23), **Mason Black** (2023), **Gerson Garabito** (2021), **Spencer Bivens** (2023), **Raymond Burgos** (2023) and **Hayden Birdsong** (2023-24). Dating back to 2022, 20-of-the-last-21 Flying Squirrels alumni who have reached the majors have debuted with the San Francisco Giants, with Garabito (Rangers) being the only exception.
