LAST TIME OUT: The Cyclones dropped their fourth-straight contest in a 6-0 loss at Hudson Valley on Wednesday night...All six Renegades' runs were scored in the bottom of the second inning...Hudson Valley scored six runs on six hits and sent 12 men to the plate...RHP **Jeffrey Colón** entered with the bases loaded and one out in the frame, proceeding to strand all three men on base...The 24-year-old would pitch the rest of the way for the Cyclones, tossing 6.2 innings of four-hit shutout relief, whiffing a season-high six...LF **Chris Suero** reached base three times for Brooklyn on an infield single, a fielding error, and a walk...RHPs **Baron Stuart** (6.0 IP), **Eric Reyzelman** (2.0), and **Hueston Morrill** (1.0) combined to toss a two-hit shutout for the Renegades...It was Brooklyn's seventh shutout defeat of 2024.

CALM, COLÓN, COLLECTED: RHP **Jeffrey Colón** was sublime out of the bullpen for the Cyclones on Wednesday night...The 24-year-old stranded the bases loaded with one out in the second inning, hurling 6.2 innings of shutout ball...Colón scattered four hits and struck out a season-best six...The 6.2 innings on the hill was the longest effort by the Las Matas de Farfán, D.R. native since he threw 6.2 innings in a start, taking a no-decision, on May 26, 2023, vs. Winston-Salem...The 6.2 innings of the bump also matched the longest outing by a Cyclone pitcher this year...RHP **Jonah Tong** tossed 6.2 innings of one-run ball to earn the win in a start vs. Hudson Valley on May 21...Colón is the first Brooklyn relief pitcher to toss 6.2+ innings since RHP **Jordan Geber** posted 7.0 scoreless innings to earn the win vs. Aberdeen on May 7, 2023...Colón and Geber are the only South Atlantic League pitchers to throw 6.2+ innings in a single game since the start of the 2023 season.

CROWN CONSUEGRA: In a win at Jersey Shore on May 29, OF **Stanley Consuegra**'s RBI double in the fourth inning made him the new Cyclones' all-time hits leader (179), breaking a tie with OF **Alex Ramirez**...Last Saturday, Consuegra's one-out double in the ninth inning broke his tie with Ramirez for the franchise record in doubles (39)...The 23-year-old is atop the Cyclones' ranks in numerous other offensive categories as well, including extra-base hits (80), home runs (35), and RBI (119)...On the final day of the 2023 regular season, he broke a tie with C **Francisco Alvarez** for Brooklyn's single-season home run record (23)...The Dominican native also broke the franchise's single-season record for extra-base hits (42) and tied the mark for RBI (63) set by **Ronny Mauricio** in 2021.

SUPER STANLEY: OF **Stanley Consuegra** is also in the midst of his best offensive stretch of the season...Consuegra had a 12-game on-base streak snapped on Wednesday and has a hit in 18 of his last 21 games since May 17 at Bowling Green...During that time, he's hitting .320/.435/.653 with a 1.088 OPS...The Dominican native has scored 12 runs and added seven doubles, six home runs, and 18 RBI...Consuegra has raised his batting average by 62 points (.171 to .233) and his OPS by 239 points (.519 to .758) during the stretch...Since that date, the 23-year-old leads the South Atlantic League in slugging (.653), is tied for the league lead in home runs (6), and ranks second in OPS (1.088).

MARVELOUS MORABITO: OF **Nick Morabito** has been as good as any offensive player in Minor League Baseball in 2024...Morabito is ninth in Minor League Baseball in on-base percentage (.453)...He is also 12th in stolen bases (27) and tied for 13th in batting average (.339)...Since making his South Atlantic League debut on May 7, the former second-round pick is tied for second in the league lead in steals (16) and tied for sixth in runs scored (24).

JUNIOR MINTS: INF **Junior Tilen** enters play with the longest active on-base streak in the South Atlantic League, reaching in 20 consecutive games since Game 1 of a doubleheader on May 16 at Bowling Green...The 21-year-old has accumulated a .297/.389/.446 slash line with a .835 OPS during the streak, adding three doubles, a triple, two home runs, and 11 RBI...The infielder is the first Cyclone to record an on-base streak of 20 or more games since INF **José Peraza** reached in 31-consecutive games from July 29 until September 2, 2022...Tilen also posted a 10-game hitting streak from May 26 until June 9...He slashed .375/.409/.550 with a .959 OPS in that time.

