YESTERDAY: The Flying Squirrels beat the Baysox, 6-2. Bowie took a 1-0 lead in the first with a sac fly by Billy Cook. The Flying Squirrels jumped ahead, 2-1, in the bottom of the first inning with a sac fly by Andy Thomas and a bases-loaded walk by Logan Wyatt. In the fourth, Vaun Brown brought in two with a single to extend the lead to 4-1. Shane Matheny hit a solo homer in the fifth and Brown added an RBI single in the sixth to extend the lead to 6-1. Bowie's TT Bowens closed the gap to four runs with a solo homer in the top of the seventh. Parker Dunshee made his first start of the year and allowed one unearned run over three innings. Nick Zwack allowed one run and struck out six over four innings. Ben Madison closed the game with two scoreless, hitless innings.

TDDAY'S GAME: The Richmond Flying Squirrels play the third of a six-game series against the Bowie Baysox, Double-A affiliate of the Baltimore Orioles. The Flying Squirrels won four-of-five at Prince George's Stadium from April 25-29, with the finale post-poned until June for rain. In their series in Bowie from June 13-18, the Baysox won four-of-seven. Along with this week's series, the Flying Squirrels will play a six-game series against the Baysox at The Diamond from August 8-13.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS have gone 13-2 in their last 15 games since June 18, including taking five-of-six in last week's series at Reading to open the second half of the season. They won six straight from June 23 through Friday, their longest winning streak since a seven-game stretch from April 28-May 5, 2022. Over the last 15 games, the Flying Squirrels are batting a league-best .271 (134-for-495) with 20 homers, 27 doubles and have scored 92 runs. In that same stretch, the Richmond pitching staff has a 2.77 ERA (41 ER/133.0 IP), tied for the best in the league, with 169 strikeouts. Over the last 20 games since June 14, Richmond starting pitchers have combined to go 2-2 with a 2.07 ERA (17 ER/73.1 IP). For the year, the Flying Squirrels' 3.70 ERA is the best in the league. Richmond starters have thrown 274.2 innings, which is the fewest in Double-A. Richmond relievers have thrown 391.1 innings this year, the most in Double-A. The Flying Squirrels bullpen has a 3.29 ERA, which is second-lowest in Double-A and tied for the seventh-lowest of the 120 teams in the minors.

THE BAYSDX opened the second half dropping four-of-six in last week's series against the Patriots. They are 2-7 in their last nine games since June 25. Bowie's roster includes six of Baseball America's top-30 Orioles prospects, including 3B Coby Mayo (No. 9), LHP Cade Povich (No. 10), OF Jud Fabian (No. 13), RHP Chayce McDermott (No. 15), OF John Rhodes (No. 26) and RHP Jean Pinto (No. 28). MLB.com's top-30 Orioles prospects list includes Mayo (No. 7), Povich (No. 11), Fabian (No. 15), McDermott (No. 17) and Rhodes (No. 19).

FOR RICHMOND: Right-hander Spencer Bivens makes the first start of his affiliated professional career. He has 14 games out of Richmond's bullpen this season, his first year at the Double-A level. Last time out, Bivens allowed two runs over one inning against the Baysox on Tuesday night. He pitched two scoreless innings and struck out four on Saturday at Reading. Bivens was signed out of independent baseball by the San Francisco Giants last May. Last fall, he pitched in the Arizona Fall League and was named to the Fall Stars team. FOR BOWIE: Right-hander Carlos Tavera 10th start of the season and his fourth appearance against the Flying Squirrels. Last time out, he threw five innings and allowed three runs in a no-decision against Somerset on Saturday. He last faced the Flying Squirrels on June 19 at Prince George's Stadium and recorded two outs, allowing four runs on four walks and one hit in a loss. He started the opener of that series on June 13 and surrendered four runs over three innings with five strikeouts. Tavera also faced the Flying Squirrels on April 26 at Prince George's Stadium and allowed a season-high five runs over 2.2 innings. Tavera was selected in the fifth round of the 2021 MLB Draft by the Orioles out of UT-Arlington. This year marks his first season at the Double-A level. Tavera was named the Eastern League Pitcher of the Week on May 28 after throwing five hitless innings at Akron on May 26.

PACKING THE HOUSE: Last year, the Flying Squirrels led all of Double-A in total attendance (406,560) and average attendance (6,160) for the first time in franchise history. This year, the Flying Squirrels are again at the top of the level in average attendance (6,563) and total attendance (255,973). The team's average attendance is the 13th-highest among the 120 MiLB teams.

