**Today:** It's the finale of a six-game series, with the Lansing Black Rhinos looking for a fourth straight win and a series victory over the Fort Wayne TinCaps after dropping the first two games of the series. Right-hander **Shohei Tomioka** makes his sixth start of the season, opposed by Fort Wayne lefty **Danny Denz**. Each pitcher is making his second start of the series: Tomioka went to the mound on Wednesday for Lansing, allowing seven runs in 3 1/3 innings, while Denz fired five scoreless innings in the Tuesday opener.

Last Night: Lansing Locos 3, Fort Wayne TinCaps 1. In a special Copa de La Diversión contest, Colin Peluse struck out six 'Caps in six scoreless innings and Jordan Díaz delivered a pair of RBI singles, lifting los Locos to the win. The game was played in just two hours and 28 minutes, coming a night after the two clubs played a four-hour, two-minute contest.

On Deck: After a league-wide day off tomorrow, Lansing travels to play at Lake County from August 3-8, returning home to host Dayton on August 20-25.

What's New in 2021: Entering this season, the Black Rhinos' stadium name changed from Cooley Law School Stadium to Jackson® Field™, Lansing moved up to the High-A Central and the ballclub accepted an invitation to affiliate with the A's, the Nuts' fourth MLB partner, following the Royals (1996-98), Cubs (1999-2004) and Blue Jays (2005-2020).

#### Lug. Notes: Headlines and Points of Interest

Why the Black Rhinos? On December 24, 2019, a baby male eastern black rhino was born to mama Doppsee at the Potter Park Zoo, located only a few minutes away from Jackson® Field™ off Pennsylvania Avenue. It was the very first black rhino born at the Potter Park Zoo and a notable baby for a highly endangered species; there are estimated to be only about 5,000 black rhinos in the world today, and only two are born each year in American zoos. The calf, soon to be named Jaali (meaning "powerful" in Swahili), proved wonderfully popular in viral videos spreading through Greater Lansing and beyond. In the autumn, Jaali is scheduled to move to the Living Desert Zoo and Gardens in Palm Desert, Calif., to be paired with Nia, from Cleveland. Today, the Lansing Black Rhinos celebrate one of Lansing's most popular young residents, Jaali, and Potter Park Zoo.

No Place Like Close to Home: The Black Rhinos' period of easy travel is about to come to an end. Lansing has not had to leave the state since June 27 thanks to three homestands and road trips to Midland (Great Lakes) and Comstock Park (West Michigan), but on Tuesday, the team will travel via bus to Eastlake, Ohio, to begin a series against the Lake County Captains.

Three Nuts Go to Washington: Before Friday's game, catcher Drew Millas and pitchers Richard Guasch and Seth Shuman were traded by the Oakland Athletics to the Washington Nationals in exchange for catcher Yan Gomes and outfielder Josh Harrison. All three are expected to report to High-A Wilmington. Interestingly, Gomes played in Lansing in 2010. On the other side of the field, Fort Wayne was also affected, with Anderson Espinoza sent to the Chicago Cubs in exchange for... well, hang on, this gets interesting...

More Trade Talk: In addition to Yan Gomes, a number of other former Lansing players were also dealt approaching the deadline, namely:

- the Chicago Cubs traded **Jake Marisnick** to the Padres for the aforementioned Espinoza,
- the Cubs also sent Ryan Tepera to the White Sox for Bailey Horn,
- the St. Louis Cardinals traded  $\textbf{Lane\ Thomas}$  to the Washington Nationals for Jon Lester,
- the Seattle Mariners sent Kendall Graveman to the Astros in a four-player deal with Rafael Montero for Abraham Toro and Joe Smith,
- and the Detroit Tigers traded **Daniel Norris** to the Brewers for Reese Olson.

Alumni Report: Vladimir Guerrero, Jr., who played for the 2017 Lansing squad at 18 years old, is third in the Majors in batting average (.327), second in home runs (33), first in RBIs (83), second in on-base percentage (.424), second in slugging (.654), first in total bases (240), first in OPS (1.078) and first in runs scored (81).