SUERO SUAVE: C **Chris Suero** has started to find his rhythm offensively in the South Atlantic League...The 20-year-old capped last week's series vs. Aberdeen with his first career multi-home run game, blasting two-run shots in the fourth and sixth innings...In five games against the IronBirds, Suero was 7-for-16 (.438) at the dish with seven runs scored, a double, three home runs, and an eye-popping 11 RBI...Since May 17 at Bowling Green, Suero has reached safely in 17 of 18 games, hitting .328/.468/.541 with a 1.009 OPS...The Bronx native has scored a whopping 18 runs with a double, four home runs, and 16 RBI...Since that date, Suero is fourth in the SAL in on-base percentage (.468), tied for fifth in runs scored (18), tied for seventh in walks (15), eighth in OPS (1.009), ninth in batting average (.328), and 10th in slugging (.541).

vs. HUDSON VALLEY: Brooklyn hits the road for the final six-game series of the season's first half against the Yankees' High-A affiliate...Hudson Valley possesses five of New York's top 30 prospects per MLB Pipeline: LHP **Kyle Carr** (11), INF **Roc Riggio** (18), INF **Jared Serna** (19), INF **Tyler Hardman** (25), and OF **Jace Avina** (28)...The Cyclones captured the first meeting at Maimonides Park, winning 4-of-6...In 2023, Brooklyn went 6-6 against Hudson Valley on Coney Island and 8-4 at Heritage Financial Park...Dating back to 2001, Brooklyn trails the all-time series, 144-148 (.493).

JOLTIN' JEFREY: IF/OF **Jefrey De Los Santos** has been an extra-base machine in recent games...The 20-year-old had a seven-game hitting streak since the beginning of June snapped on Wednesday...He has also tallied multiple knocks in six of his last 10 games...Since May 30 at Jersey Shore, De Los Santos is hitting .366/.409/.756 with a 1.165 OPS, seven runs scored, three doubles, two triples, three home runs, and seven RBI...Since the start of June, De Los Santos is tied for second in the circuit in triples (2), third in slugging (.758) and OPS (1.187), tied for fifth in extra-base hits (6), sixth in batting average (.394), and tied for sixth in total bases (25).

FETTUCINE WILFREDO: INF **Wilfredo Lara** has been scorching hot for the Cyclones since May 19...The 20-year-old has appeared in 20 games and tallied a .324/.427/.500 line with a .927 OPS...Lara has scored 16 runs and added two doubles, two triples, two home runs, 10 RBI, 10 walks, and four stolen bases...Lara is also had a 13-game on-base streak since May 26 vs. Hudson Valley snapped on Wednesday...He hit .372/.509/.535 with a 1.044 OPS during the stretch.

YOU'LL GET NOTHING AND LIKE IT: RHPs **Dakota Hawkins** (5.0 IP), **Joey Lancellotti** (1.0), and **Joshua Cornielli** (3.0) combined on the first nine-inning no-hitter in Brooklyn Cyclones history in Tuesday's 3-0 win vs. Aberdeen...The only previous no-hitter came on August 23, 2009, when RHP **Brandon Moore** tossed a seven-inning no-no in a 5-0 win during Game 1 of a doubleheader at Aberdeen...It is just the third no-hitter in Minor League Baseball in 2024...LHP **Chayce McDermott**, RHP **Nolan Hoffman**, and RHP **Kaleb Ort** combined on a 2-0 no-hitter for Baltimore's Triple-A Norfolk on May 3 vs. Nashville...RHP **Dylan Cumming**, RHP **Nick Sinacola**, and LHP **Seth Corry** of San Francisco's High-A Eugene combined on a 4-0 no-no on April 17 vs. Vancouver...Tuesday's effort was the first no-hitter by a Mets minor league affiliate since RHP **Joander Suárez** hurled a seven-inning one on September 7 at Hartford...It was also the first nine-inning no-hitter thrown in the borough of Brooklyn since RHP **Sal Maglie** tossed a no-no for the Dodgers against the Philadelphia Phillies on September 25, 1956, at Ebbets Field.

NECK AND NECK DOWN THE STRETCH: Including Thursday, seven games remain in the First Half of the South Atlantic League season...The Cyclones are tied for fourth place, 3.5 games back of Greensboro for first in the North Division.

