- The Blue Jays clinched a series victory with a 10-8, comeback win over Daytona on Sunday at TD Ballpark.
- Trailing 8-5 entering the bottom of the eighth, the Jays tallied five runs on three hits and four walks to take the lead.
- Yeuni Munoz belted his first home run of the season a solo shot in the second inning.
- Dunedin starter Nolan Perry lasted just three innings and issued six walks the most by a Dunedin pitcher this season.
- Kai Peterson nailed down the victory by leaving runners on second and third in the ninth.
- Despite the game's 18 combined runs, the two teams combined to hit a paltry 2-26 with runners in scoring position.

#### THE WEEK IN REVIEW

- Dunedin took the series, 3 games to 2, from Daytona at TD Ballpark. The series was shortened to five games as Saturday's contest was rained out and will be made up when the Blue Jays visit Daytona at the end of July.
- The Blue Jays bullpen was excellent posting a 1.01 ERA (3 ER in 26.2 IP), good for the second-best mark in all of Single-A last week.
- Dunedin largely struggled at the plate, hitting .163 with a .564 OPS as a team both 9th in the FSL last week.
- Robert Robertis belted a 2-run, walk-off home run in the 11th inning on Thursday night to end the first half on a high-note.

#### SERIES SUCCESS

Last week's series victory marks six straight sets with a split or better for the D-Jays. Across the last six series, Dunedin has earned three splits and three series wins.

### LONG TIME, NO SEE

This week's series between Dunedin and Lakeland marks the first set between the squads since opening weekend at TD Ballpark, when the Jays took two of three from the Flying Tigers. The weekend was highlighted by Manuel Beltre's two-run, walk-off home run on April 7.

#### JAMMIN' BATS IN JUNE

Dunedin's pitching staff is in the midst of its best month of the season, pitching to a 3.07 ERA in 19 games in June. The mark is third in the FSL, behind Palm Beach's 3.05 ERA and Lakeland's 2.94. In May, the Blue Jays turned in a 4.70 ERA - the second-worst in the league.

## VAMOS, VICTOR

Outfielder Victor Arias' .304 average and .851 OPS lead the Blue Jays in June. The hot month comes after a cool May in which Arias batted just .211. On June 14, Arias went 4-5 with 2 home runs and 8 RBIs - the most runs driven in by a D-Jay in a single game since 2021

### **UNBLEMISHED BULLPEN**

Dunedin's bullpen went 21.2 innings before surrendering an earned run to Daytona last week. All three earned runs surrendered by the 'pen were let up by Dahian Santos in the top of the 6th inning on Sunday.

### TOO CLOSE FOR COMFORT

Friday's 6-5 defeat marked Dunedin's 24th one-run game this season - the second-most in the FSL, behind Bradenton's 26. The Jays are 11-13 in those contests. 47 of the Blue Jays 68 games this season (69%) have been decided by three or fewer runs. Dunedin has a 24-23 record in those games.

## **INCREDIBLY IMMACULATE**

Fernando Perez delivered an immaculate fifth inning Friday night, marking the second immaculate inning in as many nights at TD Ballpark, after Adam Serwinowski pulled it off in the first inning on Thursday. The immaculate innings are the first in the Florida State League in nearly two years, as Bradenton's Carlos Jimenez was the last to do, on July 9, 2022. It's the first immaculate inning on record for the Dunedin Blue Jays since pitch-by-pitch data collection records for MiLB began in 2016.

### HOPE SPRINGS ETERNAL IN THE SUMMER

Dunedin opened the second half with a 10th inning loss Friday. The D-Jays' 34-32 mark in the first half was the team's best first half record since 2019 (41-24). Last season, Dunedin finished in last place in the FSL West in the second half with a 30-36 record. In 2022, Dunedin won the second-half title with a 38-25 record after going 28-38 in the first half.
