Pedrique was the interim manager for the Diamondbacks during the 2004 season, going 22-61 to conlucde the season.

Oliver Dunn continues his torrid month of August, thanks to two hits and a home run last night. This month, Dunn is slashing .377/.414/.849 with seven homers, 21 RBI, 12 runs scored and 11 extra-base hits. He paces Reading in a variety of offensive categories and is amongst the leadeers in the Eastern League as well. Last night, Dunn moved into second in the league with 69 RBI on the season.

Scouting Report: With a tall frame, Abel projects as a right-handed starter. Has a quick arm and fastball sits in mid-to-upper 90s. Also showcases a mid-80s slider, which is a plus pitch for Abel. Has a slower curveball and changeup. As Abel develops, scouts look for him to hone in on his command and improve strike throwing. Growing in that area could help him reach ceiling as front-half of the roation big league starter.