Historical Lugnuts Roster Index: Debuting with two innings of relief yesterday, Norge Ruíz became the 849th Lansing player all-time and the 45th player used this year. The franchise record for most players used in a single year is 54, set in 2017. Currently, 18.7% of the franchise's players have reached the Major Leagues (159 of 849), with five players debuting in the Majors this season (Ty Tice, Joshua Palacios, Tayler Saucedo, Conner Greene and Kirby Snead). If that percentage holds true, at least eight of the 45 Lansing players this year will eventually reach the Majors.

#### TODAY IN LUGNUTS HISTORY

**2010:** 19-year-old Jake Marisnick made his Lugnuts debut, jumping up from the Gulf Coast Blue Jays. Marisnick, a 3rd-round selection in 2009, had slashed .287/.373/.459 in 35 games in the GCL. On this night, he went 2-for-3 with a single, double and two RBIs, plus an HBP. Kevin Ahrens went 2-for-2 with two walks and two solo home runs, scoring four runs, but the Nuts lost at Bowling Green, 10-8. Lugnuts pitcher Egan Smith was ejected in the 9th from the first-base visitors dugout and made sure to take a sloooooow walk to the clubhouse, located out beyond the left-center field wall at Bowling Green Ballpark.

Root, Root for the Home Team: July 4th's Lugnuts/Dragons series finale drew a season-high attendance of 10,109. That's higher than the average attendance in MLB for the Baltimore Orioles, Pittsburgh Pirates, Tampa Bay Rays, Miami Marlins and Oakland Athletics. Only nine of the 119 other Minor League teams have drawn a larger crowd to a game this season: Albuquerque, Nashville, Salt Lake, Charlotte, Fresno, Indianapolis, Round Rook, Durham and Las Vegas.

**Pitching is an Art... and So is Sculpting: Blake McFarland**, who pitched for the 2012 Lansing Lugnuts, is now a professional sculptor who competed on NBC's reality show "Making It," hosted by Nick Offerman and Amy Poehler, but was eliminated in the fifth episode.

Major League Lugnuts: Five former Nuts have made their Major League debuts this season, bringing the total to 159 all-time - pitcher Ty Tice '18, outfielder Josh Palacios '16-'17, pitcher Tayler Saucedo '16-'17, pitcher Conner Greene '15 and pitcher Kirby Snead '16-'17. Tice and Palacios made their first MLB appearance in the same game for the Toronto Blue Jays on April 9th. It was the seventh time in team history that two Lugnuts made their MLB debut in the same game, with the first occurring on September 14, 1998: Carlos Febles and Carlos Beltrán for the Kansas City Royals. Snead most recently debuted, appearing in relief for the Blue Jays on July 28.

Star of Stars: The 2021 MLB All-Star Game MVP Award was won by 2017 Lugnut Vladimir Guerrero, Jr., who went 1-for-3 with two RBIs, including a 468-foot home run, in the American League's 5-2 victory. Fellow 2017 Lugnut Bo Bichette came off the bench for the A.L. as reserve shortstop.

Record-Setting, Single Game, Stolen Bases: On June 15, Max Schuemann broke Samad Taylor's franchise single-game record of four steals in a game (set July 1, 2018) with five stolen bases against the Great Lakes Loons.

Record-Setting, Single Game, Home Runs Allowed: On June 20, Stevie Emanuels broke the franchise single game record, tied many times before, of three homers served up in a game, giving up four HRs to the Loons - two apiece by Deacon Liput and Andy Pages.

Record-Setting, Single Game, HBPs: On July 14, Lansing Lugnuts pitchers hit seven Lake County Captains, breaking the franchise single game record, and the second-highest single game HBP total for a team plunked by one pitching staff behind the 1993 Gulf Coast League Braves, who were hit eight times on June 18, 1993.

Representing His Country: 1B/3B Jordan Díaz played for Colombia in Olympic Baseball Qualifying play, blasting a game-tying home run in the 9th against Venezuela, but Colombia lost all three games in opening pool play and was eliminated. Team USA won the tournament, punching a ticket to Japan.