RETURN OF THE MECK: In Game 1 of June 23's doubleheader, **Wade Meckler** closed his historic performance with a two-run, walk-off single, giving the Flying Squirrels a 9-8 win in extras. Meckler went 5-for-5 and tied the single-game franchise record for hits. It was the 11th time a Richmond player has collected five hits in a game. In his five games of last week's series, Meckler reached base 13 times with 10 hits, including four on Thursday, and three walks. In the series-opener on Tuesday, he clubbed a go-ahead, two-run homer in the eighth inning. Meckler has now reached base in all 23 of his Double-A games, including 35 hits and 16 walks. His on-base streak is the longest active streak in the league and the longest by a Richmond player this season. He also leads the league with 10 consecutive games scoring a run. Meckler leads all MiLB hitters (min. 190 PA) this season in batting average (.415), OBP (.482) and BABIP (.459). In the Eastern League (min. 100 PA), Meckler is first in batting average (.380), on-base percentage (.472), ranks second in wRC+ (174) and fourth in OPS (.983), he has the fourth-lowest strikeout percentage (12.0) and the second-lowest swinging strike percentage (5.0).

VAUN GONE WILD: Vaun Brown is riding a 10-game hit streak since June 22. He has homered four times in that stretch, including home runs in each of the first two games of last week's series at Reading and a three-run blast on Tuesday night at The Diamond. In his last 10 games, Brown is batting .364 (16-for-44) with four homers, four doubles and 15 RBIs, adding five stolen bases. Over his previous nine games from June 9-20, Brown hit .057 (2-for-35) with three walks and 16 strikeouts. Brown also has a league-best six-game extra-base hit streak dating back to June 25.

THDMAS THE TANK ENGINE: Andy Thomas has picked up 12 RBIs over his last nine games since June 24. From June 24-29, he collected nine RBIs over a four-game span, including a two-run homer last Thursday night at Reading. On Sunday night, he added a sac fly and a solo homer. In his last nine games, Thomas is batting .382 (13-for-34) with two homers, three doubles, a triple and 12 RBIs. For the season, he leads the Flying Squirrels with 39 RBIs. Thomas has a hit in each of his last nine games dating back to lune 24.

RAGIN' CANTRELLE: In his last 17 games since June 14, **Hayden Cantrelle** has reached base 29 times, posting a .453 on-base percentage. In that stretch, he has picked up 14 hits, walked 13 times and been hit by a pitch twice in 64 plate appearances. This season, he has been hit by a pitch 13 times, the most in the Eastern League. Cantrelle also ranks fifth in the league in on-base percentage (.401) and sixth in walks (48). He is second among Giants minor leaguers in walks for the year. On Monday at Reading, he hit his third home run of the season. Cantrelle is currently riding a seven-game hitting streak.

ALL ABDARD THE SHANE TRAIN: Shane Matheny has hit solo home runs in each of the first two games of this week's series. Over his last 10 games since June 23, Matheny is batting .314 (11-for-35) with four doubles, two homers, six RBIs and four walks. He now has 19 homers in his Flying Squirrels career, which ranks him tied for 15th in Richmond franchise history. His 102 career walks are the fifth-most in Flying Squirrels franchise history.

PROSPECT WATCH: The Flying Squirrels have nine players ranked in Baseball America's Top-30 Giants prospects, including Marco Luciano (No. 2), LHP Carson Whisenhunt (No. 6), OF Vaun Brown (No. 8), RHP Mason Black (No. 9), RHP Carson Seymour (No. 14), RHP Landen Roupp (No. 15), OF Wade Meckler (No. 16), RHP Ryan Murphy (No. 27) and RHP José Cruz (No. 30). Brown is rated by Baseball America as the best hitter for average and the best athlete, Luciano as the best power hitter, Meckler as having the best strike-zone discipline, Roupp as having the best curveball and Cruz as having the best change-up. Luciano is also ranked as Baseball America's No. 55-overall prospect. MLB.com's top-30 Giants prospect list includes nine Richmond players, including Luciano (No. 2), Whisenhunt (No. 4), Brown (No. 6), Black (No. 9), Roupp (No. 12), Seymour (No. 16), Murphy (No. 25), Cruz (No. 28) and Meckler (No. 29). Luciano is ranked by MLB.com as the No. 17 prospect in baseball.
