HOOKS EDGE RIDERS IN EXTRAS:

Ryan Garcia tossed five shutout innings in his start but the Frisco RoughRiders lost 3-2 on Friday to the Corpus Christi Hooks at Riders Field. Garcia allowed just three hits and struck out seven. As a pitching staff, Frisco (29-26, 60-63) struck out 17 batters of the 27 outs recorded. Grant Wolfram recorded two perfect innings out of Frisco's bullpen, striking out five of six batters. He lowered his ERA to 2.02 and has not allowed a run this week in 3.2 innings. The series is now even at two games apiece after Friday's contest, which was delayed from 7:05 p.m. to 9 p.m. due to power issues and was scheduled for seven innings. Neither team scored in the first seven frames and then both teams scored twice in the eighth to exteen the contest to the ninth. Frisco put two runs on the board in the eighth with Chris Seise's RBI single and Kellen Strahm's run-scoring groundout. The Hooks (27-28, 60-64) had scored two unearned runs in the top of the eighth. After another unearned run for Corpus Christi in the top of the ninth, Frisco did not score the designated runner. Each of the four games in the series have been decided by one run, with the two clubs alternating wins. Frisco is now three games behind Amarillo in the hunt for the second half title and a playoff berth. Antoine Kelly (3-1) suffered his first loss of the season by allowing three unearned runs in extra innings. Cesar Gomez (2-4) took the win by pitching the eighth, and Cole McDonald picked up the save by going 1-2-3 in the ninth inning.

DRIVERS, START YOUR ENGINES:

The RoughRiders have scored in the first inning in five of the last seven games. The Riders are tied for the Texas League lead in first-inning runs with 95 over their 123 games. As a team, Frisco is hitting .274/.370/.440/.810 in the first inning with 14 home runs.

WALK IT LIKE I TALK IT:

For almost the entire season, the RoughRiders have lead the Texas League in walks as an offense. Frisco has already shattered their franchise record for most walks in a season with 617 and counting (5.0 per game). Frisco's .357 on-base percentage is on pace to set a new franchise record as well. In the six games in Midland, the Riders walked 38 times (6.3 per game) with **Chris Seise, Trevor Hauver** and **David Garcia** leading the way with five.

HE'S DOING BIG(GERS) THINGS:

RoughRiders infielder Jax Biggers has been showing off in the power department this season for Frisco. Entering 2023, his career high in home runs was four and on Wednesday, he hit his 11th long ball of the season. In his last 30 games, he has clubbed six homers while hitting .281 (32-for-114)/.393/.518/.919 with five doubles, two triples, six home runs, 19 RBIs, 20 walks and 19 runs scored. In August, he had a .902 OPS, which lead the team.

NEW MONTH, NEW ME:

The RoughRiders have struggled on the mound this season, but in the month of August, they were fantastic. In the 27 games in August, (14-13 record) the RoughRiders were third in the Texas League with a 4.13 ERA while allowing a league-low 21 home runs. **Ryan Garcia** was brilliant three Tuesdays ago in Corpus, allowing just two base runners on walks over six no-hit innings with six strikeouts. **Nick Krauth** then followed up with a second quality start, giving the RoughRiders their first back-to-back quality starts since May 31st and June 1st when **Owen White** and **Jack Leiter** completed the feat. On the offensive side in the month, Frisco is second-to-last in the Texas League with a .727 OPS and tied for last in runs per game with 4.8 per contest. Their 17 homers were last in Double-A. September started the same way, pitching brilliantly (9 IP, 0 ER), but just two runs on three hits offensively in a loss.

HAUV YOURSELF A YEAR:

Trevor Hauver has been fantastic recently for the RoughRiders on the offensive side. On June 16th, he was hitting .218/.337/.368/.705, but in the 57 games since, he is batting .294/.407/.477/.884 with 16 doubles, seven home runs, 33 RBIs and 41 walks. In those games, he has raised his average 42 points and his OPS 99 points.