Front Office Connections: Lugnuts pitching coach Don Schulze was drafted 11th overall by the Chicago Cubs in 1980, 12 picks before Oakland Executive Vice President of Baseball Operations Billy Beane was drafted by the New York Mets. Lugnuts first baseman Patrick McColl set a new Harvard baseball single season record with 70 hits in 2019, breaking the previous record held by Athletics General Manager David Forst.

Clubhouse of Higher Learning: The Ivy League is well represented on the Lansing roster. First baseman Patrick McColl played for Harvard University, reliever Michael Danielak was drafted from Dartmouth College and catcher William Simoneit spent four years at Cornell University before grad-transferring to Wake Forest. Speaking of outstanding academic institutions, starter Jack Cushing spent four years at Georgetown University.

International Appeal: Seven nations are represented on the Lugnuts' roster: USA, Colombia, Cuba, Dominican Republic, Japan, South Africa (Anthony Phillips) and Venezuela (Javier Godard).

Finally: Pitchers Jeff Criswell, Stevie Emanuels and Shohei Tomioka, catchers Jared McDonald, Drew Millas and William Simoneit, first baseman Patrick McColl, and outfielder Michael Guldberg have all made their pro debut this season with the Lugnuts.

So Many Starters: The Lugnuts have used 14 different starting pitchers this season, namely Brady Basso, Reid Birlingmair, Jeff Criswell, Jack Cushing, David Leal, Stevie Emanuels, Richard Guasch, Rafael Kelly, Bryce Nightengale, Colin Peluse, Leudeny Pineda, Seth Shuman, Shohei Tomioka and Brock Whittlesey.

**Pronunciation:** Shohei's name is pronounced "SHO-hey toh-mee-OH-ka."

**Last Outing:** Tomioka suffered his poorest performance of the year on Wednesday, July 28, vs. Fort Wayne, allowing four runs in the 1st inning and 3 runs in the 3rd (on a Luis Almanzar three-run double), and finishing with seven runs allowed on five hits and three walks in 3 1/3 innings... Lugnuts were routed, 15-5.

**Pressed Into Duty:** Today's scheduled starter was Seth Shuman, who started on Tuesday in the opener and tossed six scoreless innings against the TinCaps... but Shuman was packaged with catcher Drew Millas and pitcher Richard Guasch and traded to the Washington Nationals for Josh Harrison and former Lugnut Yan Gomes on Friday. Hence, Tomioka returns to action on three days rest.

Starting Strong: After a successful pair of scoreless innings in his pro debut on Opening Night, May 4, following Seth Shuman, Tomioka was even sharper against Lake County in three scoreless innings on Saturday, May 8, after relieving top prospect Jeff Criswell... entered in the 3rd inning, working around a two-out double by Will Brennan... struck out two batters in a 1-2-3 4th... gave up a leadoff single in the 5th to Daniel Schneeman but erased him with a double-play ball and faced the minimum... of 10 batters faced, only Brennan and Schneeman hit the ball out of the infield... Lugnuts won, 2-0... in each of his first two outings as a professional, Tomioka received the victory from the official scorer.

**Talented Staff:** Shohei pitched on a talented Toyo University staff, evidenced by how the 2018 Nippon Professional Baseball Draft was loaded with his teammates, with Hiroshi Kaino selected 1st overall by Fukuoka, Taiga Kamichatani going later in the 1st round to Yokohama, and Chunichi drafting Kodai Umetsu in the 2nd round.

**The Road to MLB:** After not being drafted, Tomioka pitched for VITAL-NET in the amateur Industrial League, a level in which Hideo Nomo, Jun Tazawa and Kosuke Fukudome all first made their names before joining the higher ranks... tried out for the Athletics with 27 other pitchers in Autumn 2019, hit 95 mph with his fastball, and was signed in February... scout: Toshiyuki Tomitsuka...2021 marks his pro debut.
