On Deck: The Nuts travel to Cedar Rapids, IA, to play the Minnesota Twins-affiliated Kernels in a six-game series running Tuesday, June 22, through Sunday, June 27. Then it's back home for a sixgame series against the Dayton Dragons that concludes on the 4th of July, an unforgettable night each Lugnuts baseball season.

On the Air: Tonight's game is on Mil.B.TV and via streaming online audio at http://milb.streamguys1.com/lansing, with Jesse Goldberg-Strassler and Adam Jaksa on the call of the game.

Last Night: Lugnuts 6, Loons 5 (10 innings). A quartet of heroics! 2B Ryan Gridley made a diving stop in the top of the 9th to start a highlight-reel double play and keep the Lugnuts within one, RF Shane Selman led off the home 9th with a game-tying HR, Selman then threw out Carson Taylor at the plate to end the top of the 10th, and Elvis Peralta, Jr. walked it off with an RBI single in the home 10th.

What's New in 2021: Entering this season, the Lugnuts' stadium name changed from Cooley Law School Stadium to Jackson® Field™, the Nuts moved up to the High-A Central, and they accepted an invitation to affiliate with the Oakland A's, the Nuts' fourth MLB partner, following the Kansas City Royals (1996-98), Chicago Cubs (1999-2004) and Blue Jays (2005-2020).

Lug. Notes: Headlines and Points of Interest

Meet the Boss: Scott Steinmann is the 16th manager in Lugnuts team history. Born in Dayton, Steinmann joins the Lugnuts after three straight seasons assigned to manage Double-A Midland (though the 2020 season was canceled). Steinmann previously managed against the Lugnuts with Wisconsin (2005), Clinton (2009, 2014-15) and Beloit (2017). More info about the skipper can be found on the next page of these notes.

Cowboy Up: Former McNeese State Cowboy Shane Selman has owned the Loons' pitching staff this season; yesterday's game-tying homer in the ninth was his fourth roundtripper of the year against Great Lakes, with three of the home runs coming in the eighth inning or later. He's hitting .368 (7-for-19) in this current series.

Welcome to the Club: Right-hander Leudeny Pineda makes his 2021 debut as well as his Lansing Lugnuts debut this afternoon in a starting role. In so doing, the native of Azua, Dominican Republic, becomes the 12th different starting pitcher for the Lugnuts this season, joining Brady Basso, Reid Birlingmair, Jeff Criswell, David Leal, Stevie Emanuels, Richard Guasch, Rafael Kelly, Colin Peluse, Seth Shuman, Shohei Tomioka

Halted: In the past two nights, Loons pitchers have stopped two different 19-game on-base streaks, ending catcher Drew Millas's streak Friday and center fielder Michael Guldberg's streak yesterday. The Lugnuts' longest on-base streak this season is 24 games, set by Max Schuemann from May 8-June 6.

Man of Steal: Speaking of infielder Max Schuemann (Portage Northern H.S. / Eastern Michigan University), he leads Minor League Baseball with 28 steals, two more than South Bend's Delvin Zinn, and eight more than the Major League leader, Kansas City's Whit Merrifield. Schuemann is tied for second in the Minors with 12 HBPs and is second in the High-A Central with 34 runs scored.

Double Your Pleasure: The Lugnuts' offense tops the High-A Central with 84 doubles. Nine different hitters have notched at least six doubles.

Alumni Report: 2021 Lugnut Jake Suddleson is batting .222 (6-for-27) with two home runs in eight games for Double-A Midland, though he is on a 6-for-12 streak after opening hitless in his first 15 at-bats. Fellow former Lugnut Jack Weisenburger has appeared twice in relief for the RockHounds, pitching two hitless, scoreless innings before allowing two runs in an inning in his last outing.

Hail to Arms: The Lugnuts' pitching staff tops the High-A Central with a 3.65 earned run average with the second fewest walks in the league (129), tied for third fewest home runs (30) and tied for third most strikeouts (425)

Indicator of Success: When the Nuts outhit the opposition, they are 14-1 this season. When they get outhit, they are 3-19, with two of the wins coming in this series.

