#### FROM THE CROW'S NEST

ON THE BRINK: By winning five of their last seven games, including four of six in the previous series in Tampa, the Marauders enter Wednesday just a half-game out of first place in the West Division standings. Bradenton has had either partial or full possession of second place since May 9, but has not yet touched first place this season.

SUPER SANTIAGO: Tonight's starter, Santiago Florez, ranks third in all of Minor League Baseball in both ERA (1.26) and VHIP (0.81) and is tied for the ninth-lowest opponents' batting average (.173). Over his last five appearances (26.2 IP), the right-hander has allowed just two earned runs for a 0.68 ERA during that stretch.

MAKING HEAD-LINES: Hudson Head has recorded seven RBI in his last two games, including a career-high five RBI on Sunday in Tampa. The Pirates' number-five prospect cleared the bases with a three-run double in the second inning, drew a bases-loaded walk in the fourth, and hit a solo home run in the eighth. The Texas native has reached base safely in 27 of his last 29 games, rebounding quickly after having a 25-game on-base streak broken on Friday.

SIANI'S SEEIN' IT: Over his last three games, Sammy Siani is 6-for-21 with a home run and eight RBI. He now leads the team with 29 RBI (T-4th in the league) and is tied for third on the team with five home runs, eight multi-hit games, and five multi-RBI games. He is also tied for sixth in the Low-A Southeast with 33 walks.

THE OPPONENT: The Hammerheads are just 2.5 games out of first place in the East Division, but are just 21-22 on the season and own the league's third-worst run differential (-45). Jupiter is coming off a series split against St. Lucie, and overall, have won two series, lost two, and split three.

EXTREME SPORTS: Jupiter ranks last in the Low-A Southeast in numerous offensive categories, including batting average (.205), runs scored (169), home runs (13), OBP (.311), and SLG (.282). The Hammerheads do, however, rank near the top of the league in numerous pitching categories, including ERA (3.85, 2nd), WHIP (1.42, 4th), walks (211, 4th-fewest), and home runs allowed (29, 4th-fewest).

<u>TOP PROSPECTS:</u> The Marauders roster currently includes eight prospects in MLB Pipeline's Top 30 ranking for the Pirates organization: **Hudson Head** (#5), **Eddy Yean** (#12), **Jared Jones** (#16), **Sammy Siani** (#18), **Nick Garcia** (#20), **Endy Rodriguez** (#25), **Alexander Mojica** (#28), and **Dariel Lopez** (#29). Three of the eight (Head, Rodriguez, and Yean) came to the organization via blockbuster trades: Head and Rodriguez came from the Padres and Mets, respectively, in the three-team Joe Musgrove deal, and Yean came from Washington in the Josh Bell trade.

**<u>UNDER NEW MANAGEMENT:</u>** New Jersey native **Jonathan Johnston** is in his first season as Marauders manager. The U.S. Naval Academy graduate spent two seasons as a catcher in the Oakland Athletics system in 2008 and 2011 in between a collective five years in the Navy as a Surface Warfare Officer. Prior to joining the Pirates organization in 2020, he held coaching roles at UC San Diego and UNC Asheville.

MISCELLANEOUS: Hudson Head established a new career high with 5 RBI on Sunday in Tampa (previous high: 2 RBI, three times) ... Eli Wilson is in the Low-A Southeast's top 10 in batting average (.362, 3rd), OBP (.518, 4th), and OPS (1.042, 7th)... Endy Rodriguez has recorded two RBI in each of his last three games, the first time in his career he's plated a run in three straight games.