THE CENTURY MARK: RHP **Michel Otañez** became the 100th player in Brooklyn Cyclones history to make the trip from Coney Island to the Major Leagues, making his Major League debut for the Oakland Athletics on Monday night...The 26-year-old threw 0.2 scoreless innings in San Diego allowing a hit and a walk...Otañez made seven starts for Brooklyn in the 2019 season and 35 relief appearances during the 2021 campaign...In 42 appearances (seven starts), the right-hander held a 5-2 record with a 4.20 ERA (33 ER in 70.2 IP), one save, 58 walks, and 84 strikeouts...Otañez is the second former Cyclone to make his Major League debut in 2024...RHP **Christian Scott** (2022-23) was the first to do so for the New York Mets on May 4.

ATOP THE HEJ-ES: RHP **Josh Hejka** earned his first save of the season on May 5 vs. Aberdeen, making his Cyclones' franchise-record-setting 48th pitching appearance in the process...The 27-year-old broke a tie with **Hunter Parsons** (47) for the most pitching appearances in Cyclones franchise history...In his 58 career outings for Brooklyn since 2019, Hejka has accumulated a 5-2 record with a 2.48 ERA (26 ER in 94.1 IP) and 6 saves, walking just 22 and striking out 83.

AMAZIN' STARTS HERE: The Brooklyn Cyclones have several Top 30 prospects according to *Baseball America* and MLB Pipeline...The 'Clones have three of the Top 30 per BA: **Kade Morris** (21), **Jonah Tong** (22) and **Calvin Ziegler** (29)...Ziegler is currently on the full-season injured list...Plus four of the Top 30 per MLB: Tong (20), Ziegler (23), **Wilfredo Lara** (24), and OF **Nick Morabito** (26).

LAST TIME OUT: Earned the save in his affiliated and Mets' organizational debut last Thursday night vs. Aberdeen...Entered in relief of RHP **Edwin Díaz** in the top of the sixth inning with the Cyclones leading, 7-2...Allowed one run on four hits over 4.0 innings...Walked two and struck out three...Induced a pair of double plays...Tossed 55 pitches and 33 strikes (60.00%)...Registered the game's final 12 outs, as the Cyclones defeated the IronBirds, 13-3, on SNY.

CHANGE OF PLANS: Pintaro's final start for the Pioneer League's Glacier Range Riders (Kalispell, Mont.) was cut short due to great news...The 26-year-old tossed 2.0 innings of one-run ball against the Great Falls Voyagers on June 2 before being told by manager **Paul Fletcher** that he would not continue...Pintaro's day came to a close because his contract had been purchased by the New York Mets, officially signing the following day..."It was surreal. After the second inning I came to the dugout and I heard him (Fletcher) say somebody get warm and I kind of gave him a look," said Pintaro to the *Daily Inter Lake*...In three starts for the Range Riders, Pintaro was 1-0 with a 4.40 ERA (7 ER in 14.1 IP), one walk, and 23 strikeouts...The Pelham, Ala. native had a 14.44 strikeouts-per-nine innings ratio in the MLB Partner circuit.

REMEMBER ME?: Following the 2021 and 2022 collegiate seasons, Pintaro pitched for the Frederick (Md.) Keys of the MLB Draft League...During that time, the 26-year-old was a teammate of a few current and former Cyclones...In 2021, Pintaro pitched alongside RHP **Dylan Tebrake**, who was a member of the 2023 bullpen and is currently on Double-A Binghamton's 60-day injured list...During the 2022 season, the Shorter University alum was a teammate of RHP **Jordan Geber** (2023-24) who is currently with Double-A Binghamton and current Cyclones RHP **Jonah Tong**...In 25 games (17 starts) for the Keys, Pintaro was 3-9 with a 4.55 ERA (44 ER in 87.0 IP), 41 walks, and 108 strikeouts.

SHORTER STACK: Pintaro became the first Shorter University alum to sign a contract with a Major League team since becoming an NCAA program in 2013...During his time with the Hawks, the Alabama native was Gulf South Conference Pitcher of the Year in 2021 and 2022...Pintaro accumulated a 20-7 record with a 3.19 ERA (70 ER in 197.1 IP), 76 walks, and 286 strikeouts during those two seasons...Shorter is located in Rome, Ga. and its campus is located 3.7 miles southwest of the Rome Emperors' AdventHealth Stadium.
