- Will large trash bins be supplied?
 - Yes, at the team area one 55 gallon trash container will be provided for every 2 teams. This will include extra bags OR one large dumpster will be close to the teams for easy access.
 - For the judging area, one 55 gallon trash bin will be provided for every (4) four tables plus (1) one for any leftover table area. These will either be metal or plastic, plus extra bags.
- Will grease disposals be provided?
 - Yes, we will have (2) two containers for grease as well as (2) for ash. These will be placed at each end of the cook team area.
- Where are the rules for the contestants located?
 - All rules and regulations for the KCBS BBQ Competition are located at kcbs.us. When you get to the homepage, click on the 'Teams' button and then click on the 'Contest Rules & Regulations' button.
- When will Toyota Field open for set up?
 - $\circ~$ We will open at 12:00 noon on Friday August 4th.
- Is there a site map available?
 - No, the competition will take place in the gravel lot right outside of the stadium.
- When is the cook team meeting?
 - The meeting for cook teams will take place on Friday August 4th at 6:00pm.
- When is the meat inspection scheduled?
 - The meat inspections will take place upon the team's arrival on Friday August 4th.
- Will electricity be supplied?
 - No, Toyota Field will not be supplying electricity.
- Are containers provided for submission?
 - Yes, to the contestants. The containers will be at least a 9x9 one compartment container.
- When are the judging times?
 - Judging will begin for chicken at 12pm and for ribs at 12:30pm

- What time will the awards ceremony begin?
 - The awards ceremony will begin 2-3 hours after the last turn-in
- Where will judging take place?
 - Judging will take place at the center field gate inside of the stadium.
