TODAY'S GAME: The Curve continue a six-game series with the Erie SeaWolves, the teams will meet a total of 18 times this season.

LAST TIME OUT: Erie scored 5 times off **Mike Burrows** in the 2nd inning and held off a furious 4-run rally from the Curve in the 7th inning to take a 7-4 win in the series opener. **Jared Triolo** picked up 2 RBI and **Lolo Sanchez** had two hits in the defeat.

JUNE IS FOR THE K: Altoona pitching has picked up 124 strikeouts this month, the most in the Eastern League.

READING GONNA READ: Altoona smacked 3 solo homers across the 6th, 7th and 8th inning in their 5-2 win over Reading on Saturday, June 11.

HE'S BACK: Prior to Friday's game at Reading, the Curve activated **C Henry Davis** off the injured list after he missed about 3 weeks with a left wrist injury. Placed on the IL on May 18, Davis played a 2 game rehab assignment in Florida during which he caught a combined no-hitter with Bradenton on Thursday, June 9 thrown by fellow rehabber Quinn Priester (3 IP), Anthony Solometo (4 IP), Jake Sweeney (1 IP) and Yunior Thibo (1 IP). Davis went 0-for-4 with a strikeout in his first game back in the lineup on Saturday, June 11.

A FIRST FOR EVERYTHING: Altoona had gone 53 straight games without being shutout to begin the season, the second-longest active streak among MiLB teams this season, until they were shutout on Thursday, June 9 at Reading. Triple-A Jacksonville (Marlins) held the longest active streak of not being shutout at 56 games when Altoona's streak ended.

TREE TRIMMING: **Jared Triolo** picked up two hits in each end of the doubleheader on Wednesday, June 8 at Reading. His 12th and 13th multi-hit games of the season marked the third time this season that Triolo had two or more hits in back-to-back games. Over his last 18G (5/24 - Present) Triolo is batting: .319/.405/.406 with 3 2B, 1 HR, 8 RBI, 8 BB and 3-3 SB. His 56 hits rank T-6th in the Eastern League.

AN INNING FOR THE RECORD BOOKS: The Curve matched their franchise record with 9 hits in a 9-run 2nd inning on Thursday, June 2 against Bowie. Altoona matched their franchise record for triples in a game with 3 triples in the second inning by **Brendt Citta**, **Matt Fraizer**, and **Andres Alvarez**, and sent 13 men to the plate in the frame. The Curve were one hit shy of matching the franchise record for hits in an inning.

ALVY'S BIG START: **Andres Alvarez** picked up a career-high 5 RBI in Altoona's 13-12 win over Bowie on Thursday, June 2. After an RBI single and an RBI triple in the second inning, Alvarez smashed a go-ahead 3-run homer in the 8th inning to lead the Curve to a win. Through 39 games Alvarez has set a new career-high with a team-best 10 home runs and 27 RBI. His .587 slugging percentage would be second in the league if he qualified for the Eastern League Leaderboards.

BURROWED: Mike Burrows was been unscored upon in six of his starts this year and allowed 2 runs or fewer in 9-of-his-12 starts this season. Following his start on Wednesday, June 9, he ranks all over the EL Leaderboards: 5th in ERA (2.94), 6th in K (69), 5th in BAA (.199), 9th in WHIP (1.10), T-1st in GS (12).

LET'S HIT: The Curve have picked up at least 10 hits in 12-of-their-27 last games. Altoona has had 10 or more hits in a game 19 times this season, most in the Eastern League. The Curve lead the Eastern League in team batting average (.256) and total hits (495); they hold a 44-hit lead over the next highest team in the league (Bowie).

NO LEAD IS SAFE: Altoona has held a lead after 5 innings in 31 of 58 games played this season and hold an 21-10 record in those games.

TROUBLE WITH THE LONG BALL: Altoona pitchers have surrendered 63 home runs on the season, tied for 24th-most by a pitching staff in minor league baseball and fourth-most in the Eastern League behind Hartford (75). The Curve have allowed a home run in 35 of 56 games.

THE 'WOLVES WHO HAIL FROM THE SEA: Managed by Gabe Alvarez, the SeaWolves have surged into the first half playoff picture and enter the series just two games back from first place. They feature several top prospects according to MLB.com: C Dillon Dingler (#4), INF Gage Workman (#10), RHP Wilmer Flores (#14), RHP Reese Olson (#16), OF Parker Meadows (#18), INF Andre Lipcius (#23), RHP Austin Bergner (#27).

THE FIRST TOSSER: Righty Markus Solbach makes his second start of the season against Altoona tonight. Solbach went 4.0 scoreless innings with 5 strikeouts on May 7 against the Curve at UPMC Park, a game won by Erie 2-1 in ten innings. The 30-year-old hails from Dormagen, Germany and has been pitching in the states since 2011 with the Minnesota Twins organization. His career has taken him from the Twins to the Diamondbacks to the Dodgers system, where he reached Triple-A Oklahoma City in 2021, before signing with the Tigers in the off-season.

TODAY IN CURVE HISTORY

1999 - The Curve drop Binghamton 5-1 in 15 innings with a walk-off grand slam by Alex Hernandez, the only walk-off grand slam in franchise history.

2003 - Altoona storms back with seven runs in the top of the 9th inning to erase a 9-6 deficit and wins 13-9 at Harrisburg

2021 - Roansy Contreras strikes out 10 batters in 7.0 innings, the longest start of the season by a Curve starter. Altoona fell to Erie, 4-3 on a walk-off single by Josh Lester.
