GONE FISCH-ING

3B/1B ANDREW FISCHER enters today with 44 home runs between High-A (20) and Double-A (24), the most in MiLB... With 3 home runs on August 27, Fischer became the 1st Brewers Minor League player with a 40 home run season since **CF GORMAN THOMAS** (51) in 1974.

🔗 Fischer enters today tied for the 9th-most home runs by a minor league player in the Modern Era (since the 1963 reorganization)... It marks the most in a season since 2004, when **1B RYAN HOWARD** recorded 46.

🔗 Fischer has recorded 106 RBI between Biloxi (56) and High-A Wisconsin (50)... Fischer is the 8th Brewers Minor League player this century to record 100+ RBI in a season and the 1st since **C HUNTER MORRIS** (113) in 2012... Fischer enters today with the 5th-most RBI by a Brewers MiLB hitter this century.

🔗 No Brewers Minor League player has led MiLB in home runs since **C BILL FOLEY** (34) in 1978 with the Class-A Burlington Bees of the Midwest League... Fischer leads by 6 over **OF LAZARO MONTES** (38) with 9 games remaining in the regular season.

CHASING DOWN ANOTHER RECORD

SS JESÚS MADE (84) enters today with the 3rd-most RBI in a single season in Shuckers franchise history (since 2015)... The current single-season record is 89, set by **OF JACKSON CHOURIO** in 2023.

🔗 Made is hitting .308 (44-for-143) with an .854 OPS with runners in scoring position this season.

🔗 **OF RECE HINDS** (98, CHA, 2023) is the only Southern League player with 90+ RBI in a season since 2017... **OF TYLER O'NEILL** (102, JAX, 2016) is the last Southern League hitter with a 100 RBI season.

MADE FOR THE MOMENT

SS JESÚS MADE recorded his 3rd walk-off of the season on Wednesday, with all 3 coming against the Barons... In 14 games against the Barons, Made is hitting .322 (19-for-59) with 2 doubles, a home run and 14 RBI.

HIP, HIPO'RAE!

On Friday, **2B DYLAN O'RAE** set the Shuckers new single-season franchise record with his 53rd stolen base of the season... O' Rae's 56 stolen bases mark the most in a season by a Brewers Double-A player since 1984, when **OF MIKE FELDER** recorded 58 with the El Paso Diablos.

🔗 O' Rae enters today as the Southern League leader in stolen bases (56)... No Shucker has led the league in stolen bases since **OF COREY RAY** (37) in 2018.

HOMER HAPPY SHUCKERS

Across 60 games in the second half, the Shuckers have hit 96 home runs, the most by a Southern League team in the 2nd Half since 2005... The Shuckers have recorded a home run in 47 of 60 games in the half.

🔗 The Shuckers enters today with a franchise record 163 home runs... The previous record was 154, set in 2022.

ALL ABOUT THE BULLPEN

During the Shuckers current homestand (since 8/25), the bullpen owns a 3.38 ERA (16er, 42.2ip) with a .230 opponents average and a 23% strikeout rate... The 3.38 ERA is the 5th-best by a Double-A bullpen during that span.

PLAYOFFS?!?!? WE'RE TALKING ABOUT PLAYOFFS!

The Shuckers are set to begin the 2026 Southern League playoffs on the road on Tuesday, September 15 against the 2nd Half winner in the South Division... It marks the 25th playoff appearance by a Brewers Double-A affiliate and the 6th in Shuckers franchise history... No Brewers Double-A affiliate has won an outright league championship since the 1994 El Paso Diablos (Texas League).

TODAY'S STARTING PITCHER (GAME 1)

LHP J.D. THOMPSON (0-3, 4.41) makes his 5th Double-A start and 16th start between all levels this season... Across his first 4 Double-A starts, Thompson has limited right-handed batters to a .209 average with a 35% strikeout rate and 36% whiff rate.

TODAY'S STARTING PITCHER (GAME 2)

RHP JARON DEBERRY (7-8, 4.31) makes his team-leading 24th start of the season and his 3rd against the Barons... DeBerry enters today among the Southern League leaders in ERA (1st, 4.31), strikeouts (1st, 132), opponents average (1st, .227), innings pitched (T-4th, 119.0) and WHIP (5th, 1.34).

🔗 DeBerry is looking to become the 1st Shucker to win the Southern League strikeout crown since **RHP TOBIAS MYERS** in 2023.
