HOME? BARELY EVEN KNOW HER: After seeing another rainout on Sunday in Myrtle Beach, the FredNats finally return home from what ended up being a 10-game road trip covering two weeks to kick off the longest home stand of the season of 12 games. The first six are against a familiar foe, the Salem Red Sox, for the final meeting of 2025 between these two longtime North Divisonal rivals. This the 114th game between Salem and Fredericksburg since the FredNats relocated, and Salem leads it 57-56. Fredericksburg has scored three more runs (563) than Salem has (560) in the series. RHP Alexander Meckley makes his fourth start of the season against the Sox, and he's throwing 16 innings of one-earned run ball this season.

**ROAD TRIP RECAP:** Fredericksburg went into the Sunday game of both series of the road trip against Columbia and Myrtle Beach with a chance to win and split both series, and both games were rained out. FBG ended up losing both series 3-2, and have actually lost three straight series with that record because the previous Sunday home game with Fayetteville was also rained out. Fredericksburg got a couple gritty late-game victories on the trip in extras, once in Columbia and once again in MB.

**HE'S INEVITABLE**: FredNat outfield prospect Cristhian Vaquero picked up his MiLB-leading fourth walk-off hit of the season last home stand, and overall, he's enjoyed a very strong second half of the season offensively, pairing his hot bat with his exceptional outfield defense. In 28 second half games, Vaquero is second in the league in batting average (.333), OPS (.929), and slugging (.535), and he's third in hits (38) and sixth in extra-base hits (11). He also picked up his 11th outfield assist of the season in Tuesday night's game, reached base five times in last night's game despite seeing his seven-game hit streak.

**INSTANT IMPACT**: The first two members of Washington's 2025 draft class was promoted to Fredericksburg last week. 9th rounder Wyatt Henseler out of Texas A&M had hits in each of his four FredNat games, and 14th round pick Nick Hollifield picked up his first three professional hits the last two days. Both drove in runs yesterday. Henseler played four collegiate seasons at Penn prior to transferring to Texas A&M, and he is the Penn and Ivy League career home run leader (54). He won Ivy League Player of the Year at Penn in 2024, and led the preseason No. 1 Aggies in 2025 with a .316 batting average, slugging 12 more home runs in the SEC.

**START EARLY:** The FredNats are 50-52 overall this season, but are 15 games over .500 (30-14) when scoring first in 2025. In the first two innings this season, Fredericksburg has been outscored 77-115 (-38).

WHY TRY IT?: Fredericksburg's MiLB-leading caught stealing total is up to 82 (MB is 3rd with 70). Heading into play today, Kevin Bazzell leads MiLB by 11 with 53 caught stealings and owns the best CS% of all MiLB catchers who have played at least 400 innings this year, throwing out 43% of would-be base stealers. Bazzell also finished the best month of his season offensively in July where he hit .288 with an OPS over .700.

THIS BULLPEN IS INSANE: The FredNat bullpen has been central to the team's efforts all season, but the group has taken it to a new level since June 1. Since then, FBG's bullpen ERA is 3.10, which is currently number three in Single-A baseball. Fredericksburg is 37-1 when leading after seven innings this season, and 31-1 when leading after eight innings. Fredericksburg's 17 saves in that time frame is also tied for the fourth-most in Minor League Baseball.

**THE STAFF:** After Jake Lowery's third season as Manager of the FredNats ended in a Carolina League championship in 2024, the FredNats welcome Billy McMillon as the third Manager in Fredericksburg franchise history. McMillon, 53, has spent the last three seasons in the Nationals organization as the Development Coach for Triple-A Rochester. He also played parts of six seasons in the Major Leagues with Oakland, Detroit, Philadelphia and Florida. He's joined on the staff by returning Pitching Coach Justin Lord, returning Hitting Coach Mike Habas, Development Coach Luis Ordaz, returning Athletic Trainer Jacob Meyer, Strength & Conditioning Coach Mike Reiskind, and Performance Analyst Samantha Unger.

A LASTING LEGACY: The Fredericksburg Nationals adopt the franchise history of their predecessors in the Carolina League dating back to 1978...the Alexandria Dukes (1978, 1980-83) and Alexandria Mariners (1979) played at Four Mile Run Park in Alexandria, Virginia...the Prince William Pirates (1984-1986), Prince William Yankees (1987-1988), Prince William Cannons (1989-1998), Potomac Cannons (1999-2004) and Potomac Nationals (2005-2019) played at G. Richard Pfitzner Stadium in Woodbridge, Virginia...the franchise has won six Carolina League championships, as the Dukes in 1982, as the Yankees in 1989, and as the Nationals in 2008, 2010 and 2014. The franchise won its first league title as the Fredericksburg Nationals in 2024, defeating the Kannapolis Cannon Ballers two games to one to win the title at Virginia Credit Union Stadium.

