- The Sky Carp won a high-scoring affair 8-6 over Peoria on Saturday night to seal a series win at Dozer Park.
- Beloit jumped ahead 1-0 in the second on a Cam Barstad RBI double, and then made it 2-0 with a third inning Javier Sanoja solo homer.
- The Carp seemed to break the game open with four runs in the fifth inning to push the lead to 6-0.
- Sky Carp starter Karson Milbrandt was strong, striking out seven batters in 4.2 innings. Milbrandt exited the game with two outs in the fifth, giving way to Chris Mokma. Mokma would allow three runs to score, including one inherited runner, to trim Beloit's lead down to 6-4.
- The Chiefs got within one in the sixth as Jimmy Crooks ripped an RBI single that made it 6-5.
- Beloit got some breathing room in the eighth, as Chase Luttrell poked an RBI double, and Cristhian Rodriguez brought him home with an RBI single.
- Kyle Crigger came on for the two-inning save, and allowed an Alex Iadisernia solo homer to start the eighth, but worked around a baserunner in the ninth to seal the victory.

THAT'S ALL, FOLKS

Today's game marks the end of the 2023 season for the Sky Carp. The campaign was highlighted by a strong start, as Beloit turned in its winningest April in team history with a 14-6 record. Things turned when the Carp lost 11 straight games from May 23rd through June 3rd. Throughout the course of the year, Beloit had 12 players promoted to AA.

GOING OUT ON A HIGH NOTE

With last night's win, the Sky Carp clinched a series win in their final set of the year - their first series win in 10 tries. Beloit's last series win came when it took five of six from South Bend June 28 through July 3. Beloit went 3-9 against Peoria in the teams' first two series.

THREE'S A STREAK

The Sky Carp took their third straight win last night - the first time the team has won three straight games in over a month (8/3-5 at Dayton). Beloit has won more than three in a row just once in the second half - against South Bend, 6/30-7/3.

HIT PARADE

Beloit's 13 hits last night mark their most in a single game in the last two weeks (13, 8/24 vs Lake County). The 13 knocks in a winning effort were the most since 8/12 vs Peoria.

ON THE DOUBLE

Cam Barstad ripped three doubles last night, tying a season high by a Sky Carp. The 3-4 performance is Barstad's first three hit game since he tallied four hits vs Quad Cities on 6/15.

IN A PINCH?

Torin Montgomery continued Beloit's pinch hit success with his ninth inning RBI Saturday night. Sky Carp hitters are an incredible 14-41 (.341) in pinch hit spots this season with 12 RBIs. West Michigan (.357) is the only team with a higher average. The Midwest League's average in pinch hit situations is .252.

BILLY'S BIG MILESTONE

With 55 wins with Beloit this season, Sky Carp manager Billy Gardner Jr. has collected 1,506 victories as a Minor League manager. Beloit's win on August 19 at Quad Cities marked Gardner's 1,500th in affiliated ball. This season is Gardner's 24th managing in affiliated ball, and 26th in pro baseball.

IN THE TOOL BOX

On Tuesday, Baseball America released its "Best Tools" lists for High-A leagues, which are voted on by league managers. Marlins No. 8 prospect Yiddi Cappe was selected to have the "Best Infield Arm."

IT'S NOT MEANT TO BE WHEN THE CARP SCORE THREE (OR FEWER)

Beloit is 5-56 when scoring three runs or fewer this season. On the other hand, when Beloit tallies six or more runs (as they did last night), their record is 33-4.

IN THE ALMANAC

Beloit has clinched its most losses in a season since joining the Marlins organization prior to the 2021 season with 75. Beloit has never finished with fewer than 54 wins since at least 1995. Beloit's worst record in recent memory came in 2019, when the Snappers finished 54-84 in their final season as an Oakland affiliate.

- Was also named the 2022 PAC-12 Scholar Athlete of the year... was also a finalist for the Senior CLASS award, which recognizes Senior student athletes for achievement in community, classroom, character and competition.

- Allowed 3 ER in final two innings of work on 9/3 vs WIS; 2 on Brock Wilken 2-run homer.
- Allowed just 2 ER in 10 IP in final two starts of August... Allowed 8 ER in 6.2 innings in first two.
