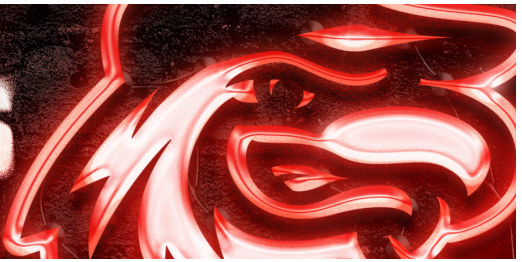

WSH AFFILIATE NOTES

Double-A Harrisburg extended their best start in franchise history to 6-0 last night, exploding for 12 runs to beat Akron, 12-1...C **MAXWELL ROMERO JR.** notched three hits, including two doubles in the win, while adding four RBI.

LEHIGH DEATH VALLEY: With a chance to take a commanding 3-0 series lead Thursday night, the Rochester Red Wings instead came up short, falling 8-1 to the Lehigh Valley IronPigs...CF **ANDREW PINCKNEY** picked up a pair of hits and an RBI at the plate, and RF **CHRISTIAN FRANKLIN** added two hits of his own out of the leadoff spot...2B **TREY LIPSCOMB** picked up the Red Wings' only extra-base hit of the night, a double down the right field line in the third...Rochester looks to get back on track and ensure at least a series split tonight, sending RHP **LUIS PERALES** to the mound for his third start of 2026...Lehigh Valley will counter with right-hander Connor Gillispie.

FRANK(LIN) THE TANK: RF **CHRISTIAN FRANKLIN** extended his on-base streak to all 10 games he's played in this season, going 2-for-4 with a pair of singles at the plate...the Arkansas alum has picked up a hit in nine of those 10 games, and now holds a share of the team lead with three multi-hit performances (**DYLAN CREWS**, 3)...since the start of 2025 when Franklin was a member of Triple-A Iowa (CHC), he ranks among the International League-leaders in several categories, including walks (2nd, 86), OBP (3rd, .391), runs scored (T-7th, 85), OPS (9th, .810), total hits (T-9th, 133), and batting average (10th, .274)...

Franklin reached base in each of his last eight games to end 2025, giving him an 18-game on-base streak dating back to 8/31/2025 at JAX.

PINCK PANTHER: CF **ANDREW PINCKNEY** drove in one of Rochester's two runs in last night's loss, driving an RBI single up the middle to cap a 2-for-4 night at the plate while adding a stolen base...across nine games played at Coca-Cola Park since his Triple-A debut with Rochester on 8/27/2024, the University of Alabama product carries a .361 (13-for-36) batting average with a .750 SLG, 1.175 OPS, six XBH (4 HR, 2 2B), 11 RBI, and five stolen bases...

Pinckney is now just two hits shy of 150 as a Red Wing, 10th-most among any hitter in the Nationals era (since 2021)...current Charlotte Knight Darren Baker leads the way in that category with 321.

MY LIPS(COMB) ARE SEALED: In the top of the third last night, 2B **TREY LIPSCOMB** drove an 0-1 fastball the other way into the right field corner for his team-leading fourth double of the season...Lipscomb finished the night 1-for-4, adding a run scored to his line...the Maryland native led the Red Wings with 29 two-baggers a season ago, and is now T-5th in the International League with 33 since Opening Day of 2025...

Four of his five hits in April have been doubles.

SQUEAKY CLEAN: For the third consecutive game, and 10th time in their first 12 games of 2026, Rochester's defense played error-free baseball...the club has committed just three errors this season, tied for the fewest among all affiliated teams with at least 10 games played (LAD, CLE), trailing just Milwaukee (1)...eight different Red Wings have logged at least 25.0 innings without making an error in the field, the most of any Triple-A team.

LONG STORY SHORT: SS **ZACK SHORT** drove in the other of the Red Wings two runs last night, going 1-for-3 with an RBI single...the Kingston, New York native has now picked up a hit in five consecutive games dating back to game two on 4/3 vs. SWB, tied with OF **DYLAN CREWS** for the longest active streak on the team...across eight games in April, Short carries a .368/.458/.526 slash line (7-for-19) with four RBI, four walks, and a stolen base.

THIS DAY IN RED WINGS HISTORY...

THIS DAY IN RED WINGS HISTORY...2007: 19 years ago today, the Red Wings held off a late Norfolk rally to win in front of the Rochester faithful, 4-3...RHP **KEVIN SLOWEY** picked up the win on the mound, tossing 6.0 innings while allowing one unearned run on three hits with a pair of strikeouts and no walks...three consecutive RBI singles in the bottom of the second led to all four Rochester runs, including one off the bat of CF **DENARD SPAN**.