**ALEXANDER THE GREAT:** Meckley, the Nationals' 12th round pick (350th overall) in the 2024 MLB Draft, was flawless after being called up to Fredericksburg last year. He made five appearances for the FredNats between the regular season and postseason and did not give up a run. In total, he allowed just four hits in 9.1 IP and got a save in his lone opportunity with two shutout innings against LYN on 9/4.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Meckley matched his career high with a six-inning start in Columbia 10 days ago, surrendering just one run on four hits against the Fireflies. For the second straight start, Meckley led the FredNats to a win with six strong innings. In his last two starts, he's allowed just three earned runs across 12 innings with 10 strikeouts.

**JUNE TO JULY:** Meckley's month of June was fabulous. Across four starts, he allowed just five earned runs in 21.1 IP, for an ERA of 2.11. In July, Meckley didn't quite hit the same stride, covering just 15.1 innings in four starts with a 5.28 ERA. Today, he looks to continue a good start to August.

**BACK IN SCHOOL:** Meckley made 21 appearances at Coastal Carolina in 2024 with nine starts for the Chanticleers, posting a 7.52 ERA in 52.2 IP with 57 K's. He previously pitched two seasons at WVU Potomac State (NJCAA)...made 20 appearances (17 starts) and led the Catamounts with 73 K's and a 2.96 ERA in 2023.

## **BILLY MCMILLON - MANAGER**

1st Season | Previously: Development Coach, Triple-A Rochester

McMillon, 53, joined Washington in 2022 and has spent the last three seasons as the Development Coach for Triple-A Rochester. McMillon played parts of six Major League seasons with four different organizations, including the Oakland Athletics (2001-04), Detroit Tigers (2000-01), Philadelphia Phillies (1997), and Florida Marlins (1996-97). The former Clemson Tiger was a three-time International League All-Star and the 1996 IL Rookie of the Year with Charlotte, earning him induction into the IL Hall of Fame in 2019 and Charlotte's Round Table of Honor in 2022. McMillon was initially selected in the eighth round of the 1993 MLB Draft by Florida. He replaces Jake Lowery, who managed the FredNats the last three seasons, culminating in a championship last year. Lowery will manage High-A Wilmington in 2025.

Prior to joining Washington, McMillon coached in the Boston Red Sox organization for over a decade. He managed the Worcester Red Sox (Triple-A) in their inaugural season in 2021 after managing Boston's former Triple-A affiliate Pawtucket in 2019. He was set to lead the PawSox again in 2020 before the cancellation of the MiLB season. Prior to managing at the Triple-A level, McMillon was the Minor League Outfield and Baserunning Coordinator for Boston from 2016-18 after managing for six seasons in the organization with Double-A Portland (2014-15), High-A Salem (2012-13), and Single-A Greenville (2010-11). His coaching career began in 2008 when he was Greenville's Hitting Coach.



### JUSTIN LORD - PITCHING COACH

3rd Season | Previously: Pitching Coach, Double-A Harrisburg

Lord, 45, returns to Fredericksburg for a third season in 2025 after leading the FredNats' championship pitching staff last season, including the 2024 Carolina League Pitcher of the Year Travis Sykora.

This is Lord's fifth total season coaching in the Washington organization after a six-year professional playing career and several seasons coaching in the Baltimore system. The Alabama native and Florida State alum was scheduled to be the Fredericksburg Pitching Coach in the canceled 2020 season, and was the Pitching Coach for one season in Double-A Harrisburg prior to joining the FredNats in 2023.



### MIKE HABAS - HITTING COACH

2nd Season | Previously: Hitting Coach, ACL Brewers

Habas, 34, returns to Fredericksburg from the 2024 championship staff for his second season with Washington after leading the FredNat offense to a highly successful season, finishing in the top third of the league in virtually every meaningful offensive category.

Prior to joining the Nationals, he spent spending the previous four seasons coaching in the Milwaukee Brewers organization, most recently as the Hitting Coach for the ACL Brewers in 2022 and 2023. Prior to joining Milwaukee, he was an Assistant Coach for the independent Gary SouthShore RailCats. While coaching with Gary, he was also the Head Coach at Prairie State College, a Junior College in the Chicago area.



### LUIS ORDAZ - DEVELOPMENT COACH

1st Season | Previously: Manager, FCL Nationals

Ordaz, 49, joins the FredNat coaching staff in the Development Coach role after managing the Florida Complex League Nationals in 2024.

He played parts of seven seasons in the Major Leagues, appearing in 206 career games with the St. Louis Cardinals, Kansas City Royals and Tampa Bay Devil Rays. Ordaz has coached in the Washington organization for over a decade, and was the Hitting Coach for the Potomac Nationals for four seasons from 2016-19. He replaces Carmelo Jaime, who will manage the FCL Nationals in 2025 after three seasons in Fredericksburg.
