FRISCO, TX — John Rave put the Northwest Arkansas Naturals up early, with a two-run homer in the third inning, but the Frisco Roughriders stormed ahead with a four-run fifth inning and the Naturals couldn't climb back, as the Riders took game one of the week's series on Tuesday, 4-3.

- Rave finished the day 1-for-1 in the box score, walking twice and laying down a sacrifice bunt in addition to his third-inning homer, his first of the year and the Naturals' second of the season.
- Rave's home run snapped a streak of 231 at-bats without a home run for the Naturals as a team, their longest since a 399 at-bat stretch from August 18 to August 31, 2019.
- Outside of Rave's home run, the only other Northwest Arkansas hit came in the seventh inning, as Maikel Garcia legged out an infield single that brought home Robbie Glendinning, the night's final run.
- Garcia extended his hitting streak to five games with the single, also stretching his on-base streak to 10 games, tied for the longest in the league.
- Starter Alec Marsh struck out four across 4.0 innings of work, though took his first loss of the season as he was responsible for all four runs that Frisco scored. Zach Haake allowed three inherited runners to score but did not allow an of his own to cross the plate, with 2.2 scoreless innings with two strikeouts. Stephen Woods Jr. finished the night, with 1.1 scoreless innings of his own, including a strikeout.

This Day in Naturals History The Naturals are 5-3 all-time when playing on April 20

On April 20, 2019, the Northwest Arkansas Naturals beat the Springfield Cardinals, 5-3 in 10 innings at Arvest Ballpark, winning on a walkoff two-run homer from **Gabriel Cancel**. Starting pitcher **Danny Duffy** was in Northwest Arkansas on MLB Rehab, pitching 5.1 innings while allowing just one unearned run on four hits, striking out seven in the no-decision. The Naturals nearly won the game in nine innings, but Springfield's Conner Capel scored on a wild pitch in the top of the ninth to tie the score at 3-3 and force extra innings.

THE CHAMPS ARE HERE!

Of the 28-man roster the Naturals rolled out for the Double-A Central Championship Series in 2021, nine players are on the Naturals' 2022 active roster, with a total of 10 returning players with the Naturals this season.

- Pitchers Holden Capps, Yefri Del Rosario, Drew Parrish, Andrés Sotillet, Stephen Woods Jr. and Ángel Zerpa were all a part of the championship celebration last year, as was outfielder Seuly Matias.
- Additionally, catcher/infielder Gavin Stupienski and pitcher Alec Marsh both played for the Naturals in 2021, as did catcher Tyler Cropley, who is currently on the Injured List.

FOLLOW THE LEADER

Manager Chris Widger enters his first season at the helm of the Naturals, after previous stops in *Advanced Rookie* Burlington (2019) and *High-A* Quad Cities (2021) managing Royals affiliates.

- 20 of the Naturals' 28 active players played for Widger with the Quad Cities River Bandits last season.
- 10 of the Naturals' 28 active players played under Widger with the Burlington Royals, then in Quad Cities and now in Northwest Arkansas:
 Dante Biasi, Jonah Dipoto, Maikel Garcia, Michael Massey, Jake Means, Drew Parrish, Zack Phillips, Logan Porter, John Rave and Ángel Zerpa.

STAR-STUDDED ROTATION

All five of the Naturals starting pitchers to open the season are consensus top prospects in the Royals' organization, with all five listed in MLB Pipeline's Top-30 rankings for Kansas City.

- RHP Alec Marsh started yesterday and will go ahead on Sunday, April 24th for the Naturals ... MLB Pipeline lists him at No. 12 in the system, while Baseball America has him at No. 11.
- LHP Drew Parrish starts today for the Naturals ... MLB Pipeline lists him at No. 29 in the system, while Baseball America had him at No. 38 in their preseason rankings.
- LHP Anthony Veneziano starts Thursday, April 21st for the Naturals ...
 MLB Pipeline lists him at No. 17 in the system, while Baseball America has him at No. 21.
- LHP Ángel Zerpa starts Friday, April 22nd, for the Naturals ... MLB Pipeline lists him at No. 13 in the system. while Baseball America has him at No. 20.
- LHP Asa Lacy starts Saturday, April 23rd for the Naturals ... MLB Pipeline
 lists him No. 72 overall in baseball, No. 4 in the system and the No. 5 lefthanded pitching prospect, while Baseball America has him at No. 4 in the
 Royals' minor league system, the No. 4 left-handed pitching prospect.

