In a game against the Nashville Sounds on May 24, 2001, Memphis pitcher Rick Ankiel set a Pacific Coast League record with six wild pitches and six consecutive walks issued at Greer Stadium. All came in the first inning.

Super Mario: Sounds catcher Mario Feliciano added a hit Saturday to extend his hitting streak to seven games. He's hitting .480 (12-for-25) with 3 runs, 1 double, 2 RBI and 3 walks during the streak.

Lucky Number Seven: The Sounds have won every series they have played this year (7). It's the first time since at least 1987 the team has won its first seven series in a season (team records date back to 1988).

Earn It: Nashville's team ERA sits at 3.00 (360.0 IP/120 ER) after a pair of games on Sunday. The 3.00 ERA is the best mark across Triple-A Baseball, far ahead of Iowa with a 3.46 ERA. Nashville's six shutouts also leads Triple-A Baseball.

How Sweet It Is: Sounds manager Rick Sweet is in his third season overall and second consecutive season at the helm of the Nashville club. Sweet led the Sounds to a 70-58 record in 2021 and a 77-67 record in 2014. He has served as the manager for Milwaukee's Triple-A club since the 2014 season.

The Future Brew Crew: Nashville opened the 2022 season with four players on the roster who are listed on MLB Pipeline's Top-30 Milwaukee prospects. Infielder Brice Turang is the No. 4 prospect, left-handed pitcher Ethan Small is the No. 7 prospect, catcher Mario Feliciano is the No. 21 prospect and right-handed pitcher Dylan File is the No. 25 prospect.