Entering sixth season of professional baseball, first with Nationals after being acquired from Boston in exchange for LHP Jake Bennett on 12/15/2025...originally signed with Boston as an international free agent on 7/2/2019...earned Arizona Fall League Rising Stars honors in 2025...named Carolina League Pitcher of the Week on 6/18/2023 with Single-A Salem...Earned Florida Coast League Pitcher of the Month for July and Pitcher of the Week on 7/17 with FCL Red Sox in 2022.

- Slated to make his third start of 2026 on 4/10 at LHV...on 3/29/2026, became first Red Wing pitcher since 2023 to throw multiple pitches over 100.0 MPH in the same outing.
- Missed most of the 2025 season due to Tommy John surgery...made one start with Double-A Portland (BOS) before he was transferred to Triple-A Worcester on 9/16.
- Made his Triple-A debut on 9/17 against Rochester, striking out three batters in 1.0 inning of work.
- Made nine starts in 2024 for High-A Greenville (BOS, 7) and Double-A Portland (2) in 2024, going 2-2 with a 2.94 ERA (11 ER/33.2 IP), 56 strikeouts, 12 walks, a 1.31 WHIP, .250 BAA, and only one homer allowed...averaged 14.97 K/9, the 15th-highest mark in MiLB and the highest in the Red Sox system (min. 30.0 IP).
- In final outing with Greenville on May 21 at Greensboro (PIT), allowed only one hit in 5.0 scoreless innings while matching a career high with 12 strikeouts.
- Placed on the 7-Day Injured List on 6/9...on 6/27/2024, underwent Tommy John surgery, performed by Dr. Jeffrey Dugas at the Andrews Sports Medicine & Orthopedics Center in Birmingham, AL.
- 2025 Pitch mix; 4-Seam FB - 98.6 MPH, 28% usage; Cutter - 91.1 MPH, 41% usage; Slider - 87.5 MPH, 14% usage; Changeup - 85.0 MPH, 17% usage.

Entering his sixth professional season, first with the Nationals organization after he signed as a Minor League free agent on March 31, 2026...originally selected by New York-AL in the ninth round of the 2021 MLB Draft, out of the University of Southern California...named Texas League Pitcher of the Week with Northwest Arkansas on 5/19/2024, and 7/30/2023...named Midwest League Pitcher of the Week with Quad City on May 7, 2023.

- Began the 2026 season with Double-A Harrisburg...transferred to Triple-A Rochester on 4/4, without appearing in a game.
- Made 29 appearances (25 GS) with Triple-A Omaha in 2025...went 4-9 with a 7.84 ERA (204 ER/119.1 IP), while compiling 100 strikeouts against 51 walks...ranked second among all Royals Minor League pitchers with in games started, fourth in innings pitched, and T-9th in strikeouts.
- Finished the season with three consecutive scoreless appearances in relief, combining to allow four hits with six strikeouts and no walks across 6.0 innings.
- Has made 107 appearances (99 GS) across his MiLB career, having just crossed 500 innings pitched in his final outing of 2025.

Entering his 14th professional season, second with the Nationals organization after he was claimed off waivers from Los Angeles-NL on 8/17/2025...originally signed with Colorado as an international free agent on 7/2/2012...named a Mexican League Mid-Season All-Star in 2024 with El Aguila de Veracruz...earned Northwest League Mid-Season All-Star honors in 2016 with Boise (COL).

- Made 35 appearances (4 starts) with Triple-A Oklahoma City (LAD) in 2025, logging a 3-0 record with a 3.05 ERA (14 ER/41.1 IP) with 49 strikeouts and 15 walks, while holding opponents to a .240 batting average...appeared in one game with Los Angeles-NL on 7/7 at MIL, after having his contract selected earlier that day...optioned to OKC on 7/8, and designated for assignment on 8/15...claimed by Washington on 8/17 and assigned to Triple-A Rochester.
- Across final 14 appearances (2 GS) with Oklahoma City since 6/27, allowed one earned run across 15.1 innings (0.59 ERA) with 22 strikeouts and five walks, with a 0.72 WHIP...over that stretch, ranked second in the Pacific Coast League (min 10.0 IP) in ERA and BAA (.118), third in WHIP, and is tied for the sixth-fewest hits allowed (6).
- Made his Red Wing debut on 8/20 against Toledo...collected his 300th minor league strikeout on 8/27 at Jacksonville...struck out the side against BUF on 9/11, collecting his 150th Triple-A strikeout.
- Has appeared in 10 MLB games since his debut with Colorado in 2021 (9/5 vs. ATL).