HICKS IS THE CORRECT PICK:

Liam Hicks has been as hot as anyone at the plate for the RoughRiders. Over the last 37 games, Hicks is batting .315 (40-for-127)/.426/.417/.843 with eight doubles, a triple, a home run, 22 RBIs, 22 walks and 17 runs scored. In August, he is batting .338 (26-for-77) with a .890 OPS.

K'S BY KELLY:

RoughRiders reliever **Antoine Kelly** has been incredible out of the Riders bullpen recently. He allowed an earned run for the first time on August 17th in his last 21.2 innings. During that stretch, he had 25 strikeouts to three walks while recording four saves. He has converted on all 11 save opportunities this season. He was named Texas Rangers Minor League Reliever of the Month for July.

ONE HOME RUN, PLEASE. AND MAKE IT GRAND:

The RoughRiders have had a knack for grand slams this year with **Evan Carter** hitting Frisco's ninth grand slam of the season. They are one of five teams with at least nine grand slams in all of Minor League Baseball. Seven different players have accounted for the grand slams (**Liam Hicks, Luisangel Acuña, Jax Biggers, Dustin Harris, Trevor Hauver, Thomas Saggese** (3) and **Evan Carter**). On July 5th, the Riders allowed their first grand slam this year, becoming the final Texas League team to do so.

-Went to Northgate High School in Walnut Creek, California (across the Bay from San Francisco, east of Berkeley). His senior season, he went 6-5 with a 2.20 ERA over 11 games

-Krauth then went to the University of New Mexico for the 2018 season, where he was teammates with current RoughRiders pitcher Justin Slaten.

-After New Mexico, transferred to Diablo Valley College in Pleasant Valley, California where he went 5-4 with a 2.20 ERA. Following that strong season, he transferred again, this time to the University of Connecticut, where he was one of the best pitchers in the country for the 2020 season before it was cut short due to COVID. In his four starts, he went 4-0 with a 0.36 ERA and a .167 BAA. This included five one-run innings against the No. 1 Michigan Wolverines on

-Due to the 2020 MLB Draft getting shortened to five rounds, Krauth went undrafted and signed with the Rangers as a free agent on June 15th.

-Brother, Ben Krauth, pitched for the San Antonio Missions in 2022, making nine starts and recording a 7.18 ERA. In two starts against Frisco, the RoughRiders touched him up for a combined seven runs, six earned, over 7.2 innings while handing him two losses. Ben was released by the Padres organization at the end of the year and retired after six seasons of MiLB experience.

2023 SEASON

-Krauth made first appearance of the season out of the bullpen on Friday, April 7th, allowing

-In his first start, Krauth went shutout five innings at San Antonio on April 14th to earn the first win among RoughRiders starting pitchers.

-Threw four scoreless innings on April 20th before game was suspended due to rain in the top of the fifth with the Riders up 9-0, ending his night early. The Riders and the Travelers went on to finish the game on April 21st with Frisco winning 13-5.

-Allowed a run in the fourth inning against Amarillo on April 26th, snapping a 14.2-consecutive innings scoreless streak dating back to April 7th.

-Joined Triple-A Round Rock on May 2nd for a spot start and make two appearances. In his start, he went 3.2 IP, 2 H, 0 R, 0 ER, 3 BB, 1 K. Allowed a grand slam to David Freitas of Oklahoma City in relief appearance.

2022 SEASON

-Spent time as both a starter and reliever, going 4-7 with a 5.38 ERA in 17 starts and 1-0, 2.25 ERA out of the bullpen.

-An extreme groundball pitcher, Krauth rolled groundballs at a 50.2% clip with the Crawdads.

2021 SEASON

-Showing his durability, Krauth led the Low-A East and the Rangers organization with 102.2 innings pitched. He also made a team-high 20 starts.

-Earned Low-A East Pitcher of the Week twice, including once for a complete-game, onehitter on August 28th vs. Fayetteville (9.0 IP, 1 H, 1 R, 1 ER, 2 BB, 9 K).
