**Today:** The Lansing Lugnuts, the High-A affiliate of the A's, play the third in a six-game series with the Great Lakes Loons, the High-A affiliate of the Los Angeles Dodgers. The Lugnuts are 8-9 vs. the Loons in their 18-game season series after splitting two 3-2 games, dropping the opener before winning yesterday.

**Yesterday: Lugnuts 3, Loons 2.** Lansing starter **Mitch Myers** struck out nine batters in 5 2/3 innings, **Jared Dickey** lined a two-run double in the seventh inning, and **Will Simpson** delivered a go-ahead sacrifice fly in the ninth to help the Nuts eke out the slim victory over Great Lakes. In the win, **Ryan Lasko** went 2-for-4 with two singles, two steals and two runs scored.

**On the Air:** Today's game is on MiLB TV and Bally Live, or listen in to the Lugnuts audio stream via StreamGuys, **Jesse Goldberg-Strassler** and **Adam Jaksa** on the call.

**On Deck:** The Nuts play the Loons through Sunday before returning home on August 13 to welcome in the West Michigan Whitecaps for a six-game series.

### LUG•NOTES

**Ri-dickey-ulous:** **Jared Dickey** singled, doubled and walked in four plate appearances yesterday, and now the Quad Cities River Bandit-turned-Lansing Lugnut (via trade) is 4th in the Midwest League in overall batting average (.285), 10th in overall on-base percentage (.376), 10th in overall OPS (.810) and 9th in total base hits (90). The 22-year-old Dickey is slashing .462/.548/.538 in seven games with the Lugnuts, going 12-for-26 with two doubles, two HBPs, three walks and five RBIs.

**Team Effort:** The Nuts' offense is 1st in the Midwest League in at-bats (3,458), base hits (863) and triples (35); 2nd in batting average (.250), runs (517), total bases (1,312), doubles (169) and OPS (.718); and 3rd in slugging percentage (.379) and on-base percentage (.339).

**Pitching Excellence:** Combining **Grant Judkins** (on his birthday) tossing four hitless innings with seven strikeouts on Tuesday and **Mitch Myers** following up with 5 1/3 innings and nine strikeouts last night, the Nuts held the Loons to one hit and no runs in a nine-inning span with 15 strikeouts. Today, by the way, is **Casey Yamauchi's** 24th birthday.

**To the Show:** 2017 & 2019 Lugnuts infielder **Luis De Los Santos** made his Major League debut for the Blue Jays last Wednesday, July 31, thus becoming the 6th former Lugnut to debut this season and the 190th all-time Lugnut to go from Lansing to the Majors.

**Prospecting:** The Nuts have six MLB Pipeline Top 30 A's prospects: pitcher **Luis Morales** (No. 2), outfielder **Ryan Lasko** (No. 16), pitcher **Kade Morris** (No. 20), infielder **Will Simpson** (No. 26), pitcher **Will Johnston** (No. 27) and outfielder **Jared Dickey** (No. 28).

**The Future is Here:** Lugs right-hander **Luis Morales**, tomorrow's starting pitcher, tossed 2/3 of an inning in the 2024 All-Star Futures Game at Globe Life Field in Arlington, Texas, striking out Jeral Pérez and Deyvison De Los Santos alongside an HBP and BB. Morales was the A's sole representative in the prospect showcase, and the fifth all-time current Lugnut to play in the game.

## TODAY IN LUGNUTS HISTORY

**2010:** Greg Wilborn struck out 12 Lugnuts in seven shutout innings, and the Lugnuts were three-hit in an 11-0 loss at Great Lakes.

**2015:** Dawel Lugo became the latest Lugnut to be traded, joining Tim Locastro and Jesus Tinoco, shipped to the Arizona Diamondbacks (specifically, the Kane County Cougars) in exchange for Cliff Pennington. Meanwhile, Starlyn Suriel gave up a home run to Joe Bennie on the game's first pitch and then settled in to strike out 12 batters in 6 1/3 innings in an 8-5 win over Beloit at Cooley Law School Stadium.