Toolsy Team

Six active Naturals players were listed in *Baseball America*'s 2022 Best Tools Survey of the Kansas City Royals' organization.

- CF Nick Loftin is rated as having the "Best Strike-Zone Discipline" in the system.
- C Sebastian Rivero is rated as being the "Best Defensive Catcher" in the system.
- SS **Maikel Garcia** is rated as having the "Best Infield Arm" in the system.
- RF Seuly Matias is rated as having the <u>"Best Outfield Arm"</u> in the system.
- LHP **Asa Lacy** is rated as having the "Best Slider" in the system.
- LHP **Ángel Zerpa** is rated as having the <u>"Best Control"</u> in the system.

GAR-SEE YA ON BASE

Shortstop **Maikel Garcia** drew 10 walks through the season's first five games, and despite having not drawn a walk in his last five games and 20 plate appearances, is still second in the Texas League in base on balls.

- Garcia drew at least one walk in each of the first five games he played, while walking twice or more on four occasions. He collected his first threewalk game on Wednesday 4/13 in the Naturals' 8-5 win over Wichita.
- In 47 plate appearances, the Venezuelan has reached base 24 times, for a cool .511 on-base percentage (14 hits + 10 walks) ... his OBP ranks fourth in the league, ninth in all of Double-A and is the best among qualified Naturals hitters ... he is the only Natural that has reached base in all 10 games this season and one of just two players in the Texas League with a 10-game reached base streak this year, along with San Antonio's Esteury Ruiz
- Garcia ranks among the Texas League leader in many categories, including tied 8th in batting average (.378), 3rd in on-base percentage (.511), tied 3rd in hits (14), tied 2nd in walks (10) and tied 3rd in steals (6).

STREAKY STARTS

While Maikel Garcia is the only Naturals hitter that has reached base at least once in all 10 games the team has played, he is not the only Natural that has reached base in every game they have played.

- SS Maikel Garcia has reached base in all nine games he's played started the season hitting .406 (13-for-32) with 2 doubles and 10 walks, giving him a .548 on-base percentage.
- INF Robbie Glendinning has reached base in all seven games he's played started the season hitting .182 (4-for-22) with 1 double and 7 walks, giving him a .400 on-base percentage.
- Prior to Tuesday, INF/OF Nate Eaton and 2B Michael Massey had both reached base in all eight games they'd played this season and OF Tucker Bradley had reached base in all six games he'd played to start the season, but all three of those streaks ended Tuesday as Eaton, Massey and Bradley all failed to reach base ... pinch-hitting in the 9th inning and striking out, Bradley's team-best six-game hitting streak ended as well, though Garcia is only one behind him right now at five games.

SNIDER DEBUTS AND EARNS THE DUB!

On April 9, right-handed pitcher **Collin Snider** made his Major League debut for the Kansas City Royals, the 111th Naturals alum to reach the Majors.

- Snider is one of 16 former Naturals on the Royals' 28-man Opening Day roster, one of 15 that has made their MLB debut after playing in Northwest Arkansas.
- Snider's first MLB appearance was a high-leverage situation, as he came on to pitch the 10th inning of a game tied 0-0 at Kauffman Stadium against Cleveland. He kept the Guardians off the board, with some defensive help from fellow 2021 Natural and 2022 debutante Bobby Witt Jr. and after the Royals walked it off in the bottom of the 10th for a 1-0 win, Snider was awarded his first MLB win in his debut.
- The full list of former Naturals on the Royals' active roster is: Scott Barlow, Jake Brentz, Dylan Coleman, Hunter Dozier, Cam Gallagher, Jackson Kowar, Nicky Lopez, Whit Merrifield, Adalberto Mondesi, Ryan O'Hearn, Salvador Perez, Brady Singer, Collin Snider, Gabe Speier, Josh Staumont and Bobby Witt Jr. ... note that Barlow pitched in MLB before he played for the Naturals.