TODAY IN LUGNUTS HISTORY

1997: José Amado changed dugouts, going from Seattle-affiliated Wisconsin to Kansas City-affiliated Lansing, as the Mariners acquired Rusty Meacham from the Royals. Amado immediately became the Lugnuts' starting third baseman.
2015: A triple play! Also: The Lugnuts clinched their first division title since 2012, beating the Great Lakes Loons, 8-2, on a Saturday night at Cooley Law School Stadium. In the second inning, the Loons had Kelvin Ramos at second base and Alex Verdugo at first base with none out. Jimmy Allen sent a line drive to shortstop Richard Ureña, who dropped it – allowed by the umpiring crew – and then tagged out Ramos (one out), stepped on second to force out Verdugo (two outs) and threw to first to retire Allen (three outs).

Major League Lugnuts: Three former Nuts have made their Major League debuts this season, bringing the total to 157 all-time - pitcher Ty Tice '18, outfielder Josh Palacios '16-'17, and pitcher Tayler Saucedo '16-'17. Tice and Palacios made their first MLB appearance in the same game for the Toronto Blue Jays on April 9th. It was the seventh time in team history that two Lugnuts made their MLB debut in the same game, with the first occurring on September 14, 1998: Carlos Febles and Carlos Beltrán for the Kansas City Royals. Saucedo most recently debuted, tossing a scoreless inning for the Blue Jays on June 17.

Familiar Settings: 13 of the 30 Lugnuts active players came through the Midwest League in Beloit on their way up the Athletics' ladder, and coaching staff members Scott Steinmann, Don Schulze and Anthony Phillips all have experience in the league.

Fly Like an Eagle: Max Schuemann (Portage Northern H.S.) is the first Lugnut from Eastern Michigan University.

Finally: Pitchers Stevie Emanuels and Shohei Tomioka, catchers Jared McDonald, Drew Millas and William Simoneit, first baseman Patrick McColl, and outfielder Michael Guldberg are all making their pro debut this season.

Front Office Connections: Lugnuts pitching coach Don Schulze was drafted 11th overall by the Chicago Cubs in 1980, 12 picks before Oakland Executive Vice President of Baseball Operations Billy Beane was drafted by the New York Mets. Lugnuts first baseman Patrick McColl set a new Harvard baseball single season record with 70 hits in 2019, breaking the previous record held by Athletics General Manager David Forst.

Clubhouse of Higher Learning: The Ivy League is well represented on the Lansing roster. First baseman Patrick McColl played for Harvard, reliever Michael Danielak was drafted from Dartmouth and catcher William Simoneit spent four years at Cornell before grad-transferring to Wake Forest.

Power Five Baseball: The Lugnuts also represent the ACC (Michael Guldberg, Georgia Tech); Big 12 (Brady Basso, Oklahoma State); Big Ten (Dalton Sawyer, Minnesota); and the SEC (Cobie Vance, Alabama, and Ryan Gridley, Mississippi State); and the Pac-12 (Stevie Emanuels, Washington).

International Appeal: In addition to 16 different states (Arizona, California, Delaware, Georgia, Illinois, Louisiana, Maryland, Massachusetts, Michigan, Minnesota, Nevada, North Carolina, Ohio, Texas, Virginia, Washington) represented by Lugnuts players and coaching staff, seven nations are represented: USA, Colombia, Cuba, Dominican Republic, Japan, South Africa and Venezuela.

Representing His Country: 1B/3B Jordan Díaz played for Colombia in Olympic Baseball Qualifying play, blasting a game-tying home run in the 9th against Venezuela, but Colombia lost all three games in opening pool play and was eliminated. Team USA won the tournament, punching a ticket to Japan.

Teammates Then, Teammates Now: Several of the Nuts are more than a little familiar with one another. Reid Birlingmair and Charlie Cerny pitched together at the University of Illinois at Chicago. The Lugnuts also have a pair of Wake Forest Demon Deacons; though William Simoneit played only one year at Wake, 2020, thus missing Colin Peluse by a year, Peluse hosted Simoneit on his visit and convinced him to attend Wake.


