BULLPEN SHINES BRIGHT: For the second consecutive game, Omaha's bullpen kept Louisville off the scoreboard last night. Omaha closed the game retiring 13 of the final 14 batters, allowing just one hit in the final four innings of play. RHP Andrés Sotillet tossed the final out in the fifth and a perfect sixth to earn his third win of the season. RHP Ándres Núñez threw the seventh and eighth innings, allowing just one hit before LHP Anthony Misiewicz finished the game in the ninth. Combined with Thursday's strong outing, the Chasers' bullpen has now thrown 7.1 combined scoreless innings after struggling to put up zeros early in this season-long road trip.

GETTING HOT: C Freddy Fermin is on a 14-game on-base streak, tied for the sixth longest on the team this season. Fermin is hitting .373 during the 14-game streak with six doubles and two home runs. He also holds a 1-to-1 walk-to-strikeouts ratio, getting seven walks and seven strikeouts. Fermin made his MLB debut on July 15, and since returning to Triple-A action on July 22, he is hitting .306 in 21 games for the Storm Chasers. Fermin also leads the Storm Chasers in throwing out base stealers, having caught 11 so far this season.

CLOSING THE GAP: Omaha has had one of the highest stolen base totals in the International League for the last few weeks, now looking to overtake the lead. The Storm Chasers swiped two bases yesterday, and now have 139 steals this season. Buffalo leads the league with 141 but have only stolen four bases in the last seven days. Omaha does lead the league in stolen base percentage at .858 with Memphis in second place at .837. The Storm Chasers have two players in the top 10 in the league in stolen bases with OF Dairon Blanco tied for second with 29 and OF Brewer Hicklen tied for seventh with 25.

LOFTY EXPECTATIONS: INF/OF Nick Loftin is currently the sixth ranked prospect, according to MLB.com, in the Royal's farm system, but has struggled to start his Triple-A career. Loftin hit his first Triple-A home run and first Triple-A double last night, earning his first multi-hit game since joining the Chasers last week. Loftin was close to hitting a couple of homers over the last few days, forcing defenders to make nice plays to keep him from getting on base. Loftin is 23-years-old and was drafted in 2020 out of Baylor. He is currently the top-rated prospect on the Storm Chasers roster.

STREAKING: OF Brewer Hicklen has reached base in 22 consecutive games, the second longest active streak in the International League, trailing Louisville's Spencer Steer at 29 games. Hicklen has five home runs, 13 walks, and 10 RBIs during the streak that started on July 26. He is now just one game shy of tying INF Michael Massey's 23 game streak for longest on the team this season.

FOR OMAHA: RHP Jackson Kowar heads to the mound to make his 16th start for the Storm Chasers this season. In his last start, Kowar went 4.0 innings on Sunday, getting tagged with the loss after allowing two earned runs on three hits and three walks with two strikeouts. Kowar has been in The Show this year, throwing seven games out of the bullpen for the Royals. Kowar is in a bit of a rough stretch at the Triple-A level, going 0-5 over his last six starts dating back to the beginning of June. Kowar is 1-0 in his lone appearance on a Saturday, going 6.0 innings without allowing a run, striking out six. Left-handed batters have hit more home runs than right-handed batters (7-4) despite having 30 less at bats against him.

FOR LOUISVILLE: RHP Raynel Espinal looks to make his Reds' organizational debut after getting signed by Cincinnati earlier this week. Espinal started the season in the Giants' organization, making 18 starts for Triple-A Sacramento. He was traded to the Cubs at the end of July, appearing in two games for Triple-A lowa before getting released. His last start came on July 28, going 5.0 innings and allowing four earned runs on five hits and two walks with six strikeouts for Sacramento. Between Espinal's two appearances for lowa, he allowed six earned runs in 3.1 innings with four strikeouts. Lefties hit .319 against him while right handed batters hit just .235 at the Triple-A level this season.
