BULLPEN, FOUR-RUN SEVENTH PROPEL VICTORY

The Jumbo Shrimp bullpen tossed 6.0 scoreless innings and Jacksonville scored four runs in the seventh Friday to beat Worcester 9-3. The Red Sox led 3-1 going to the sixth, with the Jumbo Shrimp mustering just one run and one hit through the first five innings. Jacksonville scored one in the sixth and fourth in the seventh to grab the lead. Three more Jumbo Shrimp runs in the ninth inning set the final margin at 9-3. Five Jacksonville relievers combined for just two hits and two walks in 6.0 shutout innings, striking out 10 batters in the victory.

MEN OF STEAL

Over the last three seasons, Jacksonville ranked 23rd, 21st and 29th, respectively, in Triple-A in stolen bases. The club's 249 this season not only lead the entire level, but they rank seventh in all of Minor League Baseball. Of the top 23 MiLB teams in steals, only two are Triple-A or Double-A teams (Jacksonville & Nashville, 242, 9th). The Jumbo Shrimp's 249 steals are the most in a campaign for any Jacksonville team in the club's Double-A/Triple-A era (1962-present). No Jacksonville club has finished in the top five in their respective level in steals since at least 2005.

LESS IS MORE

Jacksonville has allowed the fewest hits (880) in Triple-A this season, a robust 34 knocks better than second-place Durham. The Jumbo Shrimp have posted a level-best .223 batting average against and 7.4 H/9 mark, respectively, and done so mainly limiting hard contact. Opponents' average exit velocity of 86.9 miles per hour is the third-best in Triple-A, and Jacksonville has yielded the second-fewest barrels (167) and tied for the fifth-fewest homers (117).

BE STILL, MY BEATING START

In 2024, Jacksonville shattered the city's previous Double-A/Triple-A era (1962-present) record of 20 different starting pitchers over the course of the season and used 28 different starters in 149 games. Meanwhile, through 123 games this season, the Jumbo Shrimp have already tied that record by using 28 different starting pitchers. Perhaps unsurprisingly, Jacksonville starting pitchers have totaled just 487.0 innings (3.9 per start) this season, the sixth-fewest in Triple-A. That said, their 3.77 starters' ERA ranks second at the level.

IT GETS LATE EARLY

Jumbo Shrimp relief pitchers have worked 584.1, or 54.5 percent, of the club's 1,071.1 innings this season. Despite the huge workload, which marks the fourth-most innings of any bullpen in Triple-A, Jacksonville relievers have posted the level's best ERA (3.56) and BAA (.208). Over the last 28 games, the club's bullpen has worked 129.1 innings (4.6 per game), yielding only 42 runs, 39 earned, on 78 hits (5.4 H/9) for a 2.84 ERA (159 K, 11.1 K/9, 50 BB, 3.5 BB/9).

THE BOOK OF MORGAN

It took Morgan McSweeney 22.0 innings to finally allow his first tally with the Jumbo Shrimp, the best scoreless streak for a Jacksonville pitcher since Sixto Sánchez went 24.0 consecutive scoreless frames from July 23-August 10, 2019. Through nine outings with JAX, McSweeney has only yielded seven runs in 39.1 innings (1.60 ERA). Among the 275 IL pitchers who have logged at least 30.0 innings this season, McSweeney has the third-lowest line drive rate (14.4 percent), fourth-lowest BABIP (.214) and seventh-lowest swinging-strike rate (7.4 percent). He ranks seventh in ERA.

SO, BABY, PULL ME CLOSER

The Jumbo Shrimp are a remarkable 47-25 (.653) in games decided by three runs or fewer this season, by far the most such wins in Triple-A. Thus, of the club's Triple-A-leading 75 victories, 62.7 percent have come by no more than three runs. In one-run affairs, Jacksonville has excelled, going 25-10 (.714), tied for the second-most such victories in MiLB.

FOR IT'S ONE, TWO, THREE STRIKES, YOU'RE OUT

The Jumbo Shrimp have recorded double-digit strikeouts in 11 of the 16 games the club has played since August 5. During this stretch, Jacksonville has racked up 169 punchouts (10.6 per game), the second-most in Triple-A. Six of the club's top 20 strikeout games this season have come in the last 16 games.

YOUTH IS SERVED

Among position players on the club's active roster, only four Shrimp (Berry, De Los Santos, Mack and Winker) have played in more than half of Jacksonville's 123 games thus far in 2025. The other eight non-rehabbers have combined for a total of just 152 games in Triple-A this season.

ABOUT MORGAN

-McSweeney was originally drafted by the Baltimore Orioles in the 17th round of the 2019 draft out of Wake Forest University.

-In high school, the right-hander was cut from the team at St. John's High School (Shrewsbury, Mass.) prior to his junior year. He transferred to Worcester Academy, where he earned two letters and a scholarship to Wake Forest.

-During his college career, McSweeney pitched in 57 games, including 22 starts. He posted a 10-10 record and 5.24 ERA. His 12 K/9 in a season is the 12th-best in Wake Forest school history.

-From 2019-24, McSweeney pitched in 137 games in the Baltimore Orioles' organization, all in relief. He was released on July 10, 2024 and finished that campaign as a starter with Gastonia of the Independent Atlantic League (2-1, 4.19 ERA in eight starts). He began the 2025 campaign with Staten Island in the same league, going 4-2 with a 3.00 ERA in 10 starts before signing with Miami.

2025 SEASON

-Went 4-2 with a 3.00 ERA in 10 starts for the Staten Island Ferryhawks in the Atlantic League.

-As Ferryhawks ace, posted 41 punch outs in 54.0 innings.

-Signed by the Marlins as a minor league free agent on June 26, 2025. In his first start for Jacksonville on June 28 vs. Nashville, went a career-high 6.2 shutout innings, striking out four and scattering four hits and one walk. The start was his first in the minor leagues after 137 career appearances in relief.

2024 SEASON

-Split time with Double-A Bowie, Triple-A Norfolk and Independent Gastonia.

-Made six relief appearances with Double-A Bowie and six for Triple-A Norfolk.