**2018:** Coincidence? The Lugnuts won their third consecutive game by the same exact 5-4 score, knocking off the Dayton Dragons at Cooley Law School Stadium. (On August 9th, the Lugnuts beat the Dragons... 4-3.)

**In a Nutshell:** Acquired straight up by the A's from the Mets for American League All-Star Paul Blackburn before the trade deadline, July 30, 2022... tossed a team-high seven innings in Athletics organizational debut on August 2 vs. Dayton, becoming the 947th player in team history... 45th different Lugnut utilized this year and the 14th different starting pitcher... born in Modesto... hails from the same hometown as former Lugnut Tyler Soderstrom, Turlock, Calif., whom he is close to... attended John H. Pitman High School (which also produced Colin Kaepernick), while Soderstrom attended Turlock H.S. with Rockies 2023 2nd-rounder Cole Carrigg.

**Prospecting:** MLB Pipeline ranks Kade the A's No. 10 pitching prospect and No. 20 overall prospect, grading his pitches at Fastball - 50, Curve - 45, Slider - 50, Change - 50, Control - 50... they write, "The 6-foot-3 hurler can run his pair of fastballs up to 95-96 mph but will generally be in the 91-94 range. His sinker, with 17-18 inches of arm-side run, has been the better pitch of the two heaters, but he's continued to develop his four-seamer as well. Similarly, he'll throw three different slider varieties -- hard slider, cutter, sweeper -- with the first on that list the most reliable of the bunch at this stage. His mid-70s curveball remains a work in progress, particularly when it comes to finding a consistent arm slot, and while he didn't throw his 85-89 mph changeup much in the Florida State League this season, the offering was arguably his best in college, as he sold it well with good arm speed... Morris shows athleticism on the mound, and his history of throwing strikes has carried into the lower levels of pro ball. His pitch mix is diverse enough to give him starting upside, but he could use a tick or two more of sharpness to become the No. 4 or 5 in a Major League rotation."

**Quoting Keith Law:** "He's a sinker/slider guy who gets a lot of groundballs and pop-ups, with solid-average control. He's probably a fifth starter now who could be a fourth starter if he improves his fringy changeup."

**Path to Lansing:** Morris made his pro debut in 2023, making one start in the Florida Coast League (one inning, one unearned run) and one start in the Florida State League (2 1/3 innings, one run)... opened this season in the FSL with the Single-A St. Lucie Mets, earning a promotion to the High-A South Atlantic League in mid May immediately after a seven-inning scoreless gem against Palm Beach on May 15... notable stats in the FSL, lefties hit .306/.386/.565, .951 OPS while righties hit .205/.244/.342, .586... allowed five steals in six attempts... tossed at least six innings in six of 11 High-A appearances; lefties slashed .225/.304/.333, .637, while righties hit .217/.291/.365, .656 OPS... runners were successful in seven of nine steal attempts.

**College Days:** Attended Nevada, which also produced Lugnuts hitting coach Kevin Kouzmanoff... posted 7.71 ERA as a freshman (18 G, 1 GS, 25 2/3 IP, 13 BB, 15 K)... improved to 4.32 ERA as sophomore in 2022 (18 G, 4 GS, 66 2/3 IP, 22 BB, 53 K) and was named All-Mountain West Second Team; in Mountain West Championship game, tossed 8 2/3 innings to lead Nevada to victory... spent the summer with Cotuit on the Cape and allowed only two runs in 16 2/3 IP (1.08 ERA)... named Preseason All-Mountain West Second Team in 2023, served as Friday starter, and led the Wolf Pack in strikeouts (85 in 81 1/3 IP) on a squad that set the single-season school record for most team strikeouts... tossed two complete games.

**Turning Pro:** Undrafted out of high school... selected with the final pick of the third round by the Mets in 2023 following junior season at Nevada, signing for \$666,500, the third largest bonus handed out to a member of the Wolf Pack in school history... other notable Major Leaguers from the University of Nevada, Kevin Kouzmanoff excluded: Lyle Overbay, Chris Singleton, Ryan Church, Chad Qualls, T.J. Mathews, Braden Shipley.
